

Re telephone call from the Bureau by HUNTER HEGELSON, Division VI, on the above date.

HEGELSON stated that he was calling on behalf of the Civil Rights Desk which is currently conducting a file review on all threats ever made against Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr. Contained in that review was a reference to a Baltimore Airtel dated 4/2/65, caption unknown, setting forth an arrest interview of one CARLOS LEE BILLINGS by the Baltimore PD. Set forth in the interview is an allegation made by BILLINGS of an offer by unknown persons to kill KING for \$50,000.00. BILLINGS has mental discharge from the U.S. Marines.

HEGELSON stated that the Bureau wants the above Airtel located, all pertinent background developed on BILLINGS and an interview of him conducted as soon as possible with results to the Bureau, Memphis and other interested offices. If BILLINGS has been interviewed in the past, he must be re-interviewed concerning the above allegation and full details obtained about that statement by him. Investigation must be started on 4/25/68, and given immediate attention plus expeditious handling.

"TEN MOST WANTED FUGITIVES" PROGRAM

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet, believed fired from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.

An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a 'loner' and 'drifter' whose language and diction reflect a 'rural' quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons.

He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.

On 4/24/68, HUNTER HEGELSON, Division 6, telephonically advised Baltimore that file reviews were being conducted on all threats ever made against MARTIN LUTHER KING, and he referred to Baltimore airtel dated 4/2/65 concerning allegations made by CARLOS LEE BILLINGS of an offer by unknown persons to kill KING for \$50,000.

HEGRISON stated that the Bureau wants all pertinent background developed on BILLINGS and an interview of him conducted as soon as possible with results to the Bureau, Memphis, and other interested offices. If interviewed in the past he must be reinterviewed concerning the above allegation and full details obtained about that statement by him. Investigation must be started on 4/25/68 and given immediate attention plus expeditious handling.



JOHN PHILIP/GALT, 3003 Blueridge Ave., Wheaton, Md., was interviewed 4/18/68/and he furnished the following information:

He knows no one by the name of ERIC STARVO GALT and there is no onein family with a similar name. He has observed photographs, appearing in the local papers, of ERIC STARVO GALT and it does not resemble anyone he can recall seeing, in or out of his family. There have never been inquirite made at or around his residence indicating that anyone by the name of ERIC STARVO GALT might reside in this area. GALT has a brother WILLIAM L. GALT, who resides at Bellview, Md.

GALT is an Agent for the N. Y. Life Insurance Co., Summit Building, 16th St., NW, WDC and has resided at his surrent residence for the past 2 years. Before his current employment, of only about 2 years, GALT was an HMC, Chief Petty Officer, E-7, U.S. Navy, stationed at the U. S. Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Md.

He is described as a white male, DOB at Philadelphia, Pa. 6', 208, brown hair, blue eyes. He is married to RUTH GALT, nee Ruth Kirk, with whom he resides with his two daughters. GALT USN retired from the USN 9/15/67. GALT who is almost completely bald, did not resemble the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT.

GALT could furnish no other pertinent information.

On April 23, 1968, MAYNARD SAYER, co-owner Sayer Brothers Laundry and Linen Supply, 18th and Market Streets, Wilmington, Delaware, was contacted concerning the Thermo-Seal machine used by his laundry.

SAYER furnished three sample copies of tape from his machine, bearing markings 02B-6. These samples are being placed in the 1-A section of this file.

SAYER also furnished a typical sample of marking tape containing their system of 10B-6. SAYER explained that this code would mean as follows:


10 means 10 shirts or other items; B means Lot B; The dash is a filler in the code, and The 6 would refer to the number of bundles.

Concerning the code above, 02B-6, SAYER advised that this code means nothing to him and is not used by his company.

Mrs. LOUISE SCORZIELLO, the machine operator for the Thermo-Seal machine was contacted in conjunction with SAYER and she furnished essentially the same information as SAYER relative to the code and the explanation of the code used.

On April 23, 1968, JOHN AROYAN, owner, Lincoln Cleaners and Dyers, 906 S. Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware,

advised that the Circle Shirt Laundry, same address, is merely the Shirt Department of the Lincoln Cleaners and that they are both one and the same business.

AROYAN furnished four samples of a tape from his Thermo-Seal machine bearing the code 02B-6. AROYAN stated that this code is not used by his company. He furnished a copy of a typical code used and it is as follows:

A-5-6.

AROYAN explained this code as follows:

A is the roll of tape in use; Dash is the filler for the tape code; 5 would be the number of shirts; Dash is the filler; and 6 would be the box number and refers strictly to an in-plant operation.

AROYAN advised that the coding tapes are only used for shirts.

The above samples of code used by Lincoln Cleaners is being placed in the 1-A section of 44-669.
