At 12:10 A. M., 4/7/68, SA CHARLIE TANNIAN, Boston Division, telephonically contacted the Charlotte Division and advised as follows:

The word "Murkin" is the code name given to investigation concerning the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. A Mrs. ELEANOR POWERS, Reade Hotel, Boston, telephonically contacted the Boston Division the night of 4/6/68, and confidentially furnished the following information with request that her identity be concealed in view of her friendship with the BREECE family.

She is acquainted with one GEORGE WILBUR BREECE. white male, age 22, six feet, sandy hair, a prominent nose, of Fayetteville, N. C. He is the son of JOE WILBUR BREECE who operates a funeral parlor at 123 Bow St., Fayetteville, N. C. He bears a strong resemblance to the composite sketch of the suspect in the KING assassination. She recalls GEORGE WILBUR BREECE as a wild young man whose family gave him a white Mustang automobile a year or two ago. She ; stated he has used the alias of JOHN WILLARD which is the name used by the suspect at Memphis.

SA TANNIAN stated he had contacted Supervisor DAVID A. SCHMIDT, Division 6, of the Bureau, by telephone who instructed that the Boston Division telephone this information to Charlotte and follow it with a confirming teletype. SA TANNIAN advised that all leads in this matter are being handled on a most expedite basis.

At 12:20 A. M., 4/7/68, the above information was furnished to SA ROBERT H. CAVERLY at Fayetteville, N. C.

WILLIAM JOYNER, Bureau of Identification, Fayetteville, N. C., PD, advised 4/7/68, BREECE is son of J. WILBUR BREECE who operates funeral home at 123 Bow St., Fayetteville, N. C., which is located directly across the street from the PD.

JOYNER is acquainted with BREECE and saw him last week in Fayetteville in U. S. Army fatigues. He was driving a late-model green automobile, believed to be a Mustang or Cougar, and over the sun visor was a sign with the words "Army Mortuary Service

JOYNER stated BREECE is of similar stature and bears a resemblance to composite photograph of suspect in KING assassination; however, the nose on the photograph is too long for BREECE;

Desk Sgt. STEVENSON, Provost Marshal's Office, Ft. Bragg, N. C., advised his records contain "as of 2/29/68" the name of Specialist Fourth Class GEORGE W. BREECE, ASN RA 12981065 who was assigned to the Headquarters Co., U. S. Army Garrison, Ft. Bragg, N. C.

Sgt. BURKE, Headquarters Co., USAG, Ft. Bragg, N. C., advised he has no records available at this time of the morning to indicate whereabouts or duty status of BREECE but stated these records would be available in the later morning hours or possibly by Monday morning.

Investigation continuing and results will be furnished Charlotte 4/7/68 (or possibly 4/8/68).



Neighbor advised that CHARLES GIBSON last visited MAUDE GIBSON about Christmas, 1967.



All Agents are instructed to immediately contact criminal, security and racial informants. Positive information should be telephonically furnished Charlotte Office. Negative information should be included in a memorandum captioned "MURKIN" to reach Charlotte no later than 4/12/68.
