BARDEN R. BROWN, 455 Windsor Parkway, NE, Atlanta, Georgia, advised telephonically that he is a real estate broker that was formerly from Birmingham. BROWN stated he had read in the newspaper about Attorney ARTHUR HAINES, going to England to represent JAMES EARL RAY. BROWN stated HAINES is a racist and BO CONNORS assistant. BROWN stated he was concerned that HAINES might pass RAY some kind of vial and RAY would never be brought back to the United States. BROWN admitted he had no evidence to base his belief on other than his concern to try to prevent something happening such as happened to OSWALD. BROWN was concerned that it might not be determined where RAY obtained his money a nd if someone else was envolved with RAY. BROWN feels the above is essential if a stop is to be made in the killing of prominent people in the United States. BROWN was advised the FBI has a uthority to decide the person that will represent persons accussed of violations of laws. BROWN stated he was concerned that sommthing might happen that happened in Dallas and wanted to make sure that all precautions would be taken to prevent a repetition of this. BROWN stated he had no information that HAINES was planning to do anything to RAY.
