On 4/26/68, HAROLD DAYID MC GEE, 404 Berkshire Rd., Charlotte, N. C., advised/that he has been employed by Stylecraft Packing Service / 2900 Griffith St., Charlotte, in the Bag Department, on the 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. shift since 12/1/67. He stated his wife, ETHEL, is employed by Southern Bell Telephone Co. as a service assistant at the Caldwell St. Building for the past seven years. He stated they have been married nine years and have two children, a boy, five years, and a girl, four years. He stated he has not made any trips out of Charlotte other than to his home in Spruce Pine, N. C., as he and his wife are both from Spruce Pine.

He stated he has frequently discussed with friends, neighbors and fellow employees the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated he has no pertinent information concerning KING's murder, but often in conversations has made the statement, as have a lot of other acquaintances during conversations, that it apparently was a professional job and the killer did a pretty good job in keeping from being caught.

He stated he and other individuals have often mentioned the fact that KING would probably be assassinated in view of his racial activities, and may have stated on occasion, he could have been assassinated in Charlotte as well as Memphis or any other place he might visit.

MC GEE stated he has never had any information at all concerning the murder or the whereabouts of subject RAY, and he has never heard any individual mention the fact that they knew KING would be murdered. He stated he has never participated in any type of racial activity.

MC GEE stated he was absent from work for about three weeks, having been in an automobile accident near Shelby, N. C.; on 3/2/68, while en route to Spruce Pine and was in a Shelby hospital for a week with facial lacerations and a leg injury, and upon his release, spent two weeks at home prior to returning to work.

He stated he has ten brothers and sisters scattered from Texas, Colorado, Florida and in North Carolina; and his wife has a sister in Washington, D. C., who is head of Forbes Personnel Service, and she has a sister in Hickory, N. C., as well as one sister who is not married, BARBARA SUE FORBES, who is employed by Grandfather's Children's Home at Banner Elk, N. C. He stated BARBARA FORBES visited his wife and him for about a week while she was looking for a job in Charlotte, and recently returned to Banner Elk about three or four days ago; and other than that, they have had no company. He stated he has never expressed any opinions regarding KING's murder in any letters to relatives or friends.

On 4/26/68, Mr. ERNEST GADDY, Stylecraft Packing Service, 2900 Griffith, Charlotte, advised that his records reflect that DAVID MC GEE was in an automobile accident on 3/2/68, and was off work until 3/20/68, when he returned and worked three days. However, he was off on Sunday, and returned and worked 3/25 and 26/68, but was off 3/27,28 and 29/68. According to Mr. GADDY, the time cards reflected that MC GEE worked 4/1-6/68, from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. each night.

MC GEE is described as a white male, age about 30, 5'9", 145 lbs., brown hair, blue eyes, medium complexion, visible new scars on forehead and face.



On 4/25/68, J. C. MORTON was telephonically contacted and advised he would be personally contacted by the FBI on 4/26/68, at 2:00 p.m.

On 4/26/68, J. C. MORTON. Oxford, N. C., advised during March and the early part of April, 1968, he was vacationing at St. Thomas, Virgin Islands; and that on 4/24/68, while reading Time Magazine, he noticed the pictures of JAMES EARL RAY, and thought he had seen an individual of similar description while in St. Thomas. Virgin Islands. MORTON further advised on 4/6/68, at about 8:00 or 9:00 p.m., he was at Trader Dan's, C-Amalie, St. Thomas, when he went to the back of the bar in order to speak to JIM SHULP (phonetic), the bar owner; and on his way to the back of the bar, an individual who was apparently intoxicated reached over and pulled his shirt out of his pants.
