BLACKBURN, #56984, Maryland House of Correction, Jessup, Maryland, advised that he believed the killer of Doctor MARTIN LUTHER KING to be, one, JAMES VAUGHN (phonetic), aka "Buddy". BLACKBURN worked with VAUGHN in late 1965 or early 1966 in the Washington, D.C., area out of Carpenter's Local #132. BLACKBURN said that VAUGHN is a native of Memphis, Tennessee and has a lengthly police record there. He stated that VAUGHN once told him that "If KING ever came to Memphis, he would never leave there alive".

# BLACKBURN described VAUGHN as follows:

BLACKBURN stated that VAUGHN is to be in Norfolk with his brother-in-law at present, although he could furnish no address for either party and requested that the interviewing Agent attempt to obtain BLACKBURN'S release from the Maryland House of Correction, so that he could go to Norfolk and locate VAUGHN.

A review of BLACKBURN'S medical record at the Maryland House of Correction, Jessup, Maryland, reflected that a prison psychiatrist considered him as "emotionally unstable with a tendency to exaggerate on things which he has very little knowledge of".

On April 19, 1968, Mrs. IDA WASHBURN, Carpenter's Local #132, Washington, D.C., was telephonically contacted and she advised that her records reflected that CLARENCE BLACKBURN was a member of Local #132 in late 1965 and early 1966 but that there is no record of any JANES VAUGHN under all conceivable spellings, as having been a member of that Local at that time. Mrs. WASHBURN stated, however, that it is possible that if VAUGHN did work out of Local #132, he may have only obtained a work permit and not a full membership, in which case, he would not be carried on their records.



Mrs. THEIMA ALMEDA CAPINO, owner of a 1965 Ford Fairlane, Sky Blue in color, 2 door sedan, bearing 1968 Maryland license FA 4384, advised that the above vehicle was in her possession on April 21, 1968 from at least 9:30 AM when she drove to her daughters home in Lucketts, Va. and then to her aunts home in Leesburg, Va. until she returned home at about 4:30 PM. The vehicle then sat in her garage beside her home until about 7:30 PM that same evening when her busband, JOHN W. CAPINO drove it to work at the J. M. Bucheimer Company, Frederick, Md. where he works as a janitor and night watehman on weekends from 8:00 PM until 5:00 AM. She added that no one else drove the car on April 21, 1968. She added that both license tags were affixed to her vehicle on March 31, 1968 bid that neigher has been off the vehicle since then, to her knowledge.

Instant 1965 Ford was personally observed by the writer and both 1968 Maryland license tags, FA 4384, were on the vehicle.

### JAMES EARL RAY

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., is one of the FBI's "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his prompt location. Ray has been the subject of a massive search since the gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel.

An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom FBI wanted notices have been posted determined that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray, who escaped on April 23, 1967, from the Missouri State Penitentiary, is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery.

Possessing an arrest record dating back to 1949, Ray has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders.

A 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on Ray is approximately 5'10" tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and short brown hair. He has a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe and his left ear protrudes noticeably.

Described as a "loner and "drifter," with a "rural" quality in his speech, Ray has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher. He has taken dancing lessons and completed a course at a school of bartending.

Consider Ray armed and extremely dangerous. Report any information concerning him to the nearest FBI office.

Code, Section 241). A Federal warrant was also issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri, charging RAY with UFAC for crime of robbery. RAY was serving a twenty year sentence at the Missouri State Penitentiary from March 17, 1960, when he escaped on April 23, 1967. He was last known to be in Atlanta on April 5, 1968. From July, 1955 to April, 1958, he was serving sentence in U. S. Penitentiary, Levenworth, after conviction of forging Postal money order.

Specifically, RAY is sought for the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. in Memphis, on April 4, 1968. He is described as follows:
