The Mystery of James Earl Ray

It has been three weeks since the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King and the mystery surrounding his killer grows steadily deeper.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation first placed a federal charge of conspiracy to violate Dr. King's civil rights against a man they identified as Eric Starvo Galt, an escaped convict. The FBI said Galt was in Memphis at the time of the murder and that he conspired with a man who may have been his brother. Later, other bureau reports said Galt and the other man are the same person; that Galt really is one James Earl Ray who carefully prepared the figure some persons knew as Galt.

Next the report by Attorney General Ramsey Clark made plain that Dr. King's murder was not a spur-of-the-moment act stemming from emotions aroused by the civil rights leader's participation in the Memphis garbage men's dispute. He said it was carefully planned by at least two persons who went to great lengths to hide their identities and movements:

Then, to add to the mystery, a convict who knew Ray in prison said he never showed any racial bigotry but was always interested in ways to make a fast dollar. He said Ray told him there was an "association" willing to pay \$1 million for the slaying of Dr. King and that if he

ever got out of prison he would try to collect it.

Obviously, the FBI isn't telling all it knows. But the gnawing question looms ever larger—who would have offered a \$1 million "contract" for the killing of Dr. King? Certainly not the usual "contractors," the Mafia, certainly not a white group which had the most to gain from Dr. King's non-violent approach, Russia would have nothing to gain—but what of Communist Cuba with its frequent pledges to create turmoil and strife all over the Americas by any means? (That's an indication of how the mind can wander as the plot thickens).

And there the mystery begins to parallel the assassination of President Kennedy by Lee Harvey Oswald. Both men were loners, both had long series of involvements with the law, both traveled to Mexico, both were in New Orleans, both used similar scope-mounted sniper's rifles and in both cases the question arose—were they hired killers and, if so, by whom? There probably isn't the slightest trace of significance in these parallels but you can't help wondering.

And the mystery will continue to grow until the FBI, an organization of vast resources and proven skill, hopefully quickly picks up the suspect and provides the full, true story.

An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on March 10, 1928. He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a "loner" and "drifter" whose language and diction reflect a "rural" quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons. He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Being forwarded under separate cover is a supply of newspaper mats and proofs for expeditious distribution to all cooperative daily and weekly newspapers in your territory. Additional publications such as shoppers' guides should not be overlooked in obtaining the greatest possible publicity regarding this fugitive.

In most cases, these mats and proofs may be distributed by mail but when circumstances warrant they may be personally delivered by Special Agents. A form letter over the signature of the Special Agent in Charge may be utilized in distributing this material by mail and this letter should point out that the FBI is requesting the aid of the Nation's press in bringing about the prompt apprehension of this badly sought fugitive.

Prompt distribution should be made and additional supplies, if needed, are available at the Bureau. The following number of mats and proofs are being forwarded to your office under separate cover: 150.

As an additional means of securing widespread publicity concerning Ray, offices covering the place of publication of magazines which have previously cooperated in publicizing FBI fugitives should request the assistance of such publications in carrying an article on captioned fugitive. The Bureau press release, copies of which are available in each office, along with a glossy photograph of this fugitive can be furnished. The earliest possible utilization of this material should be encouraged and special attention should be given to publications aimed at minority groups.
