(MISCELLANEOUS) On 8 April 1968, SP5 Ronald W. Griffith, RA [REDACTED] presently TDY to 113th MI Gp, was interviewed at Headquarters, Region I, 113th MI Group, Evanston, Illinois, at his own request and voluntarily furnished the following information:

On 7 April 1968, Source saw an artist's sketch in the local Chicago newspaper of the person who fatally shot Martin Luther King. Source noticed that the sketch strongly resembled George GRIFFITH, an avid member of the Ku Klux Klan (KKK), who had expressed a desire to kill King. Description of George GRIFFITH follows:

Height:	Approximately 6'
Build:	Medium
Eyes:	Color unknown, no glasses

The following is a personal background data concerning GRIFFITH:

Present Occupation:	Unknown
Last Known Occupation:	Mechanic, Decatur Automatic Transmission Company (DATC), Moulton Highway, Decatur, Alabama
Marital Status:	Divorced, two children
Military Service:	Fixed cryptographic repairman with TOP SECRET clearance with the USASA from approximately 1958 to 1962, rank and assignments unknown

Source first met SUBJECT in approximately 1962, when Source took his automobile to SUBJECT for repair. SUBJECT, at that time operated an automobile repair shop, no name, in Decatur, Alabama. Source saw SUBJECT monthly from 1962 to 1966, and three times from 1966 to last contact in 1967. Source did not associate with SUBJECT on a social basis.

On four or five occasions SUBJECT tried to enlist Source into the KKK, but Source was unresponsive. SUBJECT mentioned that HE was going to

4. REPORT OF FINDINGS (continued) stop the "Niggers" and "kill" them. On one occasion SUBJECT said, "I'd Kill that son-of-a-bitch, Martin Luther King, if I got a chance." SUBJECT mentioned King's name on four or five occasions, but did not mention the names of any other Negro leaders. At an unrecalled date in 1966, SUBJECT visited Edward F. Griffith at his home, Route 4, Hartselle, Alabama, and tried to recruit him for KKK, but Edward Griffith asked HIM to leave and would have nothing to do with HIM. SUBJECT'S position in the KKK was unknown, but on one occasion HE was seen with the KKK robe and pointed cap, face uncovered, directing traffic on a highway, near a KKK rally. SUBJECT always carried a loaded .45 caliber, nickel-plated, gold-engraved automatic pistol in HIS automobile, which HE sometimes transferred to HIS trouser pocket. HE was also seen with a high-powered rifle, make and caliber unknown. In Decatur and Hartselle, Alabama, carrying of firearms, rifle, shotguns or pistols, was not considered unusual, and attracted no attention. KKK members were known to transfer weapons among each other, so that one day a person may be in possession of a certain firearm, but not have it the next day. DATC had from 6 to 8 employees, of whom some were KKK members, identifications unknown. KKK had strong followings in Decatur and Hartselle, Alabama, not only members but non-member sympathizers. Source advised that the following persons may have further knowledge concerning GRIFFITH or may be able to corroborate the information given above: Dennis Griffith, CPT, USA Medical Corps, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, Psychologist, permanent address: Hartselle, Alabama, SUBJECT'S cousin, degree of closeness with SUBJECT unknown. David Sandlin, Sheriff, Morgan County, Decatur, Alabama, knowledgeable of SUBJECT and KKK activities, no sympathy for KKK. Newton Powell, influential citizen and former county official, Decatur, Alabama, believed to be knowledgeable of SUBJECT and KKK activities. Albert Brewer, Lieutenant Governor, State of Alabama, former resident of Decatur, Alabama, not known if Brewer was acquainted with SUBJECT but believed to be knowledgeable of KKK activities in Decatur and Hartselle. Source was willing to execute a sworn statement concerning his knowledge of SUBJECT as mentioned above, and was willing to appear before (continued)

a board of inquiry, but was not willing to have his knowledge of SUBJECT released to HIM with or without the use of his name, because of possible reprisals against Source and his family.

AGENT'S NOTES: Some of the information contained in this report is known only to Source or members of his family, and release of this information to SUBJECT may result in prejudice and violence directed against Source and his family. Source, upon termination of present assignment, plans to live in the same area where SUBJECT resides. Source is SUBJECT'S fourth cousin, Edward Griffith is Source's father. If Dennis Griffith is out of service with US Army, contact may be imprudent because of possible family loyalty.

Operational comment: Because SUBJECT had a TOP SECRET clearance HIS photograph may be at USAIRR, and this photograph may be compared with that of the artist's sketch of King's killer. Because of SUBJECT'S active participation in the KKK, the local FBI is believed to have a dossier on HIM.

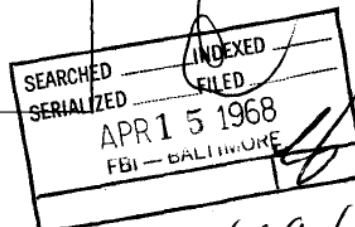
