On 4/22/68, JIMMIE PITTSFORD LAY appeared at the Birmingham Office after being in telephonic contact with SA BARRETT. He advised that he is the brother-in-law of ROBERT CRAWFORD and that he understood that CRAWFORD had telephonically advised that he resembled the picture of suspect, JAMES EARL RAY.

It is noted from observation that LAY does not resemble suspect JAMES EARL RAY in that he has brown eyes, thinning hair with a bald spot on top, and has three tattoos on his arms - a tattoo of "JIMMIE" on his left forearm; a heart on his left bicep; an eagle on his right forearm.
