

Racial Informants, Birmingham Division were checked for information pertaining to PATTON. Sources had no information that PATTON was active in KLAN or other racial organizations in this area.

On May 21, 1968, PATTON was interviewed at his place of employment by SAS SCHWEIN and MARTIN. PATTON denied ever making any type of statement concerning MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated he was opposed to violence of any type and had no feeling one way or the other concerning KING. Mr. PATTON stated he had no knowledge of JAMES EARL RAY and had never been approached by anyone concerning a plot to kill KING. Mr. PATTON stated he spends much of his time in Florida where he owns a motel. He advised that as a realtor and contractor he both rents to and builds for the Negro community and has absolutely no antagonism towards the Negro race.

He advised that he had been an active supporter of GEORGE WALLACE but had stopped supporting WALLACE partly because of WALLACE'S attitude on the racial problem.

In view of the above information no further investigation is being conducted by the Birmingham Division concerning PATTON.

on 4/18/68, JOHNNY W. BATES, 628 Yellowstone Circle, Eirmingham, telephone 836-7594, advised that he is employed with his father at the Medical Center Gulf Station, 500 19th Street South, and further that he practically eats all of his meals at Leo's Restaurant which is located a few blocks away.

He advised that he was in Leo's Restaurant eating the night that MARTIN LUTHER KING was killed but stated that he bought no drinks for anybody in the restaurant. He added he may have made a statement concerning the death of KING since this was the main topic of conversation that evening. He denied having ever made the acquaintance of GALT nor could he furnish any information in this matter.

He was asked if he was a member of a KLAN group which he also denied but without hestiation stated that he had his opinions abouts Negro's.

On the same day Mr. GEORGE LEOS, Owner, Leo's Restaurant, 18th Street and 4th Avenue South, advised that he is personally acquainted with JOUNLY W. BATES as well as his father who presently operate the Medical Center Gulf Station and further XNK that JOHNNY BATES eats most of his meals at his restaurant. Mr. LEOS advised that BATES was in his restaurant the night KING was killed but said that he did not buy any drinks for everyone in the restaurant nor did he hear his say anything about knowing GALT or having any information concerning the murder. He added that everybody that evening was discussing the murder and was uhable to recall specific words spoken by patrons since he does not care to engage in this type of conversation for fear of hurting his business. He added that he has never heard anything unfavorable concerning JOHNNY BATES.

On 5/10/68, a female who would only identify herself as a neighbor of MRS. CAIN, 1701 11th Place South, Birmingham, telephonically advised that MRS. CAIN has a brother who in her opinion bears a likeness of the photos of JAMES EARL RAY. caller refused to identify herself and hung up.

On the same day, MRS. BESSIE JEWELL CAIN, 1701 11th Place South, advised that she is married to CLIFTON W. CAIN, and has four children as well as having lived in the State of Alabama her entire life. She advised that she has six brothers and was displayed photos of RAY at which time she said that this individual was unknown to her. It was pointed out to MRS. CAIN that the FBI was in receipt of a telephone callithat one of her brother's resembled RAY at which time she stated that this was impossible. She at this point advised that she has been receiving suspicious telephone calls of all sorts for the past several months and that a former neighbor of her's who had a mental problem she feels is the source of the telephone calls. She said that the neighbor who has moved away is INEZ CAMPER, 7531 65th Court Way, Birmingham. Mrs. CAIN also related that in the past she has received obscene telephone call form an unidentified male which she has reported to the telephone company as well as to the Birmingham Police Department.

Mrs. CAIN at this point made available a piece of paper with the name O.A. UNANGST, 409 1st Street West, Birmingham, Alabama, which she said she found in her mailbox around the 1st part of April, 1968, and further that a piece of corespondence came to her address for this individual which she believed was a State of Alabama Driver's License which she returned to the U.S. Post Office. She added that this individual was unknown to her and could offer no suggestion why this mail came to her. Mrs. CAIN was quite incoherent during the interview and her mental condition is questionable although her husband was interviewed ka at his place of employment on the following day who states she has suffered no mental disorders.



EUGENE SMITH MANSFIELD, Barnes Lane, Burne, La. advised SA. L. M. SHEARSE, JR., on May 28, 1968, that he has been working in elimore drilling for Penrod Drilling Co., and to the best of his recollection he heard of the killing of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING while on a rig in the Gulf of Mexico.

He advised that since the date of the killing, he has had occasion to talk with several individuals whom he considers members of one Klan or another, and there is no indication from these conversations that the killing was a Klan action.

MANSFIELD was shown to 4182 of JAMES EARL HAY, and he said he had observed an individual who somewhat resembled MAY in a tavern at Tuscalossa, Alabama, in the period shortly after 1/17/68. This individual who resembles the photograph of EAY appeared to be friend of a dark-haired barmaid, name possibly MELL, who worked in tavera behind Johnny's Place at Broad Street, and Greensboro Avenue. The dark-haired barmaid has a sister, a redhead, who works at Pat's Bar, 9th Street and 22nd.

MANSFIELD said he could not say that this individual is identical with may; however, the resemblance is enough that the individual could be RAY.

MANSFIELD requested that his identity not be revealed as the source of the information if it is to be checked out.

By way of background information concerning MANSFIELD, he advised that he is known to several FBI offices, that he was formerly Grand Dragon of United Klans of America at Houston, Texas, and quit in 1961. He said he is well acquainted with BORBY SEELTON of the UKA, and that his brother BILLY WAYNE MANSFIELD, was secretary of the UKA subsequent to the death of ALVIE SYEES in South Carolina.

MANSFIELD said he is also acquainted with L. E. MATTHEWS, reportedly a Klan member at Jackson, Mississippi, but actual knowledge of his membership is unknown to MANSFIELD.

On 5/31/68, J. L. CAMP, Route 1, Silver Creek, Georgia, operator of the County Line Tavern, advised that 5 or 6 weeks ago, a man came to the tavern after having been picked up as a hitchhiker by a Mr. BALDWIN. The man had no luggage and when he indicated need for employment, CAMP offered him a job on CAMP's nearby-farm. The man gave only the name of JERRY MOSELEY, and when asked concerning relativessor next of kin, indicated only that he had a mother in Gadsden, Alabama. He said the man seemed to be inexperienced in farm work, and after remaining there a time. asked permission to go to Alabama, supposedly to pick up his clothing. He returned within a few days, indicating he had been unable to locate his mother, and did not return with any clothing. He occasionally mentioned having also been in Birmingham, Alabama, in the past, and having worked for a cafe of some type. CAMP allowed the man to stay in a small house trailer next to the tavern, and while there, he was not visited by anyone, and never mentioned any relatives or friends by name.

On 5/27/68, CAMP allowed MOSELEY to work as a bartender in the tavern, and observed him making mistakes in customer's change. On the morning of 5/28/68, MOSELEY was noted to be missing and that is the last he has seen or heard of this person. He later determined that t\$26 was missing from the previous day's proceeds.

On 5/30/68, CAMP observed a picture of JAMES EARL RAY, aka ERIC GAULT, in a newspaper, and decided that MOSELEY bore a resemblance to RAY. He described MOSELEY as being a W/M, age 28-30, 155 lbs., 5' 11", with dark brown or black hair, and had

what appeared to be acne on his face. He stated at times the man acted in a manner to indicate he might have been mentally unbalanced. He did not know how the man left, but he had no automobile, and assumed that he hitchhiked a ride with someone.

On 5/31/68, HENRY BALDWIN, Route 1, Aregon, Georgia, advised he had picked up a man as a hitchhiker several miles south of the County Line Tavern, 5 or 6 weeks ago. The man was hitchhiking north, and he transported this person as far as the County Line Tavern. He understood that the owner of the tavern had later offered the man a job. He said when he picked him up, the man had no luggage and did not advise him concerning his name. He said after observing a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, that there appeared to be some resemblance, although in his mind, he did not believe they were the same persons. He said judging by the man's actions, and his mode of travel and conduct, he believed very likely that the man was wanted.

On 5/15/68 THOMAS BRITTON, Haleyville, Ala., was contacted and voluntarily furnished the following information:

BRITTON was interviewed concerning several names of prisoners at MSP who are believed inmates there at the time JAMES EARL RAY was incarcerated at the prison. BRITTON made the observation concerning Major Poiry, Security Officer at MSP that he was "strict and rough and a pretty square guy, who had favorites among the prisoners"; however, he did not know if RAY was "one of the boys". BRITTON stated he did not know of any inmate by the name of MARION DITTY JANSEN. When asked about a prisoner whose last name was BAGBY, a Negro, age 60, he stated that he knew this person and believed he was a janitor in the Recreation Department and also had served as "headknocker" in the mattress factory.

BRITTON stated that an inmate by the name of JIMMY JAMES CARPENTER worked in the tag plant and might have known RAY, as he believed RAY also worked there at one time. BRITTON recalled when the name MILTON ZAVALASKI was mentioned to him that this was the name of the prisoner he knew as "BOSTON". BRITTON advised that an inmate by the name of JAMES HIGH CARPENTER, who worked in the Vegetable Room at MSP was a "real punk, a bull thrower, and a sex pervert". BRITTON recalled that inmate JOHN KENNETH HURTT was a trusty in A Hall and was onewn of MAJOR POIRY's boys and received special privileges from him such as being allowed to wander outside of his cell after hours and could have the opportunity to make a lot of contacts, but did not know his relationship with RAY.

BRITTON stated that he had a son by the name of CHARLES THOMAS BRITTON who lived with his step-father, CHARLES W. CLARK at Hopewell, Virginia. BRITTON stated that he had very little regard for CLARK and that there was "no love lost between them".

In regards to JAMES EARL RAY, BRITTON advised that to the best of his knowledge, RAY never used amphetamines and that he never heard RAY mention that he used narcotics before his incarceration at MSP. BRITTON advised that if RAY was not called by his last name, he was always referred to as "JIMMY". BRITTON stated he never heard RAY speak of any cousin or any other relative he had in Birmingham during conversations which he (BRITTON) had with him.

On 5/23/68 THOMAS BRITTON, Haleyville, Ala., was interviewed and furnished the following information:

BRITTON stated that he had no knowledge of what magazines or other publications that JAMES EARL RAY read at MSP except the one that he has previously mentioned, "The Birmingham Post Herald" newspaper which he (BRITTON) used to give him. BRITTON stated that MAJOR POIRY used to, as a matter of routine, inspect the prisoners' cells and that he therefore might have a better idea of what publications he might have found or noticed in the cell of RAY when he made these inspections.

In regard to MAJOR POIRY, BRITTON stated that he recalled hearing that POIRY was mixed up with Warden NASH over a PX scandel involving some \$12,000, which allegedly caused NASH to commit suicide, but that he did not know to what extent, if any, that POIRY was involved in the scandel except that it was prison gossip that he had something to do with it.

BRITTON advised that since he was last contacted, he had been "mulling over" the names mentioned to him during the previous interview and that the name of JAMES CARPENTER, who worked in the vegetable room, started him thinking that CARPENTER, because of his job, had access to the dock where bread was loaded on the trucks that were going outside the prison wall and could have helped RAY escape. He said that it was his opinion that the truck drivers of the Renz and Church Prison Farm trucks who carried the bread would have to know if RAY was making his escape in their trucks. He stated the only truck driver he could remember was the one who drove the Renz Farm truck whom he knew as RENO, who he believed came from St. Louis, Mo.
