Re Tampa teletype to Bureau, 4/10/68 (Serial 235) and Albany tel, 4/12/68, giving the specifications of the second Thermo Seal laundry mark found in 1966 white Mustang on the sheet and pillow slip.

FBI Lab advised that the pillow case and bedsheet found in the trunk of the 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT, which was located at Atlanta, contained thermoseal laundry tapes of approximately the same size as those tapes previously recovered but are in this instance yellow in color and contain code 20k-3. These tapes, in the opinion of the textile marking machine company, were produced by a different machine from the previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point types and the last two characters are 18 point type. The above company suggests that the 20 in the above code would be a lot number, the R may mean that it was a return of a batch of laundry, and the 3 is the bundle number.

In addition to the laundries previously set forth for checking, the following additional should be checked:

Four Mc Farland Brothers Laundry, Atlanta -- In this connection, previous investigation indicated Mc Farland Brothers not listed this area as such, but identity can be obtained from the Wink Davis Manufacturing Co.

Gainesville Steam Laundry, Gainesville, Ga. --

RICHARD BRISTOL of the Textile Marking Machine Co. has indicated that the suburban Atlanta and Sandy Springs, Ga. Laundries run by Mc Farland Brothers, use the above code beginning with letters.

Result of examination:

It was concluded that ANITA LOUISE KATZWINKEL, K26, did not prepare the questioned handwriting "Ginger & Anita Katzwinkel" appearing on Q118, the portion of a tissue box, previously submitted. Because of unexplained variations and insufficient comparable material, a definite conclusion could not be reached whether KATZWINKEL prepared any of the remaining questioned handwriting on Q118. Some significant handwriting differences were noted in this remaining questioned handwriting excluding the words "Day" and "at pool." These words are too limited and contain insufficient handwriting characteristics to determine if they were or were not prepared by KATZWINKEL.

Due to the lack of a sufficient number of significant comparable letters, it was not possible to determine if the words "broulh" and "Olkahombe" on Q118 were prepared by the person or persons responsible for the remaining questioned handwriting appearing on this specimen.

It was concluded that the FLIKEID signatures appearing on the bottom of K27, were prepared by THOMAS M. FLIKEID, FBI#534039D.

Because of insufficient significant comparable hand-writing and unexplained variations, a definite conclusion could not be reached whether the questioned Lowmyer signature on the gun invoice previously submitted or the writings attributable to Eric S. Galt, previously submitted, were prepared by the writer of K27. Some handwriting differences were noted in the handwriting attributable to Galt when compared with K27, however, these characteristics are not sufficiently strong to definitely eliminate FLIKEID as a possible writer of the Galt material.

The K28 and K29 maps are not identical with two maps, Q18 and Q20, previously submitted and recovered from the blue bag in Memphis.

Q139, Q140, K27 through K29 are temporarily retained. Appropriate photographs of the writing appearing on K27 have been made.

One 8 inch head hair of Caucasian origin was found inside the Q139 left shoe. This has been dyed black. No similar hairs were found in or on items previously submitted in this case. No other hairs or debris was found in Q139 or Q140.

On April 9, 1968, Mrs. GRADY LAYFIELD, 2678
Hillcrest Drive, Macon, Georgia, advised SA TRAVIS L.
LYNCH on a personal and very confidential basis that a logical suspect in the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. is her husband's nephew, BOBBY DEAN MEDLIN, Charleston, South Carolina. Mrs. LAYFIELD was payereally disturbed regarding the possibility that her husband's nephew, MEDLIN, may be involved in this matter and stated that under no circumstances could she have her name revealed or the location of the source of the information revealed inasmuch as the family would immediately identify her if they knew the location of the source.

Mrs. LAYFIELD explained that MEDLIN has made numerous statements in the past that his lagisambition was to kill Dr. KING. Some months ago, MEDLIN stated he had a rifle with a scope similar to the rifle which killed President KENNEDY and his day would come, implying that he would have an opportunity to kill Dr. KING. Mrs. LAYFIELD assumed that MEDLIN may await an appropriate opportunity when Dr. KING was in the vicinity of MEDLIN's home in Charleston, South Carolina, and then attempt to murder him.

Mrs. LAYFIELD is of the opinion that MEDLIN is mentally unbalanced. She was at a family gathering with her husband's family about a year ago in South Carolina and MEDLIN was observed to go berserk for no apparent reason. During the otherwise pleasant outing, MEDLIN went to the cottage next to the location where the LAYFIELD family was gathered and immediately started cursing and arguing with the residents of this cottage for no reason. Mrs. LAYFIELD's husband and another relative had to physically bring MEDLIN back to the family outing and MEDLIN explained that the cottage next door contained a group of people who were conspiring to overthrow the United States and that they were Communists. Mrs. LAYFIELD believes it is possible that MEDLIN has had some brain damage due to at least two serious acidents in the past. On one occasion he fell from a building and had a head injury and on another occasion he was involved in a motorcycle accident. 44-2386-5

AT 44-2386 TLL: SWO MEDLIN should be well known to the Police Department, Charleston, South Carolina, for previous violations of the law, including driving under the influence and possibly He resides near his mother, Mrs. WILSON ROGERS, Summerville Drive, Charleston, South Carolina, and in the' recent past he has worked at a service station which is located at the last intersection before arriving at Folly Beach, South Carolina, when traveling from Charleston, South Carolina, to Folly Beach on the Folly Beach Road. He should be well known in the vicinity of this service station. MEDLIN has caused his mother problems for a number of years. He has been married and he is either divorced or separated from his wife and family. Mrs. LAYFIELD described MEDLIN as a white male, about 30 years of age, about 5'9"-5'10" tall, about 160 pounds, dark brown hair which he has long on the sides. She advised that he has a "silly" grin expression similar to the expression described in descriptions of the unknown subject in regards to Dr. KING's murder and in Mrs. LAYFIELD's opinion MEDLIN favors the sketch of the unknown subject which appeared in the newspaper. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

On April 8, 1968, Mr. HERBERT BLUM, Blum's Individual Laundry and Dry Cleaning Company, 463 Compton Avenue, Macon, Georgia, advised Special Agent Travis L. Lynch as follows:

Blum's Laundry has a Thermoseal Tape machine, Serial Number 31973, Model H5Ll, which the company had used for a number of years. This machine cuts and seals tape 1 1/8" long with a code for identifying laundry. The is-TAPE 15 primarily used on shirts, but occasionally a piece of tape will be placed on men's shorts if there are only a couple of items in the particular bundle. The laundry has had no difficulty with this machine insofar as cutting the tape is concerned and to Mr. BLUM's knowledge this machine has not cut the tape short in the past. The laundry uses several colors of tape and red tape is used for special work.

BLUM's Laundry does not use a code identical with code number 02B-6. Their code consists of five characters which is the maximum characters which can be printed on their machine. The code consists of two numbers 1-99 designating the lot number; a letter designating the week, and two digits, dash 1 through 20 designating bundle numbers. The week is designated by starting with week A and running through the alphabet and then using the alphabet again over and over. The last time Blum's used Week B was the week of March 25, 1968.

Mr. BLUM checked all the records of his company for the B week of March 25, 1968, and located no code similar to code number 02B-6. The only way this code would have been used would have been an error inasmuch as this Blum's code does not consist of a 02 prefix.

Mr. BLUM made available several samples of red tape from his machine bearing code 02B-6.

On April 8, 1968, the samples of red tape obtained from Mr. BLUM were forwarded to the FBI Laboratory, Washington, D.C.

The following investigation was conducted by SA HILBERT ARPS on 4/16/68 and 4/17/68.

Records of the Atlanta Credit Bureau, as checked through Mr. JOHN RITTER, disclose that CLAUDE A. CASS has been of record since 1955. His address since 1962 was shown to be at 1160 St. Charles Place, NE, Atlanta and he was divorced from his wife, ALLA, in 1963. The record was favorable and the last inquiry was from the First National Bank, who was inquiring on behalf of Bankamericard credit card. This was a mailing list type of inquiry, rather than any occassion whereby CASS was applying for something requiring credit.

Records of the Atlanta Police Department, as checked by Miss JO PRESSLEY, disclosed no record of CLAUDE ALBERT CASS. Miss Pressley said applicant prints are not maintained on a permanent basis and therefore CASS could be working for Fulton County but they would no longer have his prints.

Mrs. RUTH KNIGHT, Secretary, Fulton County Givil Service Board, 165 Central Ave., SW, Atlanta, furnished the following information from the file of CLAUDE ALBERT CASS:

CASS was hired by Fulton County on 10-26-59 and has been working since then as a Deputy Marshall. There is nothing derogatory in his file. He was off on 3 days sick leave in November 1967 but had no absences in the following December, January, February and March. His April records of absences were not yet in his file, but through inquiry with the Fulton County Marshalls Office, Mrs. KNIGHT determined he had no absences during April 1968. In the file, it was noted that CASS had been fingerprinted as an applicant by the Atlanta Police Department on Hy-2300 10-21-59 and his fingerprints were sent to the FBI in





Miss ROBBIE LEE GARNER, Apartment D-8, 1295 Donnelly Avenue, S. W., furnished the following information:

She is the only sister of JIMMIE D. GARNER who operates rooming houses at 107 and 113 - 14th Street. She has a key to GARNER's room at 107 - 14th Street and visits him occasionally. On Saturday, April 13, 1968, she visited his room about Noon. GARNER was not in his room and she stayed for only a brief time. In looking about the room she observed the name "GALT" written in dark blue ink on a piece of paper, size about 2" x 4". The paper was either white or bight blue in color. She was not positive if the paper was a separate slip or the back of an envelope. She believes it was located on a table near the phone.

She had heard of the name GALT in connection with the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

About 8:00 P.M., April 13, 1968, she again visited her brother. He was in bed and appeared to be very drowsy and tired. She did not enter the room but merely opened the door and attempted to converse with him. She mentioned that she had seen the name "GALT" written on a paper in his room, but this did not cause any particular reaction, as GARNER seemed to be about half asleep. He did say something about the name GALT being a common name.

She said her brother does not keep up on current affairs and may not have even been aware of the news about GALT. She said that in addition to running the rooming houses, he also runs GARNER's cafeteria on Northside Drive. She stated he gets up about 4:00 A.M. and works about a 16-hour day. She advised that GARNER attended Mississippi Southern and was an Army officer during World War II. She stated her brother is in very poor financial condition. She stated she never heard of her brother belonging to any kind of organizations or clubs and she does not believe he has any political interests or motivations. She said she was certain that GARNER would not assist nor shield anyone involved in any criminal activity.

Miss GARNER advised she is a teacher at Sandtown School on Campbellton Road.

The following investigation was conducted by SA C. O. KENNERLY, JR., AND THOMAS R. HENRY, JR., on 4/16/68:

ROBERT MOZELL CATE, residing at Green's Trailer Park, Norcross, Georgia, advised that he had been a former member of the First Marine Division, First Regiment, H Company, stationed at Camp Pendleton, California, in 1961.

He advised that at this time there was a Corporal GUALT assigned to the same unit. He advised this unit was later sent to Okinawa.

According to CATO, artist's conception of ERIC STARVO GALT appearing in the newspapers did not appear to be identical to the Corporal GUALT he knew. He stated that if he could view a photograph of GALT he would be able to determine if they were one and the same individual.

CATO recalled that Corporal GUALT was from Arizona or New Mexico and believes he had at one time lived in Brownsville, Texas. He described Corporal GUALT as a white male, 29 - 30 years of age, 5' 10" - 6*, 155 lbs., dark brown hair - bushy on the sides. CATO further advised that he was not too well acquainted with Corporal GUALT and recalled that a Sergeant FRANK THOMAS from Elberton, Georgia, was a close friend of GUALT's and could possibly furnish additional information.

In addition, CATO recalled that Corporal GUALT had the nickname "SHAKE", was always well-dressed, and had his uniforms tailored and his shoes were also "spit" shined. 

Mr. EUGENE L. DORMINEY, 309 West Mc Lendon Circle, La Grange, Georgia, advised as follows:

Mr. DORMINEY is manager of the La Grange office of GAC Finance Corporation, $107\frac{1}{2}$ Greenville Street, La Grange, Georgia.

About 8:40 a.m. April 10, 1968, Mr. DORMINEY was driving en route to Albany, Georgia, when he chanced to come up behind a 1967 GTO automobile, yellow in color, which carried 1968 Alabama license plates, numerals not recalled. This was on United States Highway 27 past the Traffic Circle near Fort Benning, Georgia. Both cars were heading south.

DORMINEY pulled around the GTO and chanced to look at the driver. This man was white, male, about 25 years of age with black hair. He was wearing a dark shirt and his beard was beginning to grow out to the point where it was obvious he needed a shave.

After driving past the GTO, Mr. DORMINEY recalled that the driver appeared to resemble someone he had seen before. It was then that DORMINEY recalled this individual greatly resembled the artist's conception drawing of the murderer of MARTIN LUTHER KING which DORMINEY had seen in a newspaper.

DORMINEY recalled that this GTO followed him to Richland, Georgia, where DORMINEY continued driving on Georgia Highway 55 toward Albany. The GTO was noted to turn left at Richland and drive east on United States Highway 280 in the direction of Americus, Georgia.

DORMINEY did not recall observing anyone else in the GTO, no clothing or luggage being visible nor any decais or dealer's emblems on the vehicle.


