Inasmuch as no reference was made to the FBI and the fact we have already, on the record, contacted HANES for any information in his possession; and in view of the fact HANES is obviously seeking publicity to maintain his connections with this case, I feel no further action is necessary and this memorandum is for your information.

ADDENDUM: 3/14/69

Today TAYLOR telephoned me to say he had talked briefly to HANES and brought up the television interview. TAYLOR requested HANES to furnish him any information and offered to set up a three-way conference with the FBI, USA's Office and HANES at HANES' convenience. HANES mentioned that he had offered to give information to the FBI previously but the FBI did not seem too interested and TAYLOR said he told HANES this was an incorrect impression since HANES was trying to "trade information" with the FBI and the FBI was not in a position to furnish any information from its files to HANES with a pending trial of the subject. According to TAYLOR, HANES reluctantly agreed this might be the case. No agreement was made for a conference but the door was left open in the event the three possible parties could reach mutual agreement as to a time and place.

I told TAYLOR the position of the FBI was still the same, i.e.; we will receive any information HANES has to offer at any time. I told TAYLOR I could see no objection to an agent of this office meeting with TAYLOR and HANES at a mutually agreeable time to receive any information HANES might have. I also told TAYLOR I felt HANES did not have anything new to offer but was only interested in furthering publicity which would benefit HANES. TAYLOR seemed uncertain as to whether he wanted to pursue the conference idea any further and asked when you would return which, I gathered, means he wants to talk to you further about it.

Mr. DON WOOD, Aeromarine Supply Service, contacted the Birmingham Division following the conclusion of the case against JAMES EARL RAY and made known his desire to have returned to him certain items of evidence in the possession of the local prosecutor in Memphis. These items are one Remington Model 700 .243 caliber rifle; nine boxes of .243 caliber Norma cartridges; one set of Redfield ring mounts for a telescopic sight and the original invoice plus the yellow copy reflecting this sale.

WOOD is most anxious to have these items returned to him and although he feels they eventually will be he wants to alleviate any possibility that the return of these items may be forgotten by the local prosecutor.

Due to WOOD's extreme cooperation with this Bureau and his excellent attitude and help furnished in connection with this investigation, it is requested that Memphis contact prosecutors CANALE and BRASLEY and make known WOOD's request for the return of these items.

William Bradford Huie has written a third article for "Look" magazine. The article appears in the issue dated April 15, 1969, but this issue was circulated on April 1, 1969. A review of the article reveals that James Earl Ray allegedly registered at the Travelodge Motel, Five Points, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29, 1968; at a motel near Florence, Alabama, on April 1, 1968; and at a motel near Corinth, Mississippi, on April 2, 1968. It is to be noted that Ray, using the name Harvey Lowmyer, negotiated the purchase of a rifle at the Aeromarine Supply Company, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29 and 30, 1968. On April 3, 1968, he was registered at the Rebel Motel in Memphis, Tennessee.

In an effort to establish whether or not Ray was in contact with any individuals immediately prior to the assassination, appropriate investigation should be conducted by the Birmingham and Jackson Offices. It should be understood that there is to be no indication made whatsoever that the following investigation has any connection whatsoever with the case involving James Earl Ray.

Birmingham and Jackson Offices should make inquiries of the motels in or near the cities indicated above to determine the identities of individuals registered during the period March 29 to April 3, 1968. Efforts should be made to identify all individuals listed, as well as

obtaining descriptions and registrations for the automobiles of such persons. A review of such records might indicate whether any one individual might have accompanied Ray or been in contact with him during this period. Pertinent or questionable registration records should be obtained if possible for examination by the FBI Laboratory.

Memphis should insure that the Bureau is kept currently advised of pertinent developments in this case, particularly all aspects of court action since the death of Judge Battle on March 31, 1969.

Transmitted herewith are two Xerox copies of a registration card located on April 11, 1969, at the Birmingham Travelodge Motel, 521 South 20th Street in the Five Points South area of Birmingham recording the registration of ERIC S. GALT, 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama, on 3/29/68 who is undoubtedly identical with RAY. Registration card reflects he was assigned Room 307, one in party, and charged for one day, departing at an unspecified time on 3/30/68. He was in possession of a 1966 Mustang with Alabama license 1B8992 which has previously been identified as having been registered by RAY at Birmingham on 10/2/67 under the alias ERIC S. GALT with the same residence address indicated. Since guest registrations are maintained in a very haphazard manner at the Travelodge Motel, it was difficult to locate this card since an entire package of guest registrations with the numerical series 18500 could not be located in a storeroom box where other registration cards for the year 1968 were examined.

No local or long distance telephone calls were charged to the room and no information obtained which indicated any association on the part of GALT with any other guests.

Upon completion of the investigation of motels in the Florence, Alabama area, appropriate FD-302's will be furnished the Memphis Office. A copy of GALT's registration is being furnished the Memphis Office at this time and a similar copy furnished Jackson for possible assistance in conducting investigation of motels in the Corinth, Mississippi area.

Request of the Bureau:

The FBI Laboratory is requested to compare the handwriting appearing on the attached Xerox copy of Registration Card #18586, noting that GALT wrote all entries down through the description of the Mustang. Request that Birmingham and Memphis be advised of the result.

Through the cooperation of Mr. and Mrs. WALTER C. MADDOX, Managers, Travelodge Motel, 821 South 20th Street, Agents were allowed to search a storeroom on the second floor of the motel wherein registration cards are maintained in a large box and on shelves for previous guests at the motel. From an entire list of guests which is prepared each date, a notation appeared on the list dated March 29, 1968, under the name "GALT" who was assigned Room 307, with the guest registration card indicated as being number 18586. No other entry listing of guests during the pertinent period reflected the name "GALT," nor was there noted any name which during previous investigation might have any connection with the registration of "GALT."

After a diligent search, it was determined that one packet of the registration cards beginning with the number 18500 and contained 500 such cards was not located with the registration cards of that period; however, card number 18586 was subsequently located on the said day in the packet which had been removed from the box, and the following information obtained from this card:

ERIC S. GALT, residence 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama, registered on March 29, 1968, and was assigned Room 307.

There was only one in his party and he was charged for one day at a rate of \$8.00, plus .48¢ State Tax, total \$8.48. He was in possession of a 1966 Mustang automobile with Alabama license 138993. No telephone calls, local or long distance, were charged to the room from which he departed at an unspecified time on March 30, 1968.

Mr. and Mrs. WALTER C. MADDOX, Travelodge Motel, are maintaining possession of this registration card should its production in court in the future be desired.
