He stated he was not personally familiar with it since Mr. SMITH operated at the other laundry and handled all of the laundry for his company.

On April 10, 1968, Mr. ERNEST SMITH, Manager, Twin City Laundry and Dry Cleaners, 102 East Trade Street, Sanford, North Carolina, advised that he handles all the laundry for both Twin City Laundry and Star Laundry for the owner, Mr. BILL TETTERTON. He stated he utilizes a thermo seal marking machine manufactured by the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York, to place tags as laundry marks on all launders. He

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stated he can use up to ten colors in the tags and makes use of all of them, including red. Mr. SMITH was apprised that the FBI was trying to locate a laundry who had placed the number 02B-6 or D2B-6. Mr. SMITH pointed out that he always starts his laundry mark with the number one and the second is a letter and the third is a number 1 through 20. He stated that neither the number 02B-6 or D2B-6 would ever have been used by him. He stated that probably many laundries throughout the country use this machine and he would have no idea where the laundry could be located that would utilize this marking system.

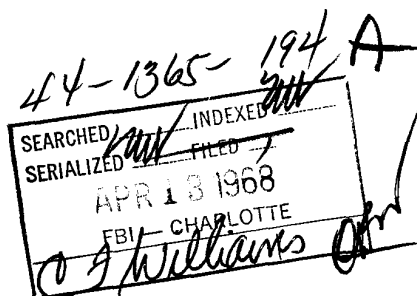

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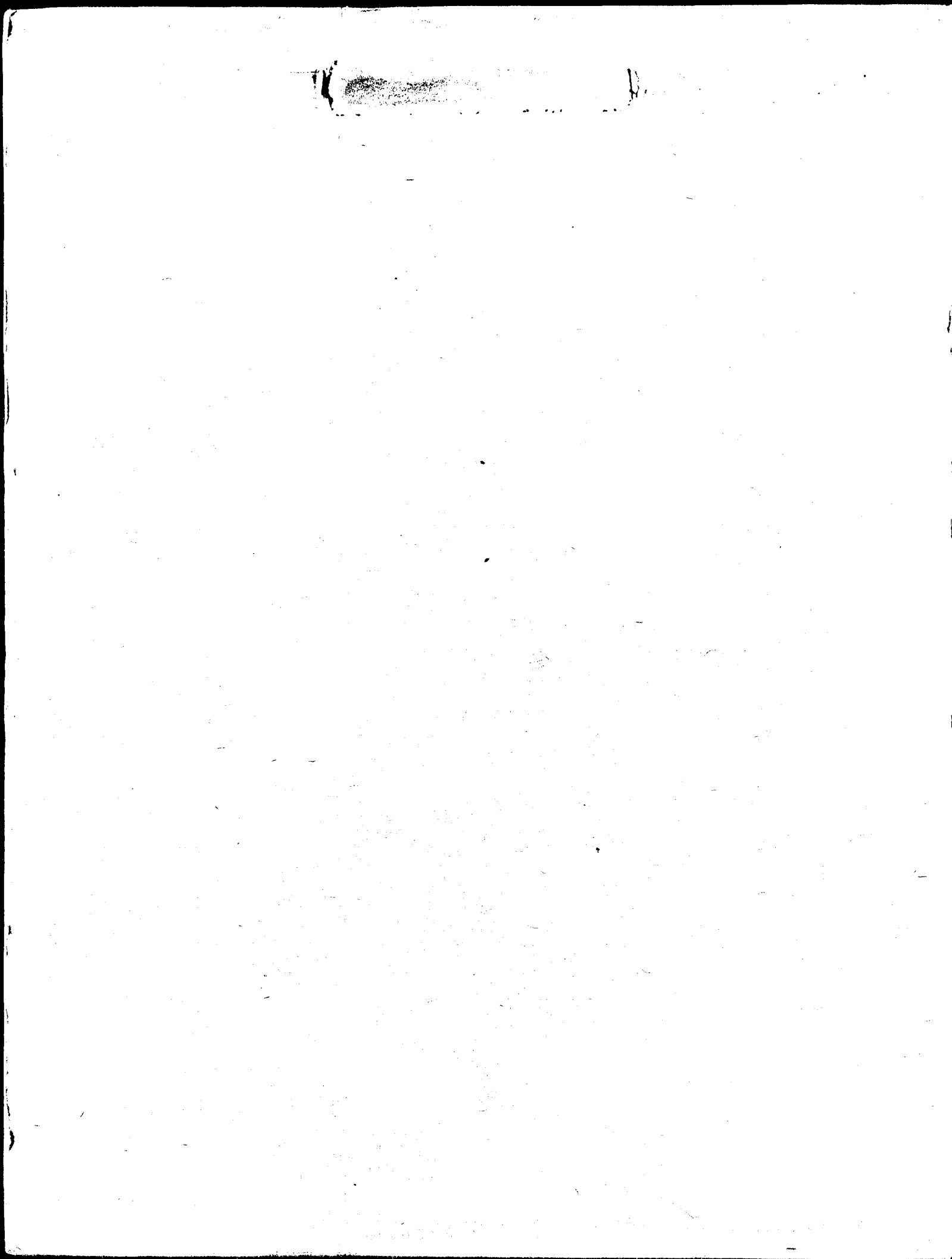
