For the information of Chicago, JERRY RAY said in a letter he sent to FCI, which was postmarked on 4/29/03 at Wheeling, Illinois, he owns a 1900 DeSoto and a 1901 Plymouth. In a previous telephone conversation with PCI, he said he keeps the Plymouth at his father's farm in Centerville, Nissouri.

On 5/8/63, FCI's telephone conversation with JERRY RAY was disconnected. About a half hour later, he called her at her residence again and they completed their conversation.

FCI further advised that JURNY RAY said he is going to send her \$25 enclosed in a letter or to be sent by a wire to reach her by 5/11/03. It is noted he sent FCI a \$25 money order enclosed in the described letter postnarked 4/29/03.

PCI said JERRY RAY told her he would telephonically contact her next on 5/21/00. He commented he would rather talk to her on the telephone than write her. He did not further explain this statement.

PCI again stated under no circumstances doss she want her comparation with the ISI in connection with this natter to ever become known outside of the FSI. She again also said it is a special concern to her that JURRY RAY nover know of her assistance to the Eureau.
