On 4/16/68, efforts to contact anyone at the Pat Patrick School of Ballroom Dancing, 65 W. Franklin St., Hagerstown, Md., were negative. It appeared that this school might not be operating, and an attempted telephonic contact of the school reflected it had been closed and the telephone disconnected. No further information was obtained from this source.

On 4/16/68, Mr. EUGENE BUDOWSKI, Manager, Fred Astaire World of Dance, residing 822 Dewey Ave., Hagerstown, Md., was contacted; he was unable to furnish any pertinent information, stating ERIC STARVO GALT was not now and had not been registered at that school under that name or the aliases, HARVEY LOWMYER or JOHN WILLARD. He was unable to identify GALT's description as being possibly identical to anyone currently or previously registered at that school. He has operated this school for over one year.



The following investigation was conducted by SA Moberg on 4/18/68:

Mr. WILLIAM LEROY GALT,, residing at the home called Fort Venture, Located at Bellevue, Maryland, provided the following informationL:

He is president, treasurer and salesman of the firm known as POKE GALT, Inc., He also uses the nickname POKE GALT. and has his offices in Bellevue, Md. He has been in the Bellevue area for about 6 years, having come from Pennsylvania, where he had the same business located in Alden, Pa. and where he resided in Clifton NEIGH Heights, Pa. His business consists of wholesale plumbing and piping. He still retains an answering service in Philadelphia area as some of his customers still come from there.

He has a brother JOHN PETER GALT, recently retired from the U.S. Navy, who currently resides at 3003 Blue Ridge Avenue, Wheaton, Md., telephone number 949-2443, and another brother CHARLES P. GALT, residing in San Rafael, California.

GALT has no children of his own. He is married to his second wife who has several children of her own, none of the name GALT.

GALT advised that he is aware of the interest of the FBI in an ERIC STARVO GALT from publicity but has no knowledge of that person. He has never heard the name other than from the wide publicity recently given it and has no relative of that name. He could provide no information which might be of any help in this matter.

GALT viewed a photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT appearing on page # 1 of the Baltimore Sun Paper of 4/18/68 and advised that the man KK is unfamiliar to him.

On 4/18/68 Dr. R. LANE WROTH, St. Michaels, Md., who is acquainted with WILLIAM LEROY GALT of Bellevue, Md., advised that to his knowledge ERIC STARVO GALT is unrelated to WILLIAM L. GALT. Dr. wroth viewed the above mentioned photo of ERIC STARVO GALT but advised that it was totally unfamiliar to him.

On 4/10/68 SA's Gene S. Weimer and $J_{\rm g}$ mes K. Thulin contacted all banking institutions, commercial and military bases, in all law inforcement agencies and credit bureau in Charles and St. Marys Cointies, Md. but no record, past or present, of a checking or savings account in name of Eric Starvo Galt.

Also all laundries and dry cleaning plants and shops, civilain and military, in these two counties were contacted with negative results concerning the instant Thermop Seal laundry mark.

The Waldorf Laundry at Waldorf, Md. was the only laundry untilizing the Thermo-Seal makingx marking process. Mr. J.Burns, Mgr. of this laundry informed 4/10/68 that this laundry has never used the Thermo-Seal tape to mark underwear but only used on shirts.

Mary Credle, the Thermo-Seal machine operator at Waldorf Laundry, contacted 4/15/68 and she also confirmed that this machine only used to mark shirts and never used to mark underware.

Mr. J. Burns informed that there is a Mr. Joe Conk of Alexandria, Va. (248-6127) who is the WDC area distributor for the Thermo- Seal marking machine. Also a R.E. Frank Co. of WDC is an area distributor for Thermo-Seal tape. Burns suggested that afore two distributors might be of some help in identifying the instant thermo-seal mark in question. This information telephonically furnished to BA 4/10/68 for consideration of advising NFO and RH.

At 10:15 a.m. on April 10, 1968, a telephone call was received from Lawrence J. Hawkins who lives at 3708 Dolfield Avenue, whose home telephone number is 664-5520. Mr. Hawkins is a postal employee at the Airmail Section of the Hain Post Office, and his telephone number there is 962-4230.

Mr. Hawkins related that he viewed a television program last night on which there appeared a composite of the alleged killer of Martin Luther King, Jr. Mr. Hawkins stated that the composite resembled closely a white man by the name of Philip Jenkins, who picketed the CORE convention at Broadway and Gay Street, Baltimore, in July 1966. Hawkins states that Jenkins' picture was in the paper at that time.

Hawkins also advised that Jenkins was connected with an organisation by the name of Pesce International in the 800 block of N. Gay Street, Baltimore, but that the organisation is no longer there. Hawkins also advised that Jenkins founded a rifle club on Gay Street and Baltimore.

The above information was transmitted by telephone at 10:30 a.m. this date to Tom Cherigo, Baltimore FBI, who advised that Philip Jenkins is known to them.

Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermoseal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse N Y The tape is $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and 1 1/16" long and bears letters and numbers 02B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape 1 1/16" long instead of 1 1/8" long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter 0 stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6 Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned
