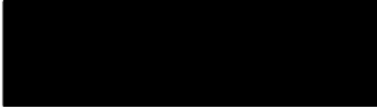

Retelephone call from SA JAMES P. MC CLARREN, 4/17/68, and memo dated 4/18/68.

On 4/17/68, JAMES BIRD was telephonically contacted through mobile telephone #674-1224 at which time he stated he was on his way to Milford, Delaware, where he was to meet the individual he had called the Baltimore Office of the FBI about. BIRD stated he knew the individual only as "Bill", that he was in the construction business and said he was from North Carolina. BIRD stated he would attempt to obtain the individual's true name, address and background information during the course of the evening and furnish this information to the writer.

On 4/18/68, BIRD advised that "Bill" did not show up the previous night as he had said he would. When questioned about his conversation with "Bill" during the afternoon of 4/17/68, BIRD stated that he met "Bill" in the bar at the Milford Hotel, Milford, Delaware. During the course of the afternoon they became quite drunk, and talked about many things, including the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated that in thinking about the conversation while sober he realized it was just drunken talk. He stated he did not remember all the details of the conversation but "Bill" kept saying, in a bragging sort of way, that he knew someone would get him, referring to KING, one of these days. He also made some remark indicating that he had been involved in the killing of a Negro in North Carolina. He gave no details and again this was made in a bragging sort of way.

BIRD described "Bill" as a white male, 30-40 years old, 6'1", 180-190 lbs, long straight black hair, sallow complexion, dressed in dungarees and boots. He did not know where "Bill" was living or working.

BIRD stated he would notify the FBI in the evening if he ran into this individual again.

On 5/6/68, BIRD was recontacted and advised that he had seen the above individual since the afternoon of 4/17/68, and could furnish no additional information as to his identity or whereabouts. BIRD added that he has seen a picture in the newspaper of JAMES EARL RAY, aka, ERIC STARVO GALT, wanted for the murder of KING, and that the individual he met and talked with on the afternoon of 4/17/68, definitely was not identical with RAY.

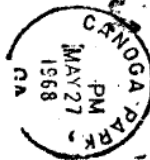

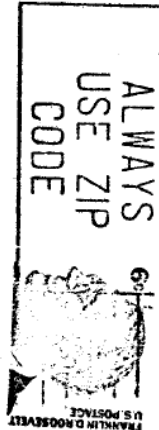

Mrs. SARA WATSON, Registration Section, North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles, Raleigh, North Carolina, advised on May 16, 1968, that 1968 North Carolina license number YN-4493 is issued to WILLIAM HENRY ANDERSON, JR., Taylor Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, to be displayed on a 1967 Mercury, four-door, vehicle identification number 7H15S505488.

She stated that 1968 North Carolina license RK-908 is issued to EUSTUS ALBERTUS COOK, Route 4, Box 41, Roxboro, North Carolina, to be displayed on a 1959 Ford, four-door, vehicle identification number H9NG129049.

Charlotte indices are negative for EUSTUS ALBERTUS COOK.

Charlotte indices indicate that one WILLIAM HENRY ANDERSON, JR., FBI Number 1 578 556, has Baltimore Police Department Number 69-814; and reference is made to reports in the case captioned, "LYNWOOD IRWIN MEARES, UFAP - BREAKING, ENTERING, LARCENY AND RECEIVING," Charlotte file 88-6146, Baltimore file 88-5859; wherein this WILLIAM HENRY ANDERSON, JR., was interviewed. Due to lack of descriptive data, it is impossible to ascertain if identical.

It is suggested that, if desired, the Baltimore Division may wish to further identify WILLIAM HENRY ANDERSON, JR., Taylor Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, furnish same to Charlotte, at which time further checks can be made.
