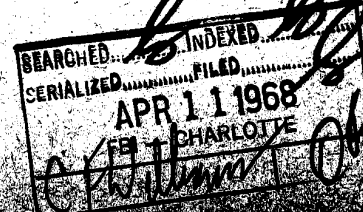

IN JUNE, SIXTYSIX, HE ENTERED ON ACTIVE DUTY, USMC, UNDER THE  
ENLISTED RESERVE PROGRAM, SIX MONTHS ACTIVE DUTY TOUR AND COMPLETED THIS  
TRAINING ON DECEMBER TWENTY, SIXTYSIX. AT TIME OF RELEASE, HE WAS ASSIGN  
ED TO COMPANY F. SECOND BATTALION, SECOND MARINES, SECOND MARINE DIVISIO  
NMF, CAMP LEJEUNE. DURING EARLY PART OF DEC. , HIS OUTFIT WENT TO VIEQUE  
ON MANEUVERS AND APPROXIMATELY THIRTY RESERVISTS REMAINED AT CAMP LEJENE  
PROCESSING FOR THEIR DISCHARGE. DURING THIS PERIOD, AN M FOURTEEN RIFLE  
WAS STOLEN AND EXTENSIVE INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED BY MILITARY AUTHORITIES  
THIEF NOT IDENTIFIED. IN CONVERSATION WITH ORTHER MEMBERS OF THE  
RESERVISTS, A MARINE RESERVIST FROM COLUMBIA, SOUTH CAROLINA, NAME NOT  
RECALLED, WAS MENTIONED AS POSSIBLY HAVING STOLEN THE RIFLE. THE UNSUB

HAVEING HOME RESIDENCE IN EITHER GEORGIA OR ALABAMA, AND THEY OFTEN WENT ON WEEKEND LEAVES TOGETHER. SHORTLY BEFORE PISKORSKI'S RELEASE FROM ACTIVE DUTY AND WHILE TALKING WITH PARRISH, PARRISH TOLD PISKORSKI THAT HE WAS CONCERNED REGARDING THE UNSUB MARINE SINCE IN CONVERSATION WITH PARRISH, HE HAD MENTIONED HE WAS GOING TO KILL MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PISKORSKI ALSO ADVISED THAT IN BULL SESSIONS DURING THEIR SIX MONTHS TRAINING, THE UNSUB MARINE HAD STATED THAT HE HAD ONCE SHOT A NEGRO AND THAT HE HAD ONCE RUN OVER A NEGRO WITH HIS AUTOMOBILE. PISKORSKI DESCRIBED THIS INDIVIDUAL AS HAVING A DEEP-SEATED PREJUDICE AGAINST THE NEGRO PEOPLE.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF THIS UNSUB FURNISHED BY PISKORSKI AS FIVE FEET ELEVEN INCHES TO SIX FEET TALL, WHITE, MALE, LIGHT BROWN HAIR, SLIM, ONE HUNDRED FIFTY TO ONE HUNDRED SIXTY POUNDS AND IN HIS MIDDLE TWENTYIES.

PISKORSKI ADVISED THAT ALL OF THE RESERVISTS WERE RELEASED TO INACTIVE DUTY DURING THE MONTH OF DEC. AND THAT IT WAS HIS RECOLLECTION THAT UNSUB AND PARRISH WERE RELEASED PRIOR TO HIS OWN RELEASE WHICH WAS ON DECEMBER TWENTY, SIXTYSIX.

HE ALSO POINTED OUT THAT UNSUB MARINE HAD ATTAINED HIGH MARKS IN THE OUTFIT ON THE RIFLE RANGE AND WAS AN EXPERT MARKSMAN. PISKORSKI COULD RECALL NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND INDICATED HE WOULD REVIEW PAPERS IN ADDRESS BOOK IN ATTEMPT TO DEVELOP FURTHER IDENTIFYING DATA RE BOTH INDIVIDUALS.

RE: MURKIN

By teletype April 11, 1968, to all SACs, the Bureau advised as follows:

"Investigation has established that an individual using the name ERIC STARVO GALT was in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968, reportedly driving a 1966 white Mustang with Alabama license 1-38993. The Bureau is anxious to locate this individual for questioning in connection with this matter.

"All offices covering points of exit from the country should initiate a check to determine whether or not ERIC GALT has departed the country.

"All offices are to contact the appropriate police departments in your territory to insure that all law enforcement agencies are covered by an All Points Bulletin to the effect that ERIC STARVO GALT is wanted for questioning by the FBI.

"GALT is described as a white male, 5'11", 175 pounds, blue eyes, brown hair, born 7/20/31, according to his driver's license.

"GALT'S car is described as 1966 white hard-top Mustang, 1968 Alabama license 1-38993, VIN 6T07C190647. The car had four individual red plastic floor mats, muffler painted silver when purchased by GALT in 8/67.

"Under no circumstances should it be indicated to anyone at any place the nature of the case in which GALT is wanted for questioning by the FBI."

One JEFF CROWELL, Wadesboro, N.C., should be considered as a possible suspect in captioned matter. CROWELL in some respects appears similar to the artist's conception of the Unsub. CROWELL has a nose and receding hairline similar to artist's conception.

CROWELL worked for the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Co., Charlotte, N.C., until approximately two years ago, selling yellow page advertising. At that time he drove a late model red Mustang with an extra powerful engine. He also had a Citizens Band Radio in the car and always a rifle, type unknown. CROWELL is originally from the Wadesboro, N.C., area but continually traveled throughout N.C. for Southern Bell, and on weekends it was his habit to travel out of the state on vacation. Consequently, he maintained no permanent residence.

He left this business, however, and no information is known concerning his activities since that time.
