EXHIBITED TO THE INTERVIEWING AGENTS HIS IDENTIFICATION CARD
FROM LOCKHEED. HE ADVISED HE OPERATED THE HOME SERVICE LAUNDRY AND
DRY CLEANING COMPANY, FIVE TWO EIGHT ZERO HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD
FROM JANUARY SIXTEEN LAST, THROUGH MARCH TWENTY THREE LAST. HE
STATED GALT WAS A REGULAR CUSTOMER TO THE LAUNDRY AND HE CAME IN
EACH SATURDAY AFTERNOON. THE FIRST TIME HE SAW GALT WAS ON

VERNON WAS SHOWN A PHOTOGRAPH OF THE T-SHIRT AND SHORTS WHICH WERE FOUND IN THE APARTMENT IN MEMPHIS. HE STATED THE SHORTS WERE SIMILAR TO THE ONES WHICH GALT ORDINARILY WORE AND SAID THE SIZE OF THE SHIRT MATCHED THE SIZE OF GALT. HE COULD NOT STATE FOR SURE WHETHER OR NOT THE TWO PIECES OF UNDERWEAR BELONGED TO GALT.

VERNON IDENTIFIED THE LAUNDRY MARKING ON THE UNDERWEAR AS BEING SIMILAR TO THE MARK USED AT HIS LAUNDRY.

VERNON DOES NOT KNOW GALT BY HIS FIRST NAME; HOWEVER, ENTRIES IN THE LAUNDRY BOOK WHICH WERE OBTAINED FROM VERNON INDICATE THAT GALT'S FIRST NAME WAS GIVEN TO THE LAUNDRY AS ERIC. VERNON STATED GALT USUALLY WORE BERMUDA SHORTS, A SPORTS SHIRT WITH A T-SHIRT UNDERNEATH WHEN HE CAME INTO THE STORE. HE SAID THAT GALT NEVER WORE GLASSES NOR DID HE EVER OBSERVE HIM TO HAVE SUNGLASSES IN HIS POSSESSION. VERNON COULD NOT RECALL WHAT TYPE OF FOOTWEAR GALT WORE WHEN HE CAME INTO THE STORE. VERNON NEVER OBSERVED GALT DRIVING A VEHICLE, NOR DID HE EVER MEET GALT IN ANY OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD RESTAURANTS OR BARS. GALT NEVER GAVE AN ADDRESS TO VERNON OR END PAGE TWO

HAIR WAS CUT NEAT, SOMEWHAT LIKE BUSHY FLATTOP AND A WIDE FOREHEAD. VERNON NEVER NOTICED ANYTHING UNUSUAL ABOUT GALT'S SPEECH, AND STATED HE WOULD ASSUME THAT GALT WOULD COME FROM THE CALIFORNIA AREA AS HE HAD NO NOTICIBLE REGIONAL ACCENT.

VERNON WAS EXHIBITED THE TWO COMPOSITES FURNISHED BY THE BUREAU. HE STATED THAT THE EYES, NOSE AND CHIN ON THE COMPOSITE FURNISHED FROM MEMPHIS SHOULD BE PLACED ON THE COMPOSITE OF BIRMINGHAM. IF THIS WERE DONE, THE COMPOSITE AS FURNISHED BY BIRMINGHAM WOULD BE A BETTER LIKENESS OF GALT.

VERNON SAID GALT ALWAYS PAID FOR HIS LAUNDRY IN CASH USING

The Capitol Homes employees believed GAULTs first name was LEONARD, his mother had remarried, LEONARD was a drunkard who caused difficulty in the project and as a result the management ultimately asked his mother to leave the project about two years ago. The Manager's recollection was that the woman lived at 81 Hunter Street in Apt. 228 or 228A, or at 83 Hunter Street in Apt. 213 or 213A. Records could not be searched based on address information only. I instructed SA SULLIVAN to make check of Atlanta Penitentiary under names furnished to determine any releasee can be identified.

SAS KEEL and RENAGHAN and PERRY instructed at 7:30 P.M. this date to make check under all names for flights from Atlanta to Mexico City, 4/5/-4/6/68.

SA OGDEN instructed to check names through Drivers License Bureau.

At 8:00 P.M. this date I called CIEM MC GOWAN at the Bureau, and suggested tohim that it appeared logical to pursue the theory that after subject abandoned instant car in Atlanta that he could have boarded a plane in Atlanta to Mexico City, where he had been previously.
