

On April 17, 1968, the following investigation was conducted by SA HUGH ROBINSON, JR.:

BILL JOHNSON, Plant Manager, Decatur Laundry, 250 Trinity Place, Decatur, Georgia, advised that said Laundry uses a "Polymark" marking machine made by the Pinnacle Products Corporation, Elmsford, New York.

Mr. JOHNSON advised that this machine does place a small piece of cloth tape on a garment with numbers imprinted thereon for identification purposes. However, he stated that his laundry never puts said tape marking device on either sheets or pillow cases. He stated that all flat work which would include sheets and pillow cases are washed in nylon net bags with no identification placed on them whatsoever. He indicated that the above described tape marking device would only be affixed to a shirt or other finished type item.

On April 17, 1968, Mr. W. M. MC FARLAND, Manager, Dial Cleaners, 3426 Shallowford Road, Atlanta, Georgia, advised that said laundry uses a Thermo-Seal marking device to identify finished items of laundry. He advised that the laundry does not normally place a Thermo-Seal tape on any flat work, which would include sheets and pillow cases. He stated that these items are usually washed separate from the shirts and other items, which would receive identifying marks. Mr. MC FARLAND was unable to identify the piece of Thermo-Seal tape in question.

Manager, Reswell Cleaners, 836 North Atlanta Road, Roswell, Georgia, advised that his laundry has in the past used a Thermo-Seal marking device to identify laundry items. However, he sated that he has not used this machine in his operations for over six months. Mr. STRICKLAND further advised that they Thermo-Seal marking tape would almost always be affixed to a shirt or dress or other item of finished laundry. He stated that it is not his practice to put Thermo-Seal tapes on unfinished of flat laundry items such as sheets and pillow cases. He advised that this type of material is usually washed in a nylon net bag and the only identification is on the bag itself and not on the unfinished laundry item.

Mrs. EDNA E. CROOKE, 169 Memorial Street, SE, Apartment 511, was contacted and furnished the following information:

Her apartment overlooks the parking lot in which the 1966 white Mustang was subsequently found. CROOKE said she had never seen this car arrive at the parking lot but was aware that it had parked there for several days prior to its discovery. CRCOKE said that on April 5, 1968, she was visited by a friend, Mrs. FLOYD MEDLEY, Jonesboro, Georgia. Sometime about dusk, Mrs. MEDLEY was seated at the front door taking care of her young children. area overlooks the parking lot which is in front of the CROOKE apartment. At this time nothing was said about any car being in the parking lot. After the discovery of the white Mustang and on a day which CROOKE believes was April 14, 1968, she talked with Mrs. MEDLEY on the telephone. At this time MEDLEY mentioned that while seated at the front steps on April 5, 1968, she had observed a white colored car, which was probably a Mustang slowly drive into the parking lot. Because of the darkness, she was unable to see the license plate on this car and did not get a good look at the driver. She was interested in the car because at first she thought it might be driven by CROOKE's former husband. MEDLEY said that the car drove slowly in the lot and then turned around and left.

CROOKE said she did nt recall that MEDLEY had said anything further about the car. About a week or ten days ago, CROOKE was visited by a reporter named DON MC KEE and she mentioned MEDLEY's conversation to him. At that time CROOKE was aware of the unlisted phone number for MEDLEY and furnished it to MC KEE, who immediately phoned her. CROOKE said she overheard the entire conversation and that MC KEE took no notes whatsoever and that at no time

MRS. F. E. MEDLEY, 661 Utoy Court, Jonesboro, Georgia, advised that in early April 1968 her husband took a temporary job in Atlanta. During this period of three or four days she and her small children resided with EDNA CROOKE, 169 Memorial Street, Apartment 511. One evening just at dusk she and her children were seated on the front steps of this apartment. The steps overlook the parking area where the 1966 white Mustang was subsequently located. While seated there, a white Mustang drove slowly into the parking area. It was driven by a man whose face she did not see. He appeared to be wearing a white knit shirt. The car stopped for a few minutes and she observed that it had a 1967 Georgia license, beginning with the numeral 2. The driver did not get out of the car but drove back out of the area. EDNA CROOKE was not present during this occurrence and MEDLEY subsequently mentioned the incident to her, thinking the man might have been CROOKE's ex-husband, who has been causing her some trouble. MEDLEY said she is not even sure on what night this happened but is positive it was after the death of MARTIN LUTHER KING and CROOKE has told her it was April 5, 1968. MEDLEY said she did not know if there was another white Mustang in the lot on this particular evening.

MEDLEY said that a week or ten days ago she was telephoned by a reporter who was then at CROOKE's apartment. She said she was very upset because CROOKE had caused this. She stated that her conversation with the reporter was very garbled because he was not only talking to her but apparently with two or three other persons who were with him and kept interjecting remarks. She stated she never felt that what she saw had anything to do with the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING, and she never told anyone that the car she saw had Alabama tags. She advised she now has unlisted telephone number 478-1317.
