On 5/10/68, Lieutenant WADE STROUD, Charlotte PD, telephonically advised Complaint Clerk RALPH HILL that a Mr. ANDREWS in Ledford's Dept. Store, Park Road Shopping Center, had telephonically advised the PD that there was a man in the store at that time who appeared to resemble the photographs of JAMES EARL RAY.

SA CHARLES W. MILLER who was in a radio car was instructed to proceed to Ledford's Dept. Store and SA CRAWFORD F. WILLIAMS proceeded to Ledford's. Mr. ANDREWS at Ledford's pointed out to SA MILLER the individual he thought resembled RAY, and it was the observation of SA MILLER that the man in no way resembled the photographs and physical description of RAY. Mr. ANDREWS was shown photographs of RAY and he advised that he based his identification on the fact that the individual's right ear protruded. It was pointed out that RAY'S left ear is the prominent ear.

SHAW, Commercial Manager, Central Telephone Co., advised his records reflect Roxboro Telephone Number 599-9083 was a Central Telephone Co. owned and operated pay telephone located in the Thomas and Oakley Drug Store on Main St., Roxboro, N. C. SHAW stated that long-distance telephone call numbers originating at this telephone and paid at that station would be recorded at the Virginia Telephone Co. at Charlottesville, Va., another company of the Central Telephone Co.

On 5/7/68, the following employees of the Thomas and Oakley Drug Store, a Walgreen agency, were interviewed for information as to the possible identity of a person receiving long-distance telephone call from Houston, Texas, Number 673-9255, to Roxboro, N. C., Number 919-599-9083, with negative results:

REVIS CARVER, Drugist Assistant. PEARLIE CARVER, Clerk. JANIE BLAYLOCK, Clerk.

These employees advised that the drug store had a listed regular telephone, number 599-3712, and this was the telephone where employees were normally reached. They noted that the pay telephone, number 599-9083, located at the back of the store was used by a number of people, both customers and non-customers, both of the Negro and Caucasian race. They stated they would have no idea who might have received a long-distance call from Houston, Texas, during December at the pay telephone.

MEMO TO ALL SENIOR RESIDENT AGENTS RE: MURKIN By airtel dated May 8, 1968, to all SAC's and Legats, the Bureau advised as follows: "In connection with the captioned case there has been speculation that JAMES EARL RAY concocted the alias of ERIC STARVO GALT by combining the names of characters from books by IAN FLEMING and from a book 'Atlas Shrugged' by AYN RAND. This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by IAN FLEMING there is a character named ERNST STAVRO BLOFIELD and in 'Atlas Shrugged' there is a character named JOHN GALT, as well as one named ERIC STARNES. ERNST STAVRO BLOFIELD is a formidable person, JOHN GALT is a 'social drop out' and ERIC STARNES is described in the book as a 'whiner' from a low-class family. "In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of RAY's utilizing an alias based on characters in FLEMING's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance." Re Charlotte teletypes to Bureau 5/9/68 pertaining to look alike at O'hare Airport, Chicago, Ill., 5/8/68.

In the early morning hours of 5/9/68, Mr. HUGH TALLEY. 128 Brookfield Cr., Mooresville, N. C., advised that he was having breakfast in a restaurant at O'hare Airport, Chicago, Ill., some time between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m., Chicago time, on the morning of 5/8/68. TALLEY does not remember the name of this restaurant but pointed out that it is located on the same concourse as Eastern Airlines and is located between Eastern Airlines and North Central Airlines in the airport. TALLEY stated that while he was sitting in this restaurant by himself at a table for four persons an individual came into the restaurant and stood beside him. TALLEY noticed this individual was glaring down at him and seemed angry at the fact that he, TALLEY, was taking up a four-seat table. The individual made a motion with his hand as if he was going to say something and then turned around, walked away, and went to sit down at one table removed from TALLEY. No conversation took place between TALLEY and this individual. TALLEY advised that he left this restaurant at about 9:15 a.m. and the individual he was referring to was still seated at the table. TALLEY stated that he was alone in this restaurant, as was this individual he referred to. The only individual he observed going toward this individual was the same waitress who waited on him, TALLEY.

TALLEY advised that this confrontation between himself and this individual lasted for about three or four seconds.

TALLEY advised that approximately one hour ago he was reading the May 9, 1968, edition of "The Charlotte Observer" and observed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY. TALLEY stated that the above referred to individual, whom he encountered in the restaurant at O'Hare Airport, was a precise duplicate of RAY in the Charlotte paper.

CE 44-1365 TALLEY furnished the following description of the individual he encountered in the airport restaurant: White Race: Sex: Male About early 30's Age: About 180 to 185 1bs. Weight: 5'11" to 6' Height: Unnoticed Eyes: (eyes set deep in eye sockets) Hair: Dark brown Medium complexion Face: Scars and Marks: None noted Dress: Extremely well dressed, wearing a blue or olive colored business suit with a clean white shirt and conservative tie TALLEY advised that he did not observe the individual he encountered carrying any luggage. On 5/9/68, TALLEY was recontacted at which time he advised that the above restaurant at O'Hare Airport to which he referred is not the Tartan Tray Cafeteria nor the Seven Continents restaurant, but stated that the restaurant he referred to is on the same (main) floor as is the Tartan Tray Cafeteria. He advised that the restaurant he referred to is less than a two minute walk from the Tartan Tray as one walks from this restaurant toward EAL flight concourse. TALLEY advised that as one walks from the Tartan Tray Cafeteria, one comes into a large circular area, approximately 60 feet in diameter, and an escalator descends into approximately the center of this circular area. At the top of this escalator is the Seven Continents Restaurant. On the opposite side of this circular area, on the main floor, one enters an approximately 70-foot corridor which leads to the United Airlines and Eastern Airlines ticket counters. TALLEY advised that the restaurant he referred to is on the right or left along this corridor, between the circular area and United Airlines ticket counter. -2-2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

CE 44-1365 TALLEY advised that the restaurant he referred to was a practical looking and not plush restaurant. He stated that it was a relatively long and rectangular-shaped restaurant with more than fifty tables. He stated that he did not observe any bar facilities in this restaurant. He advised that one wall of this restaurant, the wall opposite the side where the waitresses were picking up orders from the kitchen, was composed of windows. He stated that the table tops were of a gravish color. possibly of a Formica material, and the tables utilized paper place mats rather than table cloths. TALLEY did not notice if the floors of this restaurant had carpeting. He does not remember the types of uniforms worn by the waitresses in this restaurant but stated that they apparently were not particularly noticeable. TALLEY advised that the waitress who waited on him in this restaurant on the morning of 5/8/68 was a white female, approximately 22 years of age, 5'4", 110 lbs.. dark hair, very ruddy or pitted face, possibly of Polish descent. He believes this waitress was also the individual who waited on the individual TALLEY described as fitting the description of JAMES EARL RAY. TALLEY stated that he observed one other waitress in this restaurant and he described her as a white female, age middle 20's, bleachedblonde hair, wearing thick eyeglasses. HUGH TALLEY, white male, age 32 years old, advised that he is a self-employed chemical consultant. He stated that he is the owner of Uretech Company, which is located at 103 Main St., Mooresville, N. In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U. S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It was suggested that each state may maintain such a record in their Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency.

There is no known Federal law requiring the maintenance of such information; and it is possible that if any record of unidentified dead is maintained, it would only be maintained at local police departments, morgues, medical facilities, or the like.

Each office covering state capitals should check to ascertain if such records are maintained, and if so, should check records for the period from 4-5-68, to date, for any information which might possibly identify subject Ray with unidentified deceased person over that period.

If there is no central record repository maintained in the various states or nationally in the case of Mexico and Canada, you should, in connection with your contacts with law enforcement agencies on this case or other Bureau matters, make appropriate inquiries relative to



He was scheduled to return to Fayetteville, North Carolina, on April 8, 1968; however, Piedmont records reflect only passage from Fayetteville to Atlanta April 5, 1968.

JN 157-9586 his release in April, 1967, he became very friendly with an inmate identified as LEROY MC MANAMAN. MC MANAMAN was originally from western Kansas and was alleged to have bootlegged in Mississippi. According to NISSEN, he and MC MANAMAN worked together in the shoe factory at Leavenworth. NISSEN said he had previously met MC MANAMAN before going to the penitentiary in Jackson, Mississippi, and he recognized MC MANAMAN again at Leavenworth, Just before NISSEN was scheduled to be parolled from Leavenworth, MC MANAMAN approached him and stated that he knew NISSEN was going to Atlanta and that he wanted NISSEN to set things up for him. MC MANAMAN told NISSEN that \$100,000.00 had been offered by the WKKKKOM to be paid to anyone who would kill MARTIN LUTHER KING. MC MANAMAN allegedly instructed NISSEN to contact a Mrs. (first name unknown) EURE, at the Eure Realty Company, Jackson, Miss. MC MANAMAN claimed Mrs. EURE is listed as a correspondent by him at Leavenworth Penitentiary. According to MC MANAMAN's instructions, NISSEN was to contact Mrs. EURE and ask her when she next writes to MC MANAMAN at the Penitentiary to tell him "DON" had arrived. MC MANAMAN indicated he would write and tell EURE that NISSEN was "O.K." If NISSEN wanted to try to "pull this" himself, Mrs. EURE would put him in contact with two people identified only as FLOYD (lnu), an Honorary Colonel in the National Guard at Jackson, Miss., and a second person whom NISSEN could not now recall. NISSEN stated that the unidentified person, according to MC MANAMAN had recently been appointed Deputy Unit ed States Marshal at Jackson. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

A review of Leavenworth Penitentiary Parole
Progress Report for LEROY BASIL MC MANAMAN dated October,
1966, disclosed MC MANAMAN began his sentence at
Leavenworth on January 18, 1963. The offense is
listed as receiving and concealing stolen vehicle from
interestate commerce. Under the Sentence Captioned there
is an entry "Harboring a Fugitive 9 Years". The
codefendants were listed as BURTON HARRY HERPEL, RUBIE
CHARLES JENKINS and CHARLES E. TESCHER.

The Classification Study Sheet discloses the
following description of LEROY BASIL MC MANAMAN:

The Arrest Record Sheet in the Classification Study shows MC MANAMAN was arrested 12/22/34, Dodge City, Kansas, for investigation. He has numerous arrest since that time in Kansas, Omaha, Nebraska, Colorado Springs, Colorado, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and Springfield, Missouri.

MC MANAMAN is a native of Kansas and has resided in that state most of his life. He has been somewhat nomadic in the past several years, drifting throughout both Kansas and Oklahoma. His last residence was with his parents in Dodge City, Kansas.

JN 157-9586 Under the New Social Information, section it is indicated that MC MANAMAN writes very often to his mother who lives in Dodge City, Kansas. He has a grown son and daughter living in Dodge City and they occasionally bring his mother to the institution to visit him. He is divorced and his former wife never writes. MC MANAMAN has been writing often to a woman friend, SYBIL EURE who lives in Jackson, Mississippi. MC MANAMAN has received seven visits from SYBIL EURE and four visits from his mother and son. The Penitentiary file indicates MC MANAMAN plans to work with SYBIL EURE in the real estate business in Jackson, Mississippi, upon his release from Leavenworth. The file further indicates SYBIL EURE shows much interest in assisting MC MANAMAN and there seems some possibility that they may marry in the future. Upon receiving the information from DONALD JAMES NISSEN concerning the alleged offer of \$100,000.00, Mrs. SYBIL EURE was interviewed at Jackson, Mississippi, on 8/8/67. At that time Mrs. SYBIL M. EURE advised that she is well acquainted with LEROY MC MANAMAN and frequently corresponds with him at the Leavenworth Penitentiary. She explained that early in 1964 after becoming acquainted with MC MANAMAN she rented a room to him at her residence where MC MANAMAN stayed for a few weeks. As far as she knows this is the only time MC MANAMAN has spent in Mississippi. She does not believe that MC MANAMAN is involved or ever has been involved in any Klan activity or associated with anyone whom she new to be involved in Klan activity and that she has never been involved in any Klan activities herself. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

JN 157-9586 She stated that she does not know any of MC MANAMAN's associates, does not know anyone by the name of DONALD JAMES NISSEN, nor has MC MANAMAN ever mentioned NISSEN's name. She does not know of any alleged offer of \$100,000.00 by the WKKKKOM to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. She has never heard of anything similar to this mentioned and claims not to be involved in any such plot. She does not know anyone by the name of FLOYD who is a Honorary Colonel in the National Guard or anyone recently appointed as a United States Marshal at Jackson. She stated that her brother's name is FLOYD GARDNER but he is not in the National Guard, not a member of any Klan group, and he does not know MC MANAMAN. The only person she knows in the United States Marsal's Office at Jackson is CHARLES SUTHERLAND, the Chief Deputy, who is a distant cousin of her former husband, JOHN EURE. She also knows BOB THOMAS, who is associated with the United States Marshal's Office. She considers both SUTHERLAND and THOMAS to be respectable people and she thought most assuredly that they would have no association with any Klan group. On 5/13/68, Mrs. SYBIL G. EURE, 423 Raymond Road, Jackson, Miss., was reinterviewed. At the outset she inquired as to the nature of the interview. It was explained to Mrs. EURE that since the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., her past association with MC MANAMAN may be of a more significant nature. The alleged offer of \$100,000.00 by the WKKKKOM was explained to her again. 5 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176
