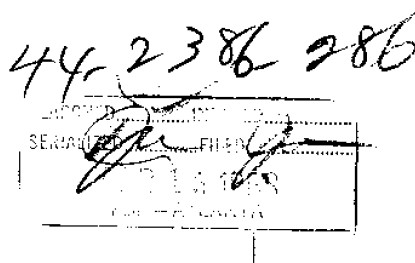

Miss SHERRY WINSLETT advised she resides at 10146 Hartford Court, Schiller Park, Illinois, telephone 678-4773. She advised she is employed as an airline stewardess for Delta Airlines. On April 5, 1968, she was a stewardess on Delta Flight 649, which originates at Atlanta and then goes to Augusta and to Savannah. During the flight from Atlanta to Augusta, luncheon is served on the plane and she and one of the stewardesses have to serve all the passengers on the plane in 35 minutes. The flight from Augusta to Savannah takes less than 30 minutes. She does not recall any individuals on this flight and specifically does not recall any individual described as a white male, age 28, to 32, weight 160 pounds, pale skin, hooked nose, hair thin on sides, thin on top, wearing a black half turtle-neck jersey shirt and black trench coat. Miss WINSLETT stated that there was another stewardess on this flight the name of whom she cannot recall who was stationed in Atlanta.

She stated that should she recall any information regarding the above individual, she would notify the FBI in Chicago.

FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

REGGIE SMITH, cameraman, Columbia Broadcasting System (CBS), Atlanta, Georgia, telephonically contacted SA JAMES O. INGRAM on April 12, 1968. He stated he had just arrived in Atlanta upon instructions issued by officials of CBS. The news media is presently carrying headlines indicating that ERIC STARVO GALT is a prime suspect in the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. at Memphis, Tennessee. A white Mustang registered to GALT was found in Atlanta, on April 11, 1968, abandoned. Through news media, SMITH has obtained description of GALT and believes he has information which could be of value to the FBI. He furnished the following information:

On Saturday, April 6, 1968, he and his soundman, LEROY COLLINS, traveled to Spelman College, Atlanta, Georgia, to film persons viewing the body of Dr. KING, or incidents. The first roll of film that he shot was of a group of about ten people. There was one lone white male who viewed the body in this first group and he and his soundman, COLLINS, noticed the unknown male pass by the coffin and smile. He appeared to laugh, looked around to see if anyone was observing him, and he left "with a smile on his face." SMITH did not consider the incident of any value at that time, until he reviewed the information on GALT and GALT's description.

He described the unknown subject who viewed the body of KING as a white male, in his early thirties, 5' 10" to 5' 11", weight 160 - 170 pounds, dark hair, and was wearing a light-colored suit. SMITH suggested that the FBI may desire to review his first can of sixteen

Mr. HERBERT BRADFORD, 2722 Stanton Road, S. E., Washington, D. C., on 4/11/68, advised that he had been to Atlanta, Georgia, to attend the funeral of Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. He arrived at about 9:00 p.m., on 4/8/68, and he stayed at the Holiday Inn, at the airport in Atlanta. Between 10:00 p.m., and midnight on 4/8/68, he saw an individual on the road who was wearing a red beard (not heavy) and his hair partially covered his forehead. He said this man was driving a foreign-make car, light blue, and it did not bear Georgia license plates. He thought the car might be a SAAB but he could not be sure. Subsequently, he saw a picture in the newspapers of the man being sought, and he recalled the man he had seen in Atlanta strongly resembled the suspect.

On 4/12/68, BRADFORD again called WFO and advised that he wished to correct information furnished on 4/11/68. He stated the correct make of the car he had observed in Atlanta was a 1960-61 blue or Alcapulco blue SAAB or similar form of car. The license plates were blue numbers on a white background, state unknown. He felt the individual he had seen strongly resembled the composite drawing of the suspected killer.
