On 4/8/68 SA ROY G. WETZEL and SA DONALD V. NORTH attempted to locate CLARENCE BENJAMIN MITCHELL at 622 Surrey Square Lane and at Andrews Air Force Base with negative results. Subject's wife, WANDA STELLA MITCHELL was telephonically contacted at her place of employment TRW Systems, 1735 I Street, WDC. Mrs. MITCHELL had CLARENCE BENJAMIN MITCHELL meet Agents at OSI Headquarters, Andrews AFB, Suitland, Md.

At this time MITCHELL advised that on 4/4/68, he was with his wife and children at their present home, 3348 Curtis Drive, Apt. 101, Suitland, Md. MITCHELL also displayed a pawn ticket bearing the date 4/4/68, from the Suitland Loan Company for a guitar and amplifier he pawned on that date. MITCHELL advised that he left WDC for his home in Ripley, Tennessee near Memphis at approximately 9 p.m., on 4/4/68.

Mrs. MITCHELL was recontacted and verified that her husband was at home until late evening on 4/4/68. Mr. ALLEN E. AUSTIN, Suitland Loan Office, Suitland, Md., identified CLARENCE BENJAMIN MITCHELL as the individual who pawned a guitar and amplifier sometime after 2 p.m. on 4/4/68.

MITCHELL stated additional individuals who may be able to verify his presence in WDC were a Mr. ROD ACKERS and his wife and also a Mr. SAMUELSON, all three of Sheeham Ford, Route 5, Suitland, Md.

These three individuals were not contacted, however, it was verified that MITCHELL was driving a cream Ford Mustang with a black vinyl top, bearing 1968 Maryland license GJ 7883 with a Sheeham Ford sticker on the rear trunk. MITCHELL advised that he had some transactions with Sheeham Ford on 4/4/68 with relation to this vehicle.

FUSION AND DISCORD IN THIS COUNTRY. JACK (LNU) APPEARED VEHEMENT IN HIS CRITICISM OF KING AND STATED THAT SOMEONE SHOULD KILL HIM. JACK (LNU) PERSONALLY STATED, "IF I HAD THE CHANCE, I'D KILL HIM MYSELF." JACK (LNU) WAS AN EXPERT SHOT WITH AN M ONE CARBINE AND ATTAINED THE SECOND HIGHEST SCORE IN HIS DIVISION.

SMITH COULD RECALL ONLY THAT JACK (LNU) WAS EMPLOYED AS A SURVEYOR AND CIVIL ENGINEER IN A SMALL PARTNERSHIP IN THE VICINITY OF CANTON, MISSISSIPPI. HE RESIDED IN CANTON AND WAS ATTACHED TO A SEABEE DIVISION AT JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI. 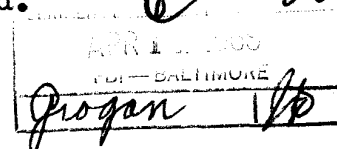
