On 4/10/68 CE 1812-R advised that Crowell is still employed at Fiber Industries, Salisbury, N.C. and has not been active in the klan since he married and is not presently a member of the klan. Informant stated that he will ascertain whether subject was in Salisbury during the pertinent period.

On 4/11/68 Frank Hall, Asst. Personnel Manager, Fiber Industries advised that Arthur Lee Crowell worked 3pm to 11pm (second shift) March 29, 30 and 4/3/68 and was off on 4/4/68 but returned to work on 4/5/68.

On 4/11/68 an effort was made to locate CROWELL at his residence without success.

On 4/11/68 Homer Agner, Rt. 1, Salisbury, N.C. a neighbor of CROWELL advised that Crowell was at home on 4/4/68.

On 4/12/68 CE 1812-R advised that he had ascertained that CROWELL had not left Salisbury Area as best he could determine on 4/4/68.

On 4/11/68 a 1967 Red Mercury 1968 N.C. 3180 listed to Maxine Agner Crowell, Rt. 1, Box 513, Salisbury and a 1967 black Chev. convertible, 1968 N.C. 3179 listed to Crowell, Rt. 1, Box 513, were observed in Crowell's yard which is brick house in front of Ellis school.

Mr. HALL also advised that he had records for the last five or six years for the ARTHUR MURRAY School of Dance, formerly operating in Asheville, N. C., but has been closed for several months. He later advised that a search of these records failed to reflect anyone by the name of GALT, LOWMYER or WILLARD, as being students at this school.

On the late afternoon of 4/18/68, Trooper HARRY L. WILLIAMS, N. C. Highway Patrol Trooper station in Catawba County, N. C., telephonically contacted the Hickory RA and advised that he saw the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT in the newspaper today and stated that he is certain that he encountered GALT while conducting a road block in Catawba County on the evening of 4/9/68. [WILLIAMS was immediately personally contacted by SA SHERIDAN at which time WILLIAMS furnished the following information:]

On the evening of 4/9/68, WILLIAMS and Trooper MARVIN WRIGHT were participating in a road block check on US 321 at the intersection of N. C. Highway 10, inside the city limits of Newton, N. C. The road block was set up as a result of the general racial situation following the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. and the purpose of the road block was to locate and confiscate from motor vehicle alcoholic beverages and firearms that might have been in the possession of motorists. The road block lasted from approximately 7:30 p.m. until approximately 11:00 p.m.

Sometime between 9:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m., 4/9/68, a white male driving a 1955 or 1956 Dodge, 4-door, automobile was stopped by WILLIAMS. WILLIAMS described this automobile as being three toned, that is, having an off white colored top, a dark green hood and trunk, with a strip of green around the sides, partially on the doors, and again having an off white bottom. WILLIAMS did not notice the color of the interior of this automobile. This vehicle was heading north on 321. WILLIAMS specifically remembers that this vehicle was bearing a 1968 Fla. license with the prefix "10W-!" There were four or five digits after the dash but WILLIAMS did not remember these numbers. The white male driving the vehicle was alone and the vehicle was heavily loaded with luggage, having possibly five or six suitcases in the back.

Trooper WILLIAMS stated that in his own mind he has definitely identified the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT

as being identical with this individual he stopped. He stated that there is no doubt in his mind regarding the matter and stated that he would "stake his life on it."

When WILLIAMS stopped this individual, he asked him for his drivers license and registration. The individual there upon presented a valid State of Florida driver's license. WILLIAMS does not remember the name of the drivers license but remembers that it did contain a first, middle and last name. He also noted that the name was uncommon to this area of North Carolina. WILLIAMS stated that this last name was a short name and he believes there were four letters in the last name. WILLIAMS stated that the name could have been "GALT." He stated that if the name was any of the three names of GALT, LOWMYER or WILLIARD, it would have been GALT or LOWMYER.

WILLIAMS stated that he does not remember the street or city address or license number on the drivers license displayed to him. He stated, however, that he specifically remembers that the drivers license listed the driver's occupation as a pilot. WILLIAMS asked the individual what airlines he flew for and the individual gave a name of some not well known airline. WILLIAMS does not now remember the name of the airline given but remembers that the airline had two names to it. He does not remember the individual talking about any cities in Fla. or where he worked.

The individual never did display a registration for the vehicle and the matter of the registration was not pursued by WILLIAMS.

WILLIAMS observed a map folded on the front seat of the vehicle. This map included several southeastern states in the United States. WILLIAMS picked up the map and noted the driver had a route marked out from somewhere in deep central Georgia to Wytheville, Va. WILLIAMS noted that this route marked out constituted almost a straight line. The line ended at Wytheville, Va. WILLIAMS asked the individual where he was going and the individual said he was going on vacation to Wytheville, Va., to visit with some friends or relatives. The individual said he was then going to either Charleston or Bluefield, West Virginia. WILLIAMS

did not remember which of these two towns in West Va. the individual mentioned. The individual did not mention anything specific about his friends or relatives in Wytheville, Va., or Charleston or Bluefield, W. Va., and did not indicate how long he was going to stay at any of these places.

WILLIAMS then instructed this individual how to get on Highway 16 north heading out of Conover, N. C. WILLIAMS advised that the entire conversation took place in about 1½ minutes.

In commenting on the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT, WILLIAMS advised that the individual he stopped, whom he believes to be GALT, did not have cheeks as full as are GALT's cheeks in the photograph. He stated that the individual had a face considerably less fleshy than is shown in GALT's photograph. He stated that the individual he stopped had noticeable features in that he had a sharp pointed chin, a long and narrow and pointed nose, and large ears. He also noted that the individual's hair was much shorter than is depicted in GALT's photograph and his hair was brushed straight back. He advised that the individual's face was considerably narrower and longer than is depicted in GALT's photograph.

In describing the individual's composure, WILLIAMS advised that the individual was calm and not excited. He stated that the individual was reserved in his talk, answered questions precisely but did not volunteer information. WILLIAMS described the individual as well-groomed, clean shaven and immaculate in appearance. He stated that the individual gave him the impression that he would be precise in everything he did.

WILLIAMS furnished the following description of this individual from memory:

Trooper MARVIN WRIGHT, who also participated in the road block, advised that he did not talk to the individual stopped by WILLIAMS because he went directly to the car stopped behind the car WILLIAMS stopped. However, WRIGHT described the green in the car WILLIAMS stopped as a faded green. Also, WRIGHT advised, after the individual stopped by WILLIAMS left, WRIGHT specifically remembers WILLIAMS remarking that the license plate on the car was a 1968 Florida license with the prefix "10W-" WRIGHT also remembers WILLIAMS remarking about what a short last name the individual had.

Neither WILLIAMS nor WRIGHT have seen this individual again since 4/9/68. */// end*

Trooper WILLIAMS furnished a map of the State of N. C., and marked the map as he remembers the map marked in the possession of the individual he stopped.

On the night of 4/18/68 Supervisor HELGESON, Extension 591 at the Bureau, telephonically advised that the Bureau had received Charlotte teletype of 4/18/68 concerning ROBERT FRANKLIN WILLIAMS. He desired to know the reaction of Mrs. CAROLYN RUTH WILLIAMS to the photograph of GALT, ~~He was~~ ~~and also~~ advised that at the time Mrs. WILLIAMS was interviewed no photograph of GALT was available to the agent. He stated that he desired that a photograph be shown to her on the night of 4/18/68 and requested that the agent call the Bureau direct from the RA and apprise him of the results.

SA VICTOR P. HOLDREN was telephonically contacted and instructed to display the photograph of GALT to Mrs. WILLIAMS and to telephonically advise Supervisor HELGESON at the Bureau.

At approximately midnight, SA ^{HOLDREN} ~~HELGESON~~ advised he had shown the photograph to Mrs. WILLIAMS and she stated that this individual is similar but not identical to her ex-husband. He stated a photograph of ROBERT FRANKLIN WILLIAMS was obtained from the Sanford PD.

SA HOLDREN telephonically advised Supervisor HELGESON of the above and was instructed to confirm this by teletype, which was done.

On the night of 4/18/68 SA PAT FLETCHER of the Indianapolis Office telephonically advised that in connection with the lead set out for Indianapolis in Charlotte teletype of 4/18/68, there is no Hampton, Ind. He said there is a Hammond, Ind., but without more identifying data it would be impossible to identify Mrs. EUNICE SMITH at Hammond.

SA FLETCHER was advised that an attempt would be made to obtain more specific information regarding Mrs. SMITH's address and Indianapolis would be advised.

No record of Mrs. FRANK WIMBERLEY was located in the current Dunn telephone directory. Officer BILLY BUTLER of the Dunn PD was contacted by telephone and he advised that Mrs. WIMBERLEY was unknown to that department and her name could not be located in the City Directory.

The long distance telephone operator advised that a FRANKLIN L. WIMBERLEY at 605 N. General Lee St. in Dunn, telephone 892-5148, was listed in her records. Mrs. WIMBERLEY was telephonically contacted at that number and advised she is the sister of ROBERT FRANKLIN WILLIAMS. She said she has not seen her brother in several years and does not know his whereabouts but understands that he called Mrs. SMITH in Ind., sometime around Thanksgiving, 1967, at which time he was reportedly in Ga.

Laundries in Hickory and Newton, N.C. contacted on 4/10/68 with negative results.

On 4/10/68 Mrs. Virginia Pitts, Holiday Laundry, Inc. 452 No. Green St. Morganton, N.C. advised they did all the actual laundry in this area, and further they did use the Thermo Seal maring machine and tags.

She explained that a small tag is attached to the customer receipt, as well as on the clothes, and the bills are filed by the week, not by customer. For this reason it is possible for the same number to be used by a different person each week. She has the bills for past ten months in storage.

On 4/10/68 J. C. "Red" Whisnant, laundry plant of Holiday Laundry Inc., Morganton, N.C. advised that heir system has first-lot number, next driver number, next station where laundry turned in, next bundle number. They use first four parts of numbering system before using fifth part, and do not use the dash as fourth part of system. He also noted that ~~xxx~~ first 3 numbers and letters on the two machines are of same size, indicating all are fifteen point in size, and the last two numbers are larger, indicating they are 18 point in size. (It is noted the ~~third~~ number on questioned tag is a 18 point letter). He furnished samples of the two machines, and these are not being sent in at this time, but retained, since they do not match point size of suspects clothing tags.

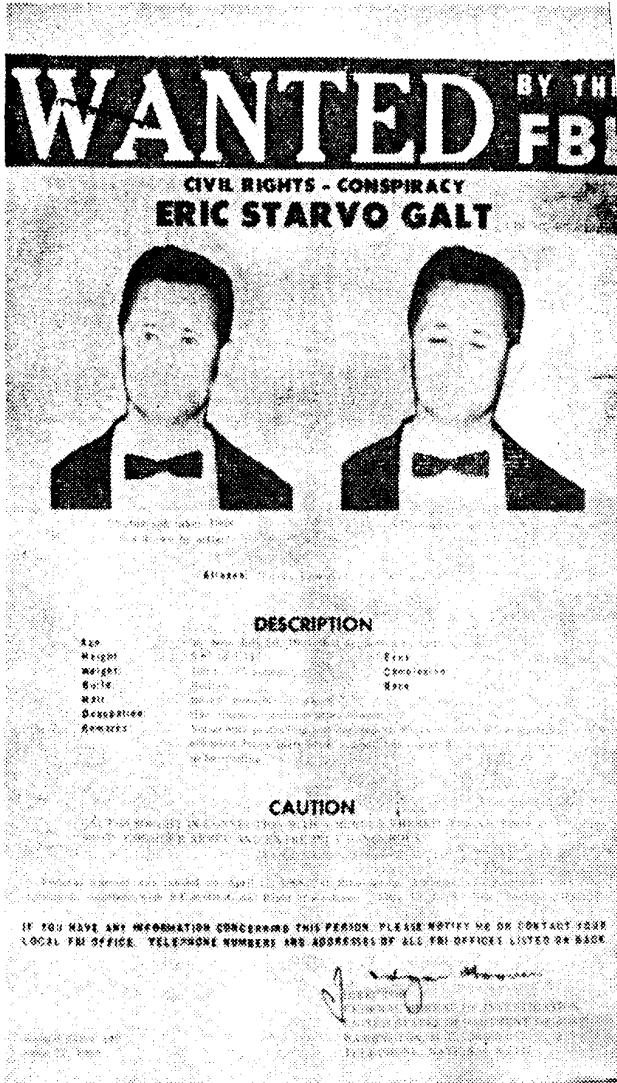

New FBI Poster On Galt

FBI Reportedly Hunting Galt Alone

From Observer Wire Reports
The mysterious Eric Starvo Galt is the lone subject of the FBI's investigation into Martin Luther King's assassination, despite an FBI complaint charging that Galt conspired in the slaying with his alleged

brother, the Los Angeles Times reported Thursday.

A federal source pointed out to a Los Angeles Times reporter that the complaint alleging a conspiracy could have been based on nothing more substantial than testimony by a witness that he had heard Galt say he and a brother planned to kill King or to use the rifle believed to be the murder weapon.

The FBI apparently knows

little about the man called Galt — probably not even whether that really is his name or whether he has a brother.

The complaint charges, however, that "on or about March 29, 1968, at Birmingham ... Galt and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968," to violate King's civil rights.

The civil rights law does not authorize federal prosecution unless there is evidence of a conspiracy.

The FBI distributed "wanted" posters on Galt nationwide Thursday after the 36-year-old mystery man apparently had eluded FBI agents in California.

The New York Times reported Thursday that agents had believed Wednesday, when Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced that a warrant had been issued for Galt's arrest, that they were close to Galt.

In regard to the brother angle, Galt is known to have twice mentioned a brother during the last two months. The first mention was when he told a clerk in a Birmingham gun store that he and his brother planned to go hunting.

FBI Agent Joseph H. Gamble, in charge of the Birmingham Bureau, said in the complaint on which a federal warrant for Galt's arrest was issued that the rifle found discarded on a Memphis street near the scene of King's slaying had been bought by Galt on March 30.

A second mention by Galt of a brother was when he was about to graduate from a bartenders school in Hollywood, Calif., in March. He turned down a job because, he said, he had to "go see his brother."

Rightwinger Said Kill Dr. King If I'm Jailed

KANSAS CITY—(AP) — The U.S. Attorney's office Thursday said an informant "of apparent reliability" told the federal government some time ago that

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was among persons ordered assassinated if Robert Bolivar DePugh ever went to jail.

The information was in a motion addressed to the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals in St. Louis and was a move to have appeals by DePugh and Walter Patrick Peyson dismissed on the theory the two were now fugitives.

DePugh is the leader of the Minutemen, militant right wing organization.

The government's motion quoted the unnamed informant as saying that "DePugh has issued orders to other Minutemen that, if he goes to jail, certain persons connected with his prosecution and others are to be assassinated, including Martin Luther King.

The government said it received this information prior to King's death in Memphis April 4.

DePugh and Peyson are appealing a November 1966 conviction in Kansas City for national firearms, violation. Both are also wanted on a federal grand jury indictment accusing them of conspiracy to rob banks in Seattle in January.

DePugh and Peyson have declared themselves "fugitives from injustice," and the FBI has been looking for them.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1960, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. By teletype to all SAC's dated April 18, 1968,
the Bureau advised as follows:

"Contacts should be maintained with all mass communications media in your territory to insure that there is frequent reference to photograph of GALT and his connection with this case. If not already done, photographs should be shown or described to law enforcement and other appropriate agencies in your areas to insure the broadest possible publication of subject's photograph and background.

Offices covering points of entry or exit from country insure that subject's photograph and background have been widely and/or appropriately displayed and that stops are being maintained.

Offices covering departure or arrival of overseas flights should also renew stops and display photographs of subject appropriately. Subject armed and dangerous."

In connection with the above by Agents Memo No. 154, dated April 18, 1968, all Senior Resident Agents were furnished photographs of GALT. In the event additional photographs are desired, they are available at Charlotte and will be furnished upon request.

SA WATSON at Wilmington will make available to Customs and Immigration officials photographs of GALT and insure that stop previously placed is in effect.

At 7:20 A. M., 4/20/68, Supervisor DICK BATES at the Bureau, telephonically advised that a call had just been received at the Bureau from JAMES H. WILLIAMS, a Negro male, who resides at 137 Adams Street, Rochester, New York. WILLIAMS was calling the Bureau from a location near Washington, D. C. He advised at approximately 11 P. M. on night of 4/19/68, he stopped at an Amoco Service Station on Interstate Highway 85 just before getting to Durham, N. C. While at the station, a man who he believes was identical with JAMES EARL RAY, aka, ERIC STARVO GALT, drove into the station in a 1960 Chevrolet, gray with a rust red top, bearing North Carolina license YT 1618. The man put gas in his own car and appeared to be in a hurry to leave. He was described as a white male, five feet eleven inches, one hundred eighty-five pounds.

Flight 133y. GILCHRIST advised that this flight left Atlanta
at 11:05AM and arrived in Houston, Tex., approximately one and
one half hours later.

GILCHRIST stated that upon viewing JAMES EARL RAY's photo
in today's paper that he is sure that RAY was a passenger on
the flight to Houston. Gilchrist stated that an individual
sat directly across the aisle from him on the flight. He stated
this individual was traveling without luggage. He stated the
only ~~XXXXXXXX~~ difference between RAY and this individual was the
color of hair, He stated the individual on the plane was blond
with the same characteristics as RAY. He stated that he was
hesitant about calling the FBI because he realized that we
probably had received numerous calls from people like himself

On 4-19-68, Larry Monteith, Records Technician, CE PD, telephonically advised that he had received a call from James Bumgardner, who gave his phone number as 392-7868. Monteith stated that he felt the FBI might be interested in the information received from Bumgardner.

Bumgardner stated he lived with James Earl Ray, who the FBI has identified as the true name for Eric Starvo Galt, for a year and a half in Forest City, N.C. He stated that Ray talked of Missouri and Jacksonville, Fla. He further stated that Ray had a wife and children living in Jacksonville, Fla. Bumgardner stated that he had tried on several occasions during this time to get the Forest City PD to arrest Ray. He stated that Bo Sisk, a police officer with the Forest City PD took pictures of Ray, which should be available at the Forest City PD.

Bumgardner gave the following description of Ray: Blue eyes, fair complexion, light brown hair, 165 POUNDS, 5 feet 9 inches to 5 feet 10 inches tall, 28 years old.

Bumgardner gave the address where they lived as Miss *44-1365-377* Smith's Boarding House, 208 Broadway St., Forest City, N.C.
