HAZEL EVANS CONTACTED AND ADVISED SHE WAS BARTENDER AT BILL BAILEY'S FROM 1966 UNTIL 1969. SHE WORKED THE NIGHT SHIFT. CAME IN AT 6:00 PM AND WORKED UNTIL 2:00 AM. THE DAY BARTENDER WAS JUNE HALL. A COUPLE OF TIMES HER NIECE, PATSY BOOZER, WORKED IN THE BAR. BILL BAILEY OWNED THE BAR IN 1966, HOWEVER, WAS BOUGHT OUT IN 1967 OR 1968 BY LEWIS CLARK; HOWEVER, CLARK MANAGED THE BUSINESS DURING THE WHOLE TIME. BAILEY HAD VERY LITTLE TO DO WITH THE BAR AND IT WAS VERY SELDOM HE CAME TO THE LOCATION.
