FINGERPRINT OF QUESTIONABLE VALUE DEVELOPED.

ALSO LOCATED IN ROOM WERE MAPS OF CANADA AND OF CITIES OF TORONTO AND MONTREAL. TWO PARTIAL PALM LATENT PRINTS DEVELOPED ON MAP. ONLY ONE OF THE PACKS OF FILM APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN OPENED BUT NOT KNOWN WHETHER CONTAINS ANY EXPOSURES. THIS BEING PROCESSED BY KODAK AT TORONTO.

LILLIAN SPENDER, MANAGER OF KENNEDY TRAVEL AGENCY, TORONTO, ONTARIO, WHO HANDLED FLIGHT BOOKING AND OBTAINING OF PASSPORT FOR SUBJECT, INTERVIEWED IN DETAIL TODAY. SHE COULD NOT MAKE POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION OF PHOTOGRAPH OF RAY OR RECALL ANY DETAILS OF TRANSACTION WHICH WOULD FIRM UP SNEJD'S IDENTIFICATION WHICH WOULD BE IDENTIFICATION AS RAY. PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION BY HER GENERALLY FITS RAY AND NOTATION MADE BY HER ON SNEJD'S PASSPORT APPLICATION REGARDING SCAR OVER CENTER OF NOSE NOW BELIEVED BY HER TO HAVE ACTUALLY BEEN IN CENTER OF FOREHEAD.

SPENDER STATES SNEJD PURCHASED ROUND TRIP TICKET, TORONTO TO LONDON, VIA BOAC, PAYING THREE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE DOLLARS IN CANADIAN MONEY ON MAY TWO LAST, WITH LIMIT OF TWENTY ONE DAYS FROM MAY SIX LAST FOR USE OF RETURN HALF OF TICKET. STATES TO GET REFUND FOR UNUSED PORTION SNEJD WOULD HAVE TO RETURN IT TO BOAC, TORONTO, OR KENNEDY TRAVEL AGENCY.

THAT THERE IS ANY CONNECTION BETWEEN SNEYD AND KING ASSASSINATION. YOU MAY ADVISE AUTHORITIES THAT INDIVIDUAL USING NAME SNEYD IS BEING SOUGHT BY FBI FOR UNLAWFUL FLIGHT TO AVOID CONFINEMENT FOR CHARGE OF ROBBERY.
