On 4/24/68, Mrs. LOWELL LANGE was interviewed at her home at 1678 Pelham Road, NE, Atlanta. She advised that she had furnished the information contained in the above referenced memorandum to the FBI after noting that numerous unexplained telephone calls noted on her telephone bill were placed to Alton, Ill., the home of JAMES EARL RAY.

Mrs. LANGE advised that she and her husband have resided at the address on Pelham Road since November 1967. She also stated that she and her husband moved to Atlanta to allow her husband to study for his master's at Atlanta University. She stated that her husband is a coach at Georgia Tech.

Both Mrs. LANGE and her husband appear to be stable individuals.

Mrs. LANGE advised she had four boarders in residence however, none of these individuals are from the Alton, Ill. area. She was positive that the calls were not placed by anyone at their residence.

In addition to the four calls to Alton, Ill. there were two unexplained calls to Stanford, Conn. The unexplained calls were listed on the March and April telephone bills. The calls are as follows:

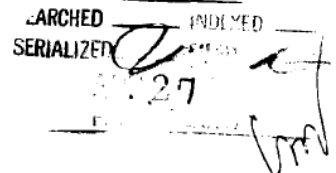
## Result of examination:

Although the photocopy, Qc288, lacks the quality necessary for a satisfactory comparison, some differences were noted between the writing appearing on the face of this item when compared with the writings appearing on specimens submitted in this case.

Some features noted on Qc288 which might give an indication of its place of purchase are a stamp with the wording "Montreal 28 VII 67;" the number of the money order, "C-31,600,868;" the printed name "Hector Cormier" at the bottom of the money order and the initials "M." or "N." "D." on the bottom line to the right of the printed Cormier name.

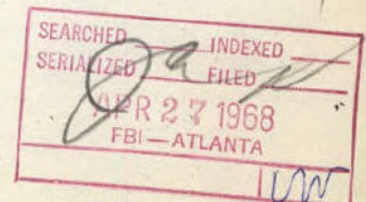

1. This single caucasian EM was referred to MHCD by Colonel Welch, the head of the Airborne Department because of "unusual behavior."

2. He returned from Vietnam eight months ago, while over there he claims he was blown out of a helicopter and fell about 75 to 100 feet to the ground. He landed in a rice paddy, and though he was in the hospital for a week, claims he sustained no serious injuries.

*This is 2nd April not 7th Can*

3. EM was recently AWOL for 10 days (from the 7th - 17th of April) and says he can't remember anything about leaving or where he went, but that he "woke up" in Chicago. He couldn't figure out why he would go to Chicago, since he is from Mobile, Alabama. When he realized where he was he called home and a relative drove up to get him, then brought him back to Ft Benning.

4. Today he related in a very guarded manner. He implies that he has no recall for 10 days, but denies any wrong doing. He relates many [REDACTED] and this plus his "memory lapse" alarms me. His SMDP and 14 P-F Tests, interview, and history all suggest he is an unstable paranoid person. I believe (but am not certain) that he is currently deceiving everyone regarding his "amnesia". He is either laying down an alibi or is concealing some antisocial act or acts. At the very least, he is attempting to make his AWOL look like an illness.

5. RECOMMENDATION: He should be followed in MHCD and his absence should be thoroughly investigated by the CID.

He has known "BUDDY" AYERS about 6 or 7 years.  
AYERS is the young white man who acted as an usher  
at the funeral of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, without  
anyone realizing he had no official capacity there.

He judges AYERS to be a very smart but very  
[redacted] individual, who he feels will  
do anything to gain recognition and who he feels  
should really [redacted].  
AYERS, who possesses great physical strength, has  
told him he, AYERS, has [redacted]  
[redacted], and has used narcotics, however, he  
himself does not know if this is really so.

About a week after the KING funeral, AYERS  
dropped by, supposedly to talk of buying a car.  
AYERS talked in a sympathetic manner towards negroes.  
He, however, is not certain whether or not AYERS  
is sincere in this feeling. AYERS claimed he had  
a contract with a publisher to obtain 20 volume  
sets of the life and speeches of Dr. KING which  
AYERS planned to sell at a great profit. It is  
seriously doubted that AYERS has any such contract.

AYERS also showed him a letter from a Negro minister, written in a very religious tone, in which the ministers itinerary was set out. AYERS said he planned to go to Philadelphia to join with this minister and help him in his work.

Mr. ELEY said that because of AYERS [REDACTED], he has always been very friendly and compassionate towards AYERS. AYERS has never indicated to him that AYERS was involved in any way in the shooting of Dr. KING, however, he felt he should mention the foregoing to the FBI in event consideration had not previously been given to the whereabouts of AYERS at the time Dr. KING was shot.

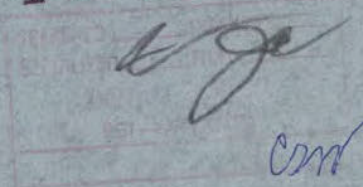
