On the late afternoon of 4/18/68, Trooper HARRY L. WILLIAMS, N. C. Highway Patrol Trooper station in Catawba County, N. C., telephonically contacted the Hickory RA and advised that he saw the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT in the newspaper today and stated that he is certain that he encountered GALT while conducting a road block in Catawba County on the evening of 4/9/68. WILLIAMS was immediately personally contacted by SA SHERIDAN at which time WILLIAMS furnished the following information:

On the evening of 4/9/68, WILLIAMS and Trooper MARVIN WRIGHT were participating in a road block check on US 321 at the intersection of N. C. Highway 10, inside the city limits of Newton, N. C. The road block was set up as a result of the general racial situation following the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. and the purpose of the road block was to locate and confiscate from motor vehicle alcoholic beverages and firearms that might have been in the possession of motorists. The road block lasted from approximately 7:30 p.m. until approximately 11:00 p.m.

Sometime between 9:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m., 4/9/68, a white male driving a 1955 or 1956 Dodge, 4-door, automobile was stopped by WILLIAMS. WILLIAMS described this automobile as being three toned, that is, having an off white colored top, a dark green hood and trunk, with a strip of green around the sides, partially on the doors, and again having an off white bottom. WILLIAMS did not notice the color of the interior of this automobile. This vehicle was heading north on 321. WILLIAMS specifically remembers that this vehicle was bearing a 1968 Fla. license with the prefix "10W-!" There were four or five digits after the dash but WILLIAMS did not remember these numbers. The white male driving the vehicle was alone and the vehicle was heavily loaded with luggage, having possibly five or six suitcases in the back.

Trooper WILLIAMS stated that in his own mind he has definitely identified the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT

as being identical with this individual he stopped. He stated that there is no doubt in his mind regarding the matter and stated that he would "stake his life on it."

When WILLIAMS stopped this individual, he asked him for his drivers license and registration. The individual there upon presented a valid State of Florida driver's license. WILLIAMS does not remember the name of the drivers license but remembers that it did contain a first, middle and last name. He also noted that the name was uncommon to this area of North Carolina. WILLIAMS stated that this last name was a short name and he believes there were four letters in the last name. WILLIAMS stated that the name could have been "GALT." He stated that if the name was any of the three names of GALT, LOWMYER or WILLIARD, it would have been GALT or LOWMYER.

WILLIAMS stated that he does not remember the street or city address or license number on the drivers license displayed to him. He stated, however, that he specifically remembers that the drivers license listed the driver's occupation as a pilot. WILLIAMS asked the individual what airlines he flew for and the individual gave a name of some not well known airline. WILLIAMS does not now remember the name of the airline given but remembers that the airline had two names to it. He does not remember the individual talking about any cities in Fla. or where he worked.

The individual never did display a registration for the vehicle and the matter of the registration was not pursued by WILLIAMS.

WILLIAMS observed a map folded on the front seat of the vehicle. This map included several southeastern states in the United States. WILLIAMS picked up the map and noted the driver had a route marked out from somewhere in deep central Georgia to Wytheville, Va. WILLIAMS noted that this route marked out constituted almost a straight line. The line ended at Wytheville, Va. WILLIAMS asked the individual where he was going and the individual said he was going on vacation to Wytheville, Va., to visit with some friends or relatives. The individual said he was then going to either Charleston or Bluefield, West Virginia. WILLIAMS

did not remember which of these two towns in West Va. the individual mentioned. The individual did not mention anything specific about his friends or relatives in Wytheville, Va., or Charleston or Bluefield, W. Va., and did not indicate how long he was going to stay at any of these places.

WILLIAMS then instructed this individual how to get on Highway 16 north heading out of Conover, N. C. WILLIAMS advised that the entire conversation took place in about $1\frac{1}{2}$ minutes.

In commenting on the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT, WILLIAMS advised that the individual he stopped, whom he believes to be GALT, did not have cheeks as full as are GALT's cheeks in the photograph. He stated that the individual had a face considerably less fleshy than is shown is GALT's photograph. He stated that the individual he stopped had noticeable features in that he had a sharp pointed chin, a long and narrow and pointed nose, and large ears. He also noted that the individual's hair was much shorter than is depicted in GALT's photograph and his hair was brushed straight back. He advised that the individual's face was considerably narrower and longer that is depicted in GALT's photograph.

In describing the individual's composure, WILLIAMS advised that the individual was calm and not excited. He stated that the individual was reserved in his talk, answered questions precisely but did not volunteer information. WILLIAMS described the individual as well-groomed, clean shaven and immaculate in appearance. He stated that the individual gave him the impression that he would be precise in everything he did.

WILLIAMS furnished the following description of this individual from memory:

Trooper MARVIN WRIGHT, who also participated in the road block, advised that he did not talk to the individual stopped by WILLIAMS because he went directly to the car stopped behind the car WILLIAMS stopped. However, WRIGHT described the green in the car WILLIAMS stopped as a faded green. Also, WRIGHT advised, after the individual stopped by WILLIAMS left, WRIGHT specifically remembers WILLIAMS remarking that the license plate on the car was a 1968 Florida license with the prefix "10W-" WRIGHT also remembers WILLIAMS remarking about what a short last name the individual had.

Neither WILLIAMS nor WRIGHT have seen this individual again since 4/9/68.

Trooper WILLIAMS furnished a map of the State of N. C., and marked the map as he remembers the map marked in the possession of the individual he stopped.



She explained that a small tag is attached to the customer receipt, as well as on the clothes, and the bills are filed by the week, not by customer. For this reason it is possible for the same number to be used by a different person each week. She has the bills for past ten months in storage.

He also noted that *** first 3 numbers and letters on the two machines are of same size, indicating all are fifteen point in size, and the last two numbers are larger, indicating they are 18 point in size.(It is noted the third number on questioned tag is a 18 point letter). He furnished samples of the two machines, and these are not being sent in at this time, but retained, since they do not match point size of suspects clothing tags.







New FBI Poster On Galt

FBI Reportedly **Hunting Galt Alone**

From Observer Wire Reports

The mysterious Eric Starvo Galt is the lone subject of the FBI's investigation into Martin Luther King's assessination, despite an FM complaint charging that Galt conspired in the slaying with his alleged

brother, the Los Angeles Times reported Thursday.

to a Los Angeles times reporter that the complaint alleging a conspiracy could have been based on nothing more substantial then testimony by a witness that he had heard Galt say he and a brother planned to kill King or to use the rifle believed to be the murder weapon.

The FBI apparently knows

little about the man called Galt - probably not even whether that really is his name or whether he has a brother.

The complaint charges, however, that "on or about March 29, 1968, at Birmingham . . . Galt and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968," to violate King's civil rights.

The civil rights law does not authorize federal prosecution unless there is evidence of a conspiracy.

The FBI distributed "wanted" posters on Galt nationwide Thursday after the 36-year-old nystery man apparently had sluded FBI agents in Califor-

The New York Times reported Thursday that agents had believed Wednesday, when Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced that a warrant had been issued for Galt's arrest, that they were close to Galt.

In regard to the brother angle. Galt is known to have twice mentioned a brother during the last two months. The first mention was when he told a clerk in a Birmingham gun store that he and his brother planned to go hunting.

FBI Agent Joseph H. Gamble, in charge of the Birmingham Bureau, said in the complaint on which a federal warrant for Galt's arrest was issued that the rifle found discarded on a Memphis street near the scene of King's slaying had been bought by Galt on March 30.



Rightwinger Said Kill Dr. King If I'm Jailed

KANSAS CITY—(#) — The U.S. Attorney's office Thursday said an informant "of apparent reliability" told the federal government some time ago that

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was among persons ordered assassinated if Robert Bolivar DePugh ever went to jail.

The information was in a motion addressed to the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals in St. Louis and was a move to have appeals by DePugh and Walter Patrick Peyson dismissed on the theory the two were now fugitives.

DePugh is the leader of the Minutemen, militant right wing organization.


The government's motion quoted the unnamed informant as saying that "DePugh has issued orders to other Minutemen that, if he goes to jail, certain persons connected with his prosecution and others are to be assassinated, including Martin Luther King.

The government said it received this information prior to King's death in Memphis April

DePugh and Peyson are appealing a November 1966 conviction in Kansas City for national firearms, violation. Both are also wanted on a federal grand jury indictment accusing them of conspiracy to rob banks in Seattle in January.

DePugh and Peyson have declared themselves "fugitives from injustice," and the FBI has been looking for them.

She stated her brother, whom she last saw 18 months to 2 yrs. ago, is approximately 34 yrs. of age, 5'9", 180-200 lbs. (when last seen), black hair, thinning and receding hairline, brown eyes, dark complexion, wide space between upper front teeth.

She stated that she has has not seen her brother nor has she heard from him since his escape and that she last saw him 18 months to 2 years ago. She has no idea of his present whereabouts. She stated in October or November, 1967, her brother called a sister, Mrs. GEORGE (EUNICE) SMITH in Princeton, Ind., asking for money and her brother stated he was calling from Atlanta, Ga.

In connection with the above by Agents Memo No. 154, dated April 18, 1968, all Senior Resident Agents were furnished photographs of GALT. In the event additional photographs are desired, they are available at Charlotte and will be furnished upon request.
