


At 6:20 p.m., instant date, an individual who identified himself as JOHN C. MORRIS, Terrace Apartments, 1124 South 20th Street, Birmingham, advised that he manufactures traffic boards for attorneys and is a lecturer at colleges. He stated that he has a workshop in the vicinity of 2608 Highland Avenue where he prepares his work. He said someone ransacked his place and had gone through all his papers and left the premises with the door ajar. He stated he thought they were FBI Agents.

He was told emphatically and unequivocally that no Agents had trespassed on his property or had been in his workshop, and he was further advised that this was not the method we use in investigations. He was asked for specifics and how he arrived at such a conclusion, and he immediately stated that he was merely asking and he was not accusing.

I requested an appointment with him so I could set him straight, and he stated that my denial was quite clear, he was satisfied, and no personal confrontation was necessary since he accepted the word of the FBI.

On 4/18/68, ASA YOUNG, Personnel Manager, Bemis Bag Co., Talladega, Ala., telephonically contacted the Anniston, Ala. Resident Agent's Office of the FBI to advise an individual by the name of OSCAR HOOVER WILLERSON had been hired by the Bemis Co. on 4/8/68. WILLERSON worked two days and then left the employ of Bemis. He returned on 4/17/68, and when asked for an explanation as to his absence, he stated that he was employed by the U. S. Government to go around to the various plants to determine how they treated Negroes. He stated that he had quit this job and now wished to have his job with Bemis Bag Co. back.

YOUNG stated that the reason he was calling was that this individual acted in a suspicious manner and that he had a small light-colored vehicle which bore a Georgia license plate; also, this individual generally fit the description of that published for ERIC GALT.

On 4/18/68, YOUNG was personally contacted and shown a composite sketch of ERIC STARVO GALT which he stated was not identical with WILLERSON. In addition, he stated there was no resemblance. YOUNG advised that Bemis had refused to hire WILLERSON back and that he had left and has not returned. A review of the personnel records provided the following information:

ERNEST Q. "DUTCH" HOLLAND, Huntsville, Alabama, was interviewed by the writer on 4/21/68 re a telephone call made on the evening of 4/18/68 from Ricker Motors Used Car Lot, Washington & Whittier Blvd., Whittier, Calif., to Mr. EARL CAMPBELL at the Ember Club, Huntsville, Ala., in which the caller identified himself as ERIC STARVO GALT. HOLLAND admitted that he was at Whittier, Calif., on 4/18/68 and that he, in fact, had attempted to make the telephone call to BARL CAMPBELL at the Ember Club in Huntsville. Ala. HOLLAND advised that the call was made from JAMES E. HOLMAN's phone at the Ricker Motor Company Used Car Lot in Whittier. HOLLAND said that CAMPBELL was a friend of his, and HOLLAND thought that he would give him a call from California. When the call could not be completed when made since CAMPBELL was not at the Ember Club, he did not want the bartender at the Ember Club to know who had been calling CAMPBELL, sowhe used a fictitious name. HOLLAND denied that he had used the name ERIC STARVO GALT, but did admit that he had said something which sounded like this, and that the operator had interpreted this into the name of ERIC STARVO GALT.

HOLLAND was very apologetic for any trouble which he had caused, and admitted that this incident was a "very poor joke."



Subject, JAMES EARL RAY, aka, was last known to be in the Atlanta, Georgia, area on 4/5/68. Intensive investigation by the Atlanta office to date has not established mode of transportation utilized by RAY after April 5, 1968, through checks with transportation companies, car rental agencies, etc.

All receiving offices are requested to check car recoveries within their respective divisions of cars stolen from the State of Georgia subsequent to April 4, 1968, and consider same to have been possible mode of transportation for subject RAY. The same consideration should be given to any cars recovered in the near future that were stolen from the State of Georgia after April 4, 1968. In those instances where cars were stolen from Georgia and where the transporter of same cannot otherwise be accounted for, investigation should be conducted to determine if RAY was personswho may have stolen and transported same.
