FBI Laboratory advised that the pillow case and bedsheet found in the trunk of the 1966 white Mustang, registered to ERIC STARVO GALT which was located at Atlanta, contained thermoseal laundry tapes of approximately the same size as those tapes previously recovered but are in this instance yellow in color and contain code 20R-3. These tapes, in the opinion of the textile marking machine company, were produced by a different machine from the previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point types and the last two characters are 18 point type. The above company suggests that the 20 in the above code would be a lot number, the R may mean that it was a return of a batch of laundry, and the 3 is the bundle number.

FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date April 16, 1968

At 2:30 a.m. JIMMIE DELTON GARNER telephonically contacted the Atlanta Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at which time he provided the following information:

Since providing the information concerning ERIC GALT during a personal interview by agents, he has rechecked his records and now believes that the individual whom he knew as GALT actually was registered at the rooming house under the name of WILLIAM LEE, Route 1, Gastonia, North Carolina. GARNER said his records do not reflect the room number to which LEE was assigned but noted that the records do show LEE arrived April 5, 1968, and paid through April 12, 1968. When renting the room, LEE supplied the name Miss BETTY RETIRMAN, 1952 Waltz Street, Warren, Michigan, as the individual to be notified in case of emergency. GARNER said all information provided during the prior interview was accurate except that he now feels certain that WILLIAM LEE's registration pertains to ERIC GALT.

GARNER was questioned as to how he determined this man's name to be GALT when the registration was in the name of LEE. GARNER was unable to satisfactorily explain this except to say that he feels that he concluded that LEE was GALT when GARNER's sister called his attention to the mail at the rooming house which was directed to ERIC GALT.





Landlord of 113 14th St. also operates same type of house next door at 107 14th St. These buildings are huge old dwellings converted into numerous extremely small sleeping rooms which are rented by transients, many of whom are cooks and dishwashers.

Composite description of GALT is white male, in thirties, 5'll" tall, 175 lbs., brown hair, blue or possibly hazel eyes.

Efforts being made to interview individuals who were residents of building at 107 or 113 14th Street any time during period 3/31/67 - 4/5/68, to determine if anyone recalls GALT, obtaining absolutely all information regarding his activities, movements, statements, modes of transportation, associates, and particularly when last seen and the circumstances obtained.

In response to a telephonic request received at 9:31 a.m. from JIMMIE DELTON GARNER, he was interviewed in front of his restaurant located at 1052 Northside Drive, Northwest, Atlanta, Georgia.

GARNER opened the conversation by stating "Lee is not Galt." He then made available the registration records for his rooming house. It was again noted these records do not reflect a registration in the name of GALT. At the same time, GARNER produced an envelope bearing the printed name "Eric S. Galt." GARNER said this name was printed thereon by GALT when GARNER requested his full name. Other handwritten notations thereon were, according to GARNER, prepared by himself.

GARNER stated that subsequent to a prior interview, he had been searching his records and his memory and had now determined that on March 24, 1968, late in the evening, an individual knocked on his apartment door, introduced himself as Mr. GALT, and requested a single room.

He was placed in Room Number 2, 113 14th Street, Northeast, Atlanta, Georgia, on noting that the room was small, was offered an adjoining storage room in which to place his surplus belongings. At this point, GALT remarked he would be able to utilize a desk in the storage room for his television set.

GARNER did not see GALT unload his automobile or bring his possessions into the room. He next saw GALT on March 31, 1968, at which time the rent was due and GALT made the statement, "I may as well pay you for another week." This was between 1:00 and 2:30 p.m.

On April 5, 1968, GARNER entered the room at approximately 11:00 a.m. to change the linens. At this time, he found a note on the bed written on a piece of cardboard, believed by him to be a laundry shirt backing, which stated in effect "I've had to go to Birmingham. I've left my TV set here and will try to return for it in 5/68 of Atlanta, Georgia

about a week." He does not recall whether the note was printed or written and destroyed it by throwing it in the trash immediately.

GARNER described GALT as a white male, 33 to 35 years of age, approximately six feet tall, slender build, black hair, worn very short with possibly a part on the side.

GARNER had previously noted GALT to be utilizing a light colored, possibly white, automobile and on the morning of April 15, 1968, telephonically contacted Mr. HAROLD WATERS, Room Number 1, 107 14th Street, Northeast, as this automobile was parked near WATERS, at which time he asked WATERS generally if he recalled the make of car and WATERS advised him it was a late model Mustang, possibly 1966 or 1967.

GARNER estimated his total contact with GALT on both occasions did not exceed one-half hour. He stated on both occasions GALT was neatly dressed in a dark suit, white shirt, and tie. He characterized him as looking like a preacher.

The inconsistencies in the information previously furnished by GARNER and the foregoing were thoroughly discussed with him and he could attribute it only to "being confused", in that he had erroneously associated the name GALT with the roomer, WILLIAM LEE, about whom he had furnished the information.

At this time, GARNER made available a three page memorandum in his handwriting which chronologically sets forth his association with GALT. The envelope previously referred to, furnished by GARNER, on which GALT wrote his name, also contained the notation "Could do several different kinds of work." This note was prepared by GARNER.

GARNER stated he made this notation during his initial contact with GALT, at which time he asked his usual questions of new roomers about their line of work. He said he inadvertently failed to record the information on the envelope in his permanent records. GARNER added that at the time of renting the room, he received a \$1.00 key deposit from GALT and the key was left with the note on the bed by GALT.

A survey of the area at 14th and Peachtree Streets, NE reflected there are only two banks in the immediate proximity.

JERRY MC CRACKEN, JR., Assistant Manager, Atlanta Federal Savings and Loan Association, 1124 Peachtree Street, NE advised his bank does not sale cashier's checks, maintain checking accounts, or rent sale-deposit boxes. He has no record for an ERIC S. GALT ever having done business with his bank.

Branch of the Citizens and Southern National Bank, 12th and Peachtree Streets, NE, caused a check to be made of the records of his bank as well as the central records of the Citizens and Southern National Bank, Atlanta and advised he could locate no record of an ERIC S. GALT as having a checking account, a savings account, having a loan or having a charge account. Mr. WALSTAD explained that his bank issues between twenty-five and fifty eashier's checks per day and the records are filed at the central office of the bank under the numbers and there is no alphabetical listing. He stated the only logical check would be to check each individual record of camaier's checks issued on a day by day basis at the main office and this would be an extensive search.

Mrs. KAREN MC CARTHY, Tenth Street Branch, Citizens and Southern National Bank, who issues checks (cashier's) and money orders, advised she does not recall the name of ERIC S. GALT. Mrg MC CARTHY explained three is no record as to name for money orders issued, therefore, it would be impossible to determine if an individual purchased a money at her bank.
