On 4/17/68, RICHARD MARKUS, Comptroller, Staub Cleaners, Inc., 951 Main Street East, Rochester, N. Y., advised that it has been over five and one half years since his company has used any thermo-seal marking machines. He advised that his cleaning company uses a new marking system and has used this system for approximately five years. He advised that the records of his company do not reflect any information concerning the thurmo-seal machine Serial No. 31586. He advised that it would not be possible for him to determine the disposition of this machine after its use was discontinued by his company.

On 4/18/68, ANDREW IEONARDI, Manager, Ace Cleaners and Laundry, 1441 Dewey Avenue, Rochester, advised that his company is currently using a thermo-seal marker machine. This machine has Serial No. 33763 and was produced by the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, N. Y. This machine uses tape which is 5/16" wide and issues tape of the length of 1 1/8" or 1". He advised that the code used by his company would never begin with an O or a dash and that the code in photograph of instant tape has no significance to him. He advised that his machine has always had a set-up where the first three letters or digits are a 15 point type and the last two letters are larger. He advised that there has never been any variation in the size of letters and digits used.

LILLIE HARRIS, Operator of the thermo-seal marker at Ace Cleaners and Laundry, 1441 Dewey Avenue, Rochester, advised on 4/18/68 that she has operated this machine or similar machines for the company for approximately six years. She advised that the code used by her at this company has never begun with a zero or an O or a dash. She advised that

the first character would always be a l or higher number. She observed the photograph of instant tape and stated that she never saw any tape marking similar to this. She advised that the characters on the machines which she has operated have had the first three characters smaller than the last two characters. She could furnise further information.

On 4/17/68, TED SNYDER, Deluxe Laundry, 436 Monroe Avenue, Rochester, advised that he is the owner of this company. He advised that he has owned this company for approximately two years and that at no time during his ownership has the company used a thermo-seal marker. The former owner of the company was a Mr. GERBER, who is now deceased. Mr. GERBER's wife, SARAH GERBER, of Ashburn Road, Rochester, may be able to furnish further information. He advised that there are no individuals currently employed who have been in the company as a marker for the former employer. He advised that no thermo-seal machine has ever been in his possession and he did not buy such a machine when he purchased the business, 5/16/67.

On 4/19/68, Mrs. SARAH GERBER, 314 Ashburn Street, Rochester, advised that her husband, who is now deceased, was the former owner of the Deluxe Laundry on Monroe Avenue. She advised that her husband had at one time had a thermoseal marking machine in the company, but this was at least seven or eight years ago. She advised that he had the machine for only a few months and discontinued its use when it was not satisfactory. She advised she has no information concerning the disposition of this machine and would not be able to check any records to determine its possible disposition. She advised that no one else would be aware of the disposition of this machine.

On 4/17/68, DANIEL SPEEDY, Speedy Laundry and Cleaners, 190 Court Street, Rochester, advised that he has not used a thermo-seal marking machine for over two years. He advised that he, at one time, had purchased two thermo-seal marking machines from the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, N. Y. He advised that the system which these machines had consisted of five digits in which the last two digits were larger than the first three. He advised that the code used on instant tape had no relationship to any code which he had

ever used. He advised that approximately two years ago, he had sold the two thermo-seal machines to Statewide Machinery, Inc., Rochester.

On 4/18/68, HENRY DENBS, Vice President and General Manager, Statewide Machinery, Inc., 33 Lichfield, Rochester, advised that his company had purchased two thermo-seal machines from Speedy Cleaners in 1966. He advised that these machines had Serial Numbers 31473 and 31475. His company has since sold these machines. The machine with Serial Number 31473 was sold to JAMES CUDNEY, 126 South Broadway, Saratoga Springs, N. Y., on 11/15/67. The machine with Serial Number 31475 was sold to Phil's Cleaners, Manilius, N. Y., on 10/20/66. He advised that both of these machines were purchased from Speedy's and that he has had no further contact with thermo-seal machines.

On 4/18/68, Detective ANTHONY BIONDI, Rochester, N. Y. Police Bureau, telephonically advised that Detective Lieutenant REIS of the police bureau had received a telephone call from a ROBERT GOLDEN of 6 Rawley Street, Rochester, N. Y. GOLDEN advised him that at approximately 8:38 PM on 4/17/68, he had observed an individual arriving at the Rochester Monroe County Airport on American Airlines Flight 744. He believed that this individual resembled ERIC STARVO GALT.

On 4/18/68, ROBERT GOLDEN, 6 Rawley Street, Rochester, telephonically advised that he would come to the Office of the FBI to furnish the information which he had in this matter.

On 4/18/68, ROBERT GOIDEN appeared at the Rochester RA. He advised that he is a University of Rochester student and that at approximately 8:38 PM on 4/17/68 he had observed an individual leaving a plane at the Rochester airport.
