TO LEAD SEARCH FOR KING'S KILLER

PRECEDE: THIS IS THE LAST OF A SERIES BY FAMED NEGRO REPORTER LOUIS LOMAX, WHO HAS BEEN INVESTIGATING THE SEARCH FOR JAMES EARLE RAY, WANTED FOR THE MURDER OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING.

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LOS ANGELES, MAY 3 (NANA)--THE SEARCH FOR THE SLAYER OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. IS MORE THAN A MANHUNT FOR JAMES EARLE RAY, ALIAS ERIC STARVO GALT. FOR THE SEARCH IS THAT OF A TROUBLED NATION TRYING TO LOCATE ITS SOUL, OF A REPUBLIC IN SEARCH OF ITS OWN VALUE SYSTEM.

PRESIDENTIAL ASPIRANT HUBERT HUMPHREY CAME CLOSE TO THE TRUTH A FEW DAYS AGO WHEN HE SAID WE ARE NOT LOST, THAT WE ARE A NATION GROWING UP AND TRYING TO FIND BETTER WAYS. THE ASSASSINATION OF DR. KING HAS INTENSIFIED THE SEARCH FOR BETTER WAYS AND I SUSPECT THERE WILL BE A GOOD DEAL OF FOUNDATION SHAKING, IN HIGH PLACES AT THAT, BEFORE THE ENTIRE MATTER IS PUT TO REST.

I AM SPEAKING SPECIFICALLY OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ITS DIRECTOR, J. EDGAR HOOVER.

"MOST NOTORIOUS LIAR"

IT IS OPEN PUBLIC KNOWLEDGE THAT HOOVER DEEPLY DISLIKED MARTIN LUTHER KING. HE ONCE REFERRED TO KING AS "THE MOST NOTORIOUS LIAR IN THE NATION." NOW HOOVER IS CALLED UPON TO LOCATE KING'S ASSASSIN.

THERE ARE A FEW BLACK PEOPLE INDEED WHO BELIEVE HOOVER WILL WORK OVERTIME IN THIS SEARCH. THE FEELING IS NOT WITHOUT SOME FOUNDATION; EITHER THE FBI IS INEPT OR THE BUNGLING OF THE KING CASE IS INTENTIONAL.

. THE FBI ISSUED A REPORT THAT JAMES EARLE RAY TOOK DANCING LESSONS IN NEW ORLEANS IN 1964-65. THE FBI'S OWN FILES SHOW THAT RAY WAS IN PRISON AT THE TIME.

. SOMEBODY, SOMEHOW, MANAGED TO CIRCULATE THE WRONG FINGERPRINTS FOR RAY. UP UNTIL THE LATTER PART OF THIS WEEK THE GEORGIA BUREAU OF INVESTIGATIONS HAD WRONG PRINTS FOR RAY; HAD HE BEEN ARRESTED IN ATLANTA ON THE DAY HE ABANDONED THE WHITE MUSTANG HE WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS RAY.

LOCAL POLICE SHOVED ASIDE

. THE FBI HAS PREEMPTED LOCAL POLICE FROM THE CASE BY DECLARING THE KING MURDER A CONSPIRACY. THUS THE FULL BURDEN OF THE INVESTIGATION

RESTS WITH THE FBI. IT GUARDS IT JEALOUSLY; KING HAS BEEN DEAD A MONTH NOW AND THE FBI IS YET TO ASK THE COOPERATION OF LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT. YET RAY LIVED IN LOS ANGELES FOR SEVERAL MONTHS AND IT IS KNOWN THAT HE MADE AT LEAST THREE TRIPS FROM LOS ANGELES TO NEW ORLEANS AND THAT HE CARRIED A LOS ANGELES MAN WITH HIM ON ONE OCCASION.

. SHORTLY AFTER I DISCOVERED TELEPHONE BOOTHS IN LOS ANGELES FROM WHICH RAY ALLEGEDLY MADE PHONE CALLS, THE FBI MOVED IN AND CONFISCATED THE TELEPHONE COMPANY RECORDS. THEY AND ONLY THEY KNOW WHAT THOSE RECORDS REVEAL.

BLACKS DON'T TRUST HOOVER

LET ME MAKE IT PLAIN, VERY PLAIN: AMERICA'S BLACKS NEVER HAVE AND DO NOT NOW TRUST EITHER J. EDGAR HOOVER OR THE FBI. THOSE OF US WHO HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO COVER CIVIL RIGHTS STORIES IN THE SOUTH KNOW ALL TOO WELL HOW MUCH THE FBI CAN FUMBLE WHEN IT DOES NOT WISH TO SOLVE A CASE.

THE SUSPICION IS DEFENDED BY THE FACT THAT THE FBI "LEAKED" A STORY TO NEWSMEN THAT SUGGESTED THAT A NEGRO WITH AN ANIMUS TOWARD KING WAS BEHIND THE ASSASSINATION. THE STORY WAS COMPLETELY FALSE, BUT IF NEWSMEN HAD WRITTEN IT, DR. KING WOULD HAVE BEEN SMEARED EVEN IN HIS GRAVE.

THE FBI ATTEMPT TO DISCREDIT THE DEAD CIVIL RIGHTS LEADER WAS SO BLATANT THAT EVEN WHITE REPORTERS WHO KNEW OF THE STORY RECOILED IN FURY.

J. EDGAR HOOVER WOULD DO HIS NATION A GREAT SERVICE IF HE WERE TO ADMIT PUBLICLY HIS DISLIKE FOR DR. KING AND THEN SHARE THE HUNT FOR THE ASSASSIN WITH A LESS PREJUDICED AGENCY.

WANTED: A MIXED COMMISSION

PERHAPS THE CAUSE OF JUSTICE WOULD BE BETTER SERVED IF THE INVESTIGATION WAS PLACED UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF A WARREN-TYPE COMMISSION COMPOSED OF BOTH BLACK AND WHITES.

THE MURDER OF DR. KING WAS AN ORGANIZED AND WELL PLANNED EXERCISE. THIS WAS NOT THE DEED OF "SOME WHITE NUT." RATHER THERE IS A SENSE IN WHICH SOCIETY ITSELF COMMITTED THE ACT; AND IT IS CERTAIN THAT POWERFUL MEN IN AMERICAN SOCIETY WERE PART OF THE DEED MOST FOUL.

UNLIKE CAESAR'S WIFE, J. EDGAR HOOVER IS NOT ABOVE REPROACH WHEN IT COMES TO THE CIVIL RIGHTS ISSUE. LET MR. HOOVER THEN CLEAR THE AIR BY EITHER REMOVING HIMSELF FROM THE INVESTIGATION OR SHARING THE HUNT WITH MEN AND ORGANIZATIONS THAT COMMAND THE FAITH OF THOSE WHOSE CAUSE KING CHAMPIONED.

Referenced memo advised that Professor JOSEPH LONERO, Room 208, Sturgess Hall, Geneseo College, Geneseo, N.Y. telephonically contacted the Buffalo Office on 5/2/68 concerning an anonymous letter in his possession. According to LONERO this letter claims that ERIC STARVO GALT is currently residing in Asantee (Ashantee). There is no place by the name of Asantee located in Livingston County, N.Y., however, Ashantee is located in the Town of Avon, N.Y. on New York State Route 39 south of the Village of Avon, N.Y. There is no Post Office located at Ashantee.

LONERO contacted on 5/2/68 at Geneseo College at which time he made available a copy of the letter he referred to in his telephone call. The letter indicates that there is a group calling themselves "Knights of the Valley" and that they are arming themselves against future rioting and violence by Negroes.

LONERO advised that he has no idea as to who may have sent him this letter and is not acquainted with anyone who lives in the Ashantee area. However, he stated that he is very active in civil rights matters and feels that this is the reason he received this letter. LONERO advised that he has no idea as to what the word Nitschie in the first line of this letter means and knows no one by this name. LONERO advised that he does not have any information to indicate that an organization know as "Knights of the Valley" actually exists.

On 5/2/68, DOUGLAS WELCH, Chief Deputy, Livingston County SO, Geneseo, N.Y., advised that he has no information concerning an organization know as "Knights of the Valley", however, he understands that LONERO has received other letters signed "Knights of the Valley". WELCH stated that LONERO is not well liked by several of the students and faculty at Geneseo College and feels that someone from the college may have sent the letters to LONERO.

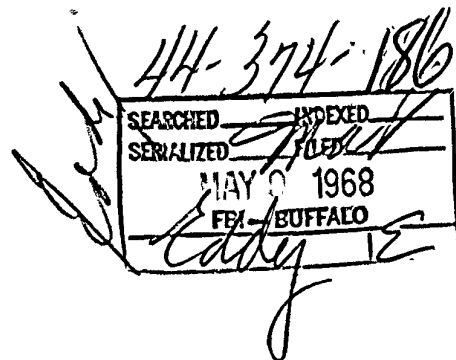

2 New Ray Photos Distributed by FBI

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The FBI distributed yesterday two more photographs of the accused killer of Dr. Martin Luther King — one of them “an extremely good likeness.”

Both were snapshots of James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, an escaped convict accused of shooting Dr. King to death in Memphis April 4.

The “extremely good likeness” is a candid photograph of Ray in a business suit and tie and shows almost his full face, taken in late January or early February somewhere in California.

The other, which the FBI said was taken last November somewhere in Mexico, shows him wearing sun glasses and what appears to be a white sports shirt.

The two new photographs —

the FBI refused to say where or how they were obtained — will be displayed throughout the country along with three others now appearing on FBI wanted posters.

One of the earlier photographs was taken when Ray was graduated from bartending school in Los Angeles early this year. His eyes were closed when the shutter snapped, but they were sketched in by an FBI artist.

The other two photographs were made when Ray entered the Missouri State Prison in 1960 to serve a 20-year sentence for armed robbery.

Ray, who escaped from prison April 23, 1967, by hiding in a truck, is wanted by the FBI for illegal flight to avoid prosecution in Tennessee for Dr. King's murder.

Investigation has determined that the subject, using the name of ERIC GALT, left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67, driving his Mustang automobile, in the company of CHARLES J. STEIN, of Los Angeles. STEIN had formerly been a resident of New Orleans and the alleged purpose of this trip was for STEIN to pick up two children of his sister's who were residing in New Orleans and return them to California. According to STEIN, they arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67 and left New Orleans on 12/19/67. STEIN stayed with relatives and investigation has determined that subject registered at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, on 12/17/67 as ERIC S. GALT and was assigned room 126. The registration card indicated GALT's automobile to be a Mustang bearing Alabama license 1-38993 and his address as 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Ala. The subject, as GALT, stayed at the motel until 12/19/67 when he checked out.

Interviews of motel employees in regards to the subject have been negative in that they cannot recall him.
