



Mr. WALTER HAINES, President, Quality Cleaners and Launderers, South Center Street, Westminster, Maryland advised on April 16, 1968, that the Termo Seal Marking Machine which Quality Cleaners formerly owned and used was traded approximately two years ago on another piece of machinery after the Quality Cleaners and Launderers decided to use the Poly-mark machine an English made marking machine with 3/4" tape. He said that the Termo Seal Machine was unsatisfactory for their purposes since the tape was much heavier then they felt they could use and did not stick to the garments properly. He said that he believes their Thermo Seal Machine was traded to the Braun Laundry and Dry Cleaning Equipment Supply House with offices in Washington, D. C. and warehouse in Orange, Virginia. According to Mr. HAINES the Braun Laundry and Dry Cleaning Equipment Supply House has since gone out of business. He further advised that the Thermo Seal Machine which his firm traded had been purchased new by them and had been kept in its original condition until it was traded by his company.

In regards to dancing school leads which were set out in a teletype dated April 15, 1968, it is noted that there are no ballroom dancing schools located in the area covered by the Frederick, Maryland Resident Agency. The only schools located in this area are those which teach classical ballet, ballet and tap dancing to young boys and girls.



On April 25, 1968, Mr. HAROLD WEISBERG, Route 8, Old Receiver Road, Frederick, Maryland, advised that he had furnished copies of photographs, one of an artists conception and the other of an individual who was originally in a group photo, to Mr. HARPER, the city editor of the Frederick Newspaper and had called the FBI in Baltimore from Mr. HARPER's office on April 23, 1968. He said that he did not have extra copies of the king photo for the FBI at this time but felt that Mr. HARPER would make his copies available to the FBI to copy and that this is alright with him, Mr. WEISBERG.

On April 25, 1968, Mr. ROBERT HARPER, City Editor, The Frederick Post, made available the two photographs, attached, which he had received from Mr. HAROLD WEISBERG. He requested that the photos be returned to him after being copied by the FBI, as he intends to do a story on them after he learns the identity of the person in the photograph.

Mr. WEISBERG, in discussing the above photographs with the writer, advised that the photograph of the "sketch" appeared in the newspaper and he is not certain if the photo is of a sketch done by the FBI or by another law enforcement agency, although it allegedly represents a composite sketch of the assasin of Dr. KING. He said that the photograph of the individual was taken from a group photograph of individuals who were waiting by a police car after the assasination of President J. F. KENNEDY in Dallas and was apparently the photograph of a group of persons being taken into custody by the XEXICAN Dallas, Tex. P.D. for questioning just after the assasination of the president occurred. The group photofrom which instant "blow - up" was taken was allegedly made by photographer WILLIAM ALLEN of one of the Dallas newspapers.

It is suggested that copies of attached photographs be made immediately so the attached can be returned to Mr. HARPER. It should be noted that HAROLD WEISBERG is the author of the books "Whitewash" and "Whitewash II" which are critical of the Warren Commission report and of the investigation conducted into the assasination of President KENNEDY.

The enclosed photographs were obtained from ROBERT HARPER, City Editor, Frederick Post and has been given to him by HAROLD WEISBERG, Route 8, Old Receiver Road, Frederick, Maryland.

Mr. WEISBERG in discussing the above photographs stated that the photo of the sketch appeared in the newspaper and allegedly represents a composite sketch of the assassin of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He said the photo of the other individual was taken from a group photograph of individuals who were waiting by a police car after the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY in Dallas and was apparently the photograph of a group of persons being taken into custody by the Dallas, Texas PD for questioning just after the assassina-tion of the President occurred. The group photo from which the individual blow-up was taken, was allegedly made by WILLIAM ALLEN, a photographer for one of the Dallas newspapers.

It is to be noted that HAROLD WEISBERG is the author of the books, "Whitewash" and "Whitewash Number 2" which are critical of the Warren Commission Report and of the investigation conducted into the assassination of President KENNEDY.
