On 4/16/68, **YERN TRUCKENHILLER**, 1247 Vine Street, Abilene, Texas, advised that she has worked closely with her brother-in-law, **GLEN E. DUGAN**, 1247 Vine Street, an amateur Genealogist's in the study of descendants in their respective family. She advised that all of the records such as they maintain are in the hands of Mr. DUGAN who could best furnish the data concerning same.

On 4/16/68, **GLEN E. DUGAN**, 1247 Vine Street, advised that their studies of family descendants reflects the name of **GAULT** and **GAUT** in the early histories of the family. He went on to state that his family originated in Scotland and migrated to this country in the early 1800s. He stated that his last trace of the family shows them to be in Pennsylvania. He advised that nowhere in his checking has he found the name to be **GALT** but always **GAULT** or **GAUT**. He stated that the names of **ERIC** and **STARVO** are completely foreign to him and in no instance can he find them entering into the family name.

He advised that the only information he has on the **GALT** family is the private publication "The **GALT** Families Notes on their Origin and their History with Genealogical Lists by **HOWARD SPIELMAN GALT**, DL Ed D, Dept. of Ed, Yenchung University, Peking, China, and Printed by the Sheffield Print Shop Yenchung University, Peking".

Mr. BROWN advised that as far as he can tell this publication was made in about 1900 and there has since, as such, been at least two generations of GALT, which makes the information in this printing somewhat obsolete.

Mr. BROWN advised that it is his belief that the name of GALT appeared in Vermont back in 1837 and there followed a migration to Scotland and thence to America. He stated that it is his belief that some of the individuals being unable to spell their name or through misunderstanding in recordings of the name, the names of GALT and GALT appeared.

Mr. BROWN pointed out that the most recent source of information on the name in question is through the records of the Library of Congress, Local History and Genealogy Section, Washington, D.C., and the Latter Day Saints, Library of the Mormon Church, Salt Lake City, Utah.

On this date, Rev. THOMAS LINTON, President, Tuscaloosa Citizens for Action Committee, Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and liaison source of the Birmingham Division, advised he had learned from LEE JENKINS, 1004 12th Avenue, Tuscaloosa, telephone 752-7775, that JENKINS had talked to a taxi cab driver from Bessemer, Alabama, by the name of HOMER AARON. AARON had advised JENKINS that he picked up two white men in Bessemer, Alabama, approximately a week and a half ago and had driven these two men to the airport in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. AARON had stated to JENKINS that one of these white men strongly resembled the sketch of KING's assassin that was then appearing in the local papers.

LINTON advised he had ascertained from Mr. JENKINS that AARON had been very scared about telling people about this experience, and this is why he had waited so long before he notified the authorities.

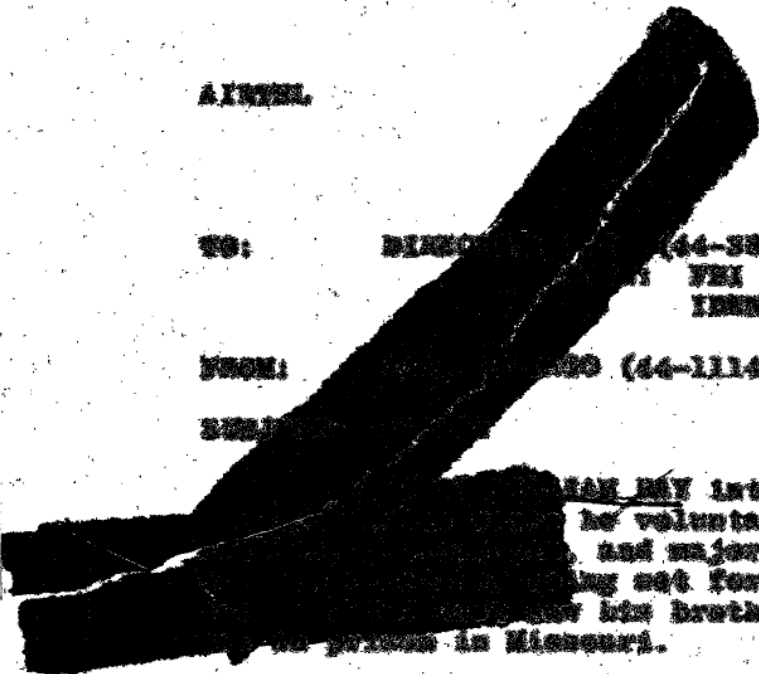

JERRY WILLIAM RAY interviewed this date at [redacted] he voluntarily furnished handwriting and major case prints. Summary of [redacted] set forth this date in separate report. [redacted] his brother in 1964, when JAMES [redacted] in Missouri.

JERRY denies any positive knowledge of or participation in any manner in captioned case. He states he has definitely not seen EARL outside of prison since 1958.

JERRY WILLIAM RAY is described as WMA, DOB [redacted] Quincy, Illinois, 5'8", 175 pounds, medium build, brown eyes, brown hair, high receding hairline.

Enclosed herewith for the Bureau is one stand-up and mug photo of JERRY RAY. Also are the major case prints for him, as well as six sheets of handwriting and hand printing samples which he furnished.

The Identification Division is requested to compare the enclosed fingerprints with the remaining unidentified latent prints in captioned case.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to compare the handwriting samples furnished by JERRY with the handwriting material and the hand printing material previously submitted.

Attached for information regarding JAMES BERTRAM MC ARTHUR HUBKA is one copy of Hubka's prior arrest record and one copy of his presentence report dated 12/10/62 for the violation of Title 18, Section 871, U. S. Code.

On 4/14/68, Officer CONAWAY and Sergeant CORN, Birmingham Police Department, Ensley Division, were contacted and interviewed regarding their possible knowledge of HUBKA but they advised that the only record of anyone of that name arrested by their division was one DAVID HUBKA, age 56, who had been previously arrested for drunkenness on many occasions who had been a trustee at the Ensley Jail when it was in operation. Officer CONAWAY advised that he could locate no record in his files of JAMES HUBKA.

On 4/15/68, Special Agent in Charge ADOLPH M. DOWNING, U. S. Secret Service, advised that he was familiar with the JAMES HUBKA matter because HUBKA had written letters which contained threats against the life of JOHN F. KENNEDY, President of the United States, in 1962. Mr. DOWNING advised that his records indicate that JAMES HUBKA presently resides at 2121 Avenue H, Ensley, Alabama, with his father and mother. He advised that he had interviewed HUBKA on several previous occasions and had learned of HUBKA's intents, personal dislikes for members of the Negro

race and his obsession to insure a separation of the races in all aspects of living. Mr. DOWNING advised that he had had no recent discussions with HUBKA but understood from discussions with USA MACON L. WEAVER, Birmingham, that HUBKA was attempting to initiate criminal prosecution against Dr. A. B. STEPHENS, JR., with regard to STEPHENS psychiatric diagnosis of him in 1962.

On 4/18/68, Mr. JOHN W. MC INTOSH, U. S. Probation Officer, Birmingham, Alabama, advised that he was familiar with JAMES HUBKA due to the fact that he had had long interviews with him on many past occasions. Mr. MC INTOSH said that in his opinion HUBKA was capable of anything and would not be surprised if HUBKA actually attempted to carry out some of his plans using violent methods. Mr. MC INTOSH further stated that he believed HUBKA had sympathies toward Nazi groups and groups which favored segregation of the races. MC INTOSH stated that he believed that HUBKA was presently collecting antique weapons but did not know to the extent which this activity had reached. A review of JAMES HUBKA's file at the U. S. Probation Office indicated that he has a paranoid personality and has been diagnosed as follows by A. H. MILOSKEY, MD, Staff Psychiatrist, Federal Prison, Springfield, Missouri, March 1, 1963:

Schizophrenic reaction; chronic undifferentiated type manifested by looseness of associations, flattening of the affect, impoverished relationship with people, chronic enuresis, history of bizarre thinking (e.g., experimenting with his own feces to see if they would attract mosquitos, while in the service - presentence report), and lack of evidence of progression from adolescent identity confusion.

This agent observed a photograph of JAMES HUBKA taken in 1962 and eliminated him as

Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced today that ERIC STARVO GALT is being sought by the FBI as a fugitive on a Federal charge arising from the fatal shooting of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968.

Director J. Edgar Hoover stated that a Federal complaint was filed by the FBI at Birmingham, Alabama, today, charging GALT with conspiring to violate the civil rights of Dr. King in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the United States Code.

The FBI complaint charges that "On or about March 29, 1968, at Birmingham, Alabama, ... ERIC STARVO GALT and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968, to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Martin Luther King, Jr.... in the free exercise or enjoyment of a right secured to him by the Constitution or laws of the United States; namely, the right to freely travel from state to state. In furtherance of this conspiracy, ERIC STARVO GALT did, on or about March 30, 1968, purchase a rifle at Birmingham, Alabama...."

According to Mr. Hoover, a 30.06 rifle, equipped with a telescopic sight was found near a rooming house on South Main Street in Memphis immediately after the fatal shooting of Dr. King occurred. The rooming house overlooks the Lorraine Hotel and Motel where Dr. King was staying.

Mr. Hoover said that FBI Agents determined that the 30.06 rifle had been purchased from a gun dealer in Birmingham, Alabama, on March 30, 1968. The telescopic sight also was purchased from this dealer.

The FBI Director stated that Galt, who has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer in the past, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang, bearing Alabama license plates, which was located abandoned in Atlanta, Georgia, on April 11, 1968. Investigation disclosed that Galt purchased this car from a private citizen in Birmingham on August 30, 1967. The Mustang's odometer showed that it had been driven more than 19,000 miles between late August, 1967, and early April, 1968.

According to Mr. Hoover, Galt's travels in the Mustang include trips to Los Angeles, California; New Orleans, Louisiana; Birmingham, Alabama; and Mexico, as well as to Memphis, Tennessee, and Atlanta, Georgia. Galt was reported to have been in Memphis on April 3 and 4, 1968, and to have departed from there for Atlanta.

Intensive investigation by the FBI has disclosed that Galt has claimed to have been employed as a cook on Mississippi River vessels and as a Merchant Seaman. He is said to be an avid dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965; in Birmingham during September and October 1967; and in Long Beach, California, from December, 1967, to February, 1968.

Galt left Los Angeles on December 15, 1967, and drove his white Mustang to New Orleans, where he claimed he contacted either an engineering or a contracting firm. He left New Orleans on December 19 and arrived back in Los Angeles on December 21, 1967.

While in the Los Angeles area early this year, Galt took a course at a school of bartending and was graduated on March 2, 1968.

The fugitive is described as a white male. He is approximately 5 feet eight inches to five feet eleven inches tall, and weighs between 160 and 175 pounds.

He is said to be a neat dresser and has a medium build.

Galt has brown hair, which he wears in a "brush" cut. He reportedly has blue eyes; his nose is straight and narrow; his teeth are straight and clean; and he has given his date of birth as

The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his hand. His left ear protrudes farther from his head than his right ear.

According to Mr. Hoover, persons who have met Galt describe him as a "loner" and state his language and diction have a "rural" quality and suggest that he probably does not have a high degree of education.

He is said to drink alcoholic beverages and has a preference for Vodka and beer. He is a fan of western and country music.

Galt should be considered armed and dangerous. Any information concerning him should be furnished immediately to the nearest FBI Office.

The FBI Laboratory advised that pillowcase and bed sheet were found in trunk of 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT, which was located at Atlanta 4/11/68. These items contain Thermo-Seal laundry tapes of approximately same size as tapes on items previously recovered, but are yellow in color and contain code, "2OR-3." In opinion of Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York, the tapes were produced by a different machine than previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point type and the last two characters are 18 point type.

The Textile Marking Machine Company suggests the twenty in above code would be the lot number, the R may mean that this was a return of a batch of laundry, and the three is the bundle number.
