NEW YORK, Dec. 27—James Earl Ray is going "to tell all—everything I knew about people and events leading up to and after King's murder in Memphis" if he loses his appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court, the man convicted of the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., told a reporter for the Pacific News Service recently.

Despite the political nature of the assassination, and despite Ray's own statements in court that there was a conspiracy, the U.S. and Tennessee authorities who imprisoned Ray have everything to prevent any everything to prevent any testigation into who was behind the King assassination. Since the sensational stories of recent to discredit King, however, several people have been motivated to speak out.

One of them is Arthur Murtage, a retired FBI agent who headed a 'labyrinthine underground Black informers' in Atlanta, King's headquarters.

"My superiors—both in the Atlanta bureau and Washington—washed out leads suggesting a right-wing conspiracy," Murtagh told PNS reporter Wayne Chastain, Jr., last week. "Had a more thorough investigation between the FBI, I believe links would have been established between the King assassination and the Kennedy murders—both those of JFK and RJK."



ARNOLD RAY GODFREY, 1105 Lakeshore Drive, Jonesboro, Georgia, was contacted at his place of employment, City of Atlanta Sewer Department, 360 Englewood Road, SE, and advised that an interview was desired with him concerning an allegation regarding his participation in a plot to assassinate MARTIN LUTHER KING. He was promptly advised of his rights by Special Agent THOMAS J. WILSON and stated he understood his rights, but did not wish to sign anything, however, would consent to be interviewed. Thereafter, and promptly following this, he was interviewed and furnished the following information:

He has been employed by the City of Atlanta in the Sewer Department since 1949. He worked for approximately eight years as a laborer, the last five years as a foreman and all the time in between as a truck driver. He was also a country and western singer for some time. Most of his records were produced in 1967 or 1968. One of the records under the Saber label was on one side "Count me out" and on the other side "Try one on for size". Another record under the Columbia label was called "Always room for one more Fool like Me".

When he was actually engaged as a country and western singer he was tending bar part-time at a bar known as Pete's Bar on Moreland Avenue. He also had a band and sang with them at the same time.

He did not know anything about any assassination plot of any kind. He never talked with anyone regarding the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING before KING had been assassinated. He did not make any arrangements with anyone to have KING assassinated by CLAUDE and LEON POWELL. When questioned about any well-dressed individuals frequenting Pete's Place GODFREY remembered a white male approximately 45 years of age with wavy hair, very clean-cut and very well spoken being in Pete's Place numerous times. This individual carried a walking stick in his right hand and to the best of GODFREY's memory, this individual had something wrong with his right leg.

GODFREY could not remember the individual's name but described him as approximately 5'11", 170-180 pounds, of Latin descent. GODFREY further stated that this individual could talk in two different languages, one of which he thought was "Mexican". He stated that this individual had lots of money and was thought to be owner of a number of bars in honky tonk places around Atlanta. He thought that one of the bars that this individual owned in 1967 was located at the corner of Hunter and Bell Street in Atlanta. This individual was driving a big black automobile, probably a Lincoln. He was reportedly associated with the Venable Music Company in some manner. GODFREY thought that it was possible that some individual connected with Venable Music Company and this individual were connected in numerous enterprises throughout the city. GODFREY stated that PETE DAVIS would be able to identify this individual. GODFREY further stated that possibly DIANE (last name unknown) a former bartender at Pete's Place may also be able to identify this individual. DIANE also owns a bar known as "The Office" located on Flat Shoals in Atlanta

GODFREY again denied having any conversation with the POWELLS' or anyone else regarding the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING prior to his actual assassination. GODFREY advised he would be more than willing to take a polygraph examination to clear the air.

Mrs. POWELL, who is 85 years of age, stated that she is the mother of CLAUDE POWELL, JR. and LEON POWELL. She stated that at no time had her sons ever mentioned to her anything regarding being approached by anyone to make a lot of money.

Mrs. POWELL advised that she felt sure that she would know of the incident if it had happened to her sons, as in her opinion, they would have told her.

HUBERT POWELL, Black Mountain Road, telephone 404-886-4754, was interviewed by SA JIMMIE D. BURRIS who identified himself to him as a Special Agent of the FBI.

HUBERT POWELL was informed by SA BURRIS of the nature of the inquiry and thereafter freely and voluntarily advised as follows:

He advised that he is the older brother of LECN POWELL and CLAUDE POWELL, JR. He stated that approximately one to two weeks ago, exact date unrecalled, WENDELL POWELL, another brother who resides in Belmont, North Carolina, telephoned him and told him that FBI agents had been to talk with him about LECH and CLAUDE.

He also stated that shortly after his talk with WENDELL, LEON telephoned him and, in his opinion, was in a drunken condition. He advised that LEON told him the FBI would probably be by to see him and LEON then added that several years ago, he (LEON) and CLAUDE were in a club in Atlanta when an unknown male individual asked anyone in the club if they were interested in making a lot of money. CLAUDE told the unknown person that he was interested.

According to HUBERT POWELL, LEON told him that some time later on this unknown person came back into the club with a briefcase and that he (LEON) and CLAUDE knew this person meant business. LEON told HUBERT that CLAUDE, at that time, told this person that they were not interested.

HUBERT POWELL stated that he could not recall any other details about the telephone call with LEON, however, he definitely knew that LEON nor CLAUDE had ever mentioned this story to him before.

HUBERT POWELL added that LEON and CLAUDE both liked to drink and talk a lot while drinking.
