On April 19, 1968, Mr. WILLIAM MEULLER, Adult Probation Office, Fulton County Probation Department, Atlanta, Georgia, advised that AARON BENNER HOLCOMB was due to report to his probation officer on this date. He stated that HOLCOMB would report on the first floor of the new criminal court building in Atlanta, Georgia. MEULLER placed a stop for HOLCOMB at this desk and stated that he would get in touch with the FBI immediately should HOLCOMB appear.

At 3:00 p.m. SA WILLIAM V. KENNEDY and SA ROBERT J. KOLEVAR waited at the Adult Probation Office in the new Criminal Court Building until it closed at 5:00 p.m. HOLCOMB did not report for probation on that date.

On April 19, 1968, Mr. WILLIAM MEULLER, Adult Probation Office, Fulton County Probation Department, Atlanta, Georgia, advised that he was familiar with the case of AARON BENNER HOLCOMB. He advised that HOLCOMB has been handled by the Adult Probation Office before and that he is presently on probation after having been arrested and convicted of larceny from house in Atlanta, Georgia. He has been on probation with the department from April 4, 1968. Mr. MEULLER advised that his records reflected that HOLCOMB is now residing at 68 Rawson Street, Southeast, Apartment 48, Atlanta, Georgia.

Mr. MEULLER further advised that he could account for HOLCOMB's time up until 12:30 p.m. on April 4, 1968. He stated that on this date, HOLCOMB was in court and was also in the process of pleading the procedures for probation. He advised, however, that after 12:30 p.m. on that date HOLCOMB left the court house and MEULLER had no idea of his whereabouts after that time. MEULLER added, however, that a person on probation is not allowed to leave the State of Georgia without permission of the probation officer.

MEULLER further advised that a psychological report was conducted regarding HOLCOMB and that it was found that this individual had a marginal touch with reality, was of moronic intelligence, and has a pre-occupation with sex. MEULLER advised that he could not be considered a trustworthy individual.

MEULLER further stated that HOLCOMB was due for his monthly visit to the probation office on this date. He stated that it would be possible for Agents to talk to this individual when he reported into his probation officer.

Mrs. MARIE DOMINICK, 1076 Cumberland Road, Northeast, Atlanta, Georgia, furnished the following information:

Mrs. DOMINICK advised that on April 5, 1968, at about 12:00 p.m., she put out a sign on her front lawn advertising that she had a furnished apartment for rent. At about 4:00 p.m. that same day, a man knocked on her door and asked to see the apartment that she had to rent. Mrs. DOMINICK stated that she thought at first that the man was a salesman but then realized that he was there to see the apartment. She asked him how many people he had in his family and he stated that there was just himself. Mrs. DOMINICK told him that it was a three room apartment and that she was asking \$95 a month. The man still insisted on seeing the apartment and was quite worried about whether Mrs. DOMINICK had any problem with bugs in the apartment. He told Mrs. DOMINICK that he had gotten "hooked" on apartments that were just full of roaches. Mrs. DOMINICK told him that she had a contract with an exterminating company and the apartment was regularly sprayed. The man told Mrs. DOMINICK that he lived within the 1600 block of Briarcliff Road near LaVista and that his rent was going to be up April 11, 1968, and that he would need another apartment at that time. The man advised Mrs. DOMINICK that he was a vacuum cleaner salesman and worked for Electro-Lux Vacuum Cleaner Company.

Mrs. DOMINICK advised that she sat and talked with the man for about 45 minutes and they discussed the vacuum cleaner business and also the market value of Negro property, which he was interested in buying. He seemed very anxious to ask Mrs. DOMINICK about her estimates on the amount of profit that could be made from buying Negro property and renting it out. Mrs. DOMINICK stated that the man was driving a black Volkswagen convertible with a black top, but the year model of the car was not known to her.

Mrs. DOMINICK furnished the following description of the individual:

Mrs. DOMINICK advised that she cannot remember the name of the individual, but does remember that this individual told her that he was married and divorced. He also advised her that he had been in the Marine Corps and that he was originally from Texas. He had said that he was living at Briarcliff Road for three months, since he had just gotten out of the Marine Corps. The individual was anxious to rent the apartment by the week. The only time that he wrote anything down was when he took out a flat book to write down Mrs. DOMINICK's telephone number. The individual told Mrs. DOMINICK that he would call her in a few weeks to let her know about the apartment.

Mrs. DOMINICK viewed a series of photographs, including that of ERIC STARVO GALT and picked out the photograph of GALT as being the individual who looked like the man who examined the apartment. Mrs. DOMINICK stated that she was sure this was the man who was there and advised that she would immediately contact the Atlanta Office of the FBI if this man should try to recontact her in any way.

At approximately 11:15PM on 4/21/68, Mrs DOROTHY PHILIPPS, 413 Henson Avenue, Columbus, Georgia, telephonically contacted the writer and requested that the writer come to her home concerning an incident which took place in Eufaula, Alabama, that afternoon.

Mrs PHILIPPS stated that at about 3:30PM (Alabama time) on 4/21/68, while she and her family were eating in a restaurant in Eufaula, she noticed a man enter the restaurant and sit at a nearby table. She said that this man did not pass along the buffet table and one of the waitresses approached him and asked if he wanted her to get the food for him. The man told her to secure enough food for two people and that he wanted to take it with him.

At this point, the waitress secured one platter of meats while another waitress secured another. The first waitress took the platter back to him and showed it to him and he approved the choice. Mrs PHILIPPS said that she was looking at the man because of his attitude and his unusual behavior. She said that he kept to himself and turned away from her view.

After the waitress brought the three platters to him they wrapped them in foil and after one of them accepted payment from him at the cash register, she accompanied him to his car which Mrs PHILIPPS believed was parked outside the restaurant. Mrs PHILIPPS could not see the car nor if anyone was in the car, but, she heard it start off with either a defective muffler or "straight" pipes.

Mrs PHILIPPS said that she did not think too much of the incident until she returned home late in the evening and read the Saturday newspaper and observed the picture of ERIC GAULT which was taken in 1959. She said that the features closely resembled this picture.

Mrs PHILIPPS described this individual as follows:

Mrs. PHILIPPS said that the restaurant in which she and her family were at the time she observed the above individual was on Highway #431, in Eufaula and was named either "Dixie" or Rebel. She said that it was connected with a motel and was just past the railroad tracks in town, near a hill.

Mrs PHILIPPS said that most striking item which made her remember the man as against the picture in the newspaper was his nose which was pointed and had a slight upward pitch to it at the end.

The above information was telephonically furnished to SA JOHN G. SULLIVAN at AT. Upon subsequent instructions, the above information was telephonically furnished to SA CHILLITON CREASON, Union Springs RA, who advised that he would contact personnel at the restaurant in Eufaula on 4/22/68.

He advised that he boarded a Greyhound Bus at 7:40 p.m. on the Old Marietta Highway, Cobb Co., Ga., and that the bus proceeded south and that an individual boarded this bus around the Smyrna Baptist Church and handed the driver a \$10.00 bill. The driver stated that he had no change, whereupon the passenger gave the driver a \$1.00 bill. The individual then walked to the rear of the bus and this individual and BONILLA disembarked from the bus together near the Atlanta American Hotel in downtown Atlanta, which is the last bus stop.

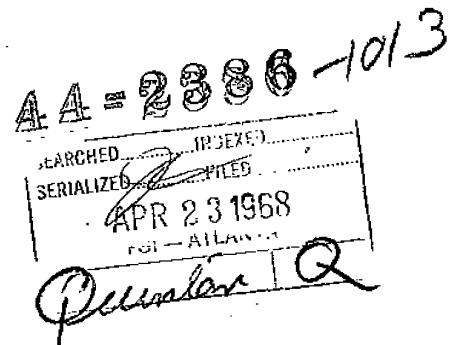
KIDD stated he would like to see an agent re this and look at some photos of RAY as the newspaper pictures are not very good.

JAMES L. SMITH, Room Number 9, 107 14th Street, Atlanta, advised he has lived at this location since May of 1967. He said that since this time he has never known or met anyone who resided at 113 14th Street, and he could not identify by description or artist's composite photograph anyone who may have resided in the area believed to have used the name of GALT.

SMITH advised that he believes he has seen a white Mustang parked in the rear of either 107 14th Street or 113 14th Street, but he could not recall whether this might have been within the last three or four weeks.
