On 4/13/68, Mrs. LEE APPERSON, 416 Palo Duro N. W., telephone 344-3625, (Protect Identity), telephonically advised that one OLIVER CRAWFORD, a Negro residing at 4182 Palo Duro N. W., which address is next door and to the rear of her home, had been residing at this address for about three weeks. She feels that he is a very dangerous individual, possibly a mental case, and wanted to call him to our attention. She very reluctantly admitted her identity after questioning and is extremely anxious that her name not be mentioned and that CRAW-FORD does not find out that she called us.

She said that in the past three weeks, she has seen police officers at CRAWFORD's apartment several times; that he has been engaged in a number of fights in his apartment; and that three different women have resided there. He showed her husband a couple of pictures which were snapshots and said these were of the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He said he, CRAWFORD, was in the FBI and he had just received these pictures. He mentioned once that he had \$40,000. She said he wears a white uniform such as is worn by a hospital orderly and the uniform as "VA" or possibly VA Hospital on it.

She described him as follows:

Race Negro Sex Male American Nationality 63 Claimed Age 5'11" Height Build Slender 160 pounds Weight Very Dark Complexion Dark Eyes

He claims to be part Hawaiian

It appears that subject may be having mental difficulties.

With regard to his statement he was "in the FBI" she was asked if he acted in the capacity of a FBI employee by asking questions, attempting to arrest anyone, etc. and she replied in the negative.

It is possible that Albuquerque Police Department records will have full identification on CRAWFORD. He may be a "walk away" from the local VA Hospital or from a mental institution.

On 4/12/68, contact was made at the home of CLEO QUINTON at 3205 Britt NE. Mrs. QUINTON advised that RICHARD JAMES DAYHOFF is going with her daughter. She said he is in the Army and he arrived in Albuquerque on furlough, arriving at her home at 7:15 P.M. on 4/1/68. She said he visited each day at her home and left the following Sunday morning about 6:00 A.M. She said he left driving his 1963 Dodge Dart, white in color, and she had absolutely no idea what route of travel he would take, however, she said he had mentioned he would be going through Memphis, Tennessee and each of them commented on the commotion going on there regarding the murder of Dr. KING. She said furthermore that on his way to Albuquerque, he had called long distance from Knoxville, Tennessee so this would give some indication of his route of travel coming to Albuquerque. KAREN QUINTON, her daughter, and RICHARD J. DAYHOFF's girlfriend, was also present during this interview. She nodded approval for everything her mother advised concerning DAYHOFF and it appears there is no doubt DAYHOFF was in Albuquerque, N.M. from 4/1/68 through 4/7/68.

On 4/12/68, contact was made several times at the DAYHOFF home at 3509 Mary Ellen Court NE. There were no cars at the residence and contact with neighbors indicated that no activity had been seen around the home for the last couple of days.

I interviewed Betsy Egan at the Santa Fe Preparatory School, 1519 Canyon Rd., Santa Fe on 4/16/68 and displayed the two artist's photos of the subject to her. She stated the one from Birminhgam bore some resemblence to the man she had reported in her telephone call of 4/15/68, but added that the man she had seen on flight 157 TWA had a thinner face and higher cheek bones than the man in the photo.

I called attention to her earlier description of the man in question as to the curly hair. She replied that this man she had referred to had curly hair which was cut very short.

Miss Egan, age 14, related she sat in the aisle seat at the back end of the 1st class section of this flight and the man in question sat in the seat just behind her and two seats to Miss Egan's right. The stewardess serving her was Linda McCallester and the Flight Captain was Brown.

Egan noted the man she had seen resembled the photo prepared in Birmingham except that he had a narrower face and higher cheek bones than the man in the photo.

She was unable to provide any details about this man's departure from flight 157 at Wichita, Kansas. He had no luggage to the best of her knowledge.

It may be advisable to have the Kansas City Office check this flight to identify the man in question if possible.

Miss Egan is very mature for her age and appears to be quite intelligent.



This was occupied by two individuals, neither of which had any resemblance to GALT. The driver, JESSIE JAMES ROBINSON, was 6'4" and weighed 250 pounds. The other individual, CHARLES SMITH, had no identification, but was not of the same description as GALT.

During the a.m., 4/18/68, JIM SAMPLEY, former Bureau employee, telephonically contacted the office and advised that at approximately 10:45 p.m., on 4/17/68, he was in the Greyhound Bus Depot in Albuquerque to pick up his mother who was arriving on a bus from Dallas, Texas. He advised that he was standing at the baggage counter waiting to get his mother's luggage when he observed a cart with luggage, presumably from the bus which had just arrived from Dallas, come into the baggage room. He observed a brown Samsonite, two-suiter, Pullman suitcase, silhouette model, removed from this car by the baggage handler and on the side of this suitcase, in masking tape, approximately 1 inch by 8 inches, was imprinted in red marking ink the name GALT. SAMPLEY advised that his mother's luggage was also removed from this same cart. He watched for approximately 20 minutes to determine if anyone came to the counter to claim this particular piece of luggage; however, no one appeared to claim the suitcase.

SAMPLEY advised he observed this same suitcase re-loaded on another baggage cart and from this point, he did not know where this suitcase went, presumably however, back onto the bus, which was departing at 11:45 p.m., same evening, for San Francisco, California. He advised he did not see any tags attached to the suitcase indicating its destination and that when he observed the suitcase, he was approximately six feet from the item.

At 12:10 p.m., this date, R. G. MC COURT, terminal manager, Central Greyhound Lines, Albuquerque, advised that Bus #1273 arrived from Dallas, Texas, at 10:45 p.m., 4/17/68, and departed at 11:45 p.m., same evening, for San Francisco. This bus was due to arrive at Barstow, California 1:52 p.m., PST, on 4/18/68, and at Bakersfield, California, at 2:14 p.m., 4/18/68. MC COURT advised that this bus is a through bus from Dallas to San Francisco and that normally baggage loaded in Dallas would remain on the bus until arrival at its destination. He advised that this is frequently not the case, as the Albuquerque terminal is a baggage control point and that luggage on an arriving bus oftentimes is unloaded, the bus taken to the garage for fuel and servicing, and upon its return to the terminal, luggage re-loaded therein.

He advised that the Greyhound terminal in Dallas, Texas, is a transfer point for the Southeastern part of the United States, specifically Atlanta, Georgia, and Memphis, Tennessee.

MC COURT advised that 20 people arrived in Albuquerque from Dallas aboard this bus and 12 boarded the bus departing from Albuquerque. Bus #1273 was brought from Clovis to Albuquerque by a driver by the last name OLDHAM, and driven from Albuquerque to Flagstaff by a driver by the last name of GULLETT.

KOB-TV advised that they had received the press release but did not have photographs. Two photographs were furnished to this station by SA JEROME VAN LANCKER prior to 6:00 p.m., 4/17/68.

KBIM TV in Roswell also advised they had the release, but no photographs. Photographs were mailed immediately to that station. Efforts to contact the other TV station in Roswell, WESE, resulted in no one answering the phone. SA SMART was advised that photographs were being sent to him to be delivered to that station on 4/18/68, and to be sure that they had the press release.

An administrative tickler is being set to review this matter on a weekly basis to insure that this release and photograph receive repeated coverage by radio and TV stations.


