Investigation has determined that the subject, using the name of ERIC GALT, left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67, driving his Mustang automobile, in the company of CHARLES J. STEIN, of Los Angeles. STEIN had formerly been a resident of New Orleans and the alleged purpose of this trip was for STEIN to pick up two children of his sister's who were residing in New Orleans and return them to California. According to STEIN, they arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67 and left New Orleans on 12/19/67. STEIN stayed with relatives and investigation has determined that subject registered at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, on 12/17/67 as ERIC S. GALT and was assigned room 126. The registration card indicated GALT's automobile to be a Mustang bearing Alabama license 1-38993 and his address as 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Ala. The subject, as GALT, stayed at the motel until 12/19/67 when he checked out.

Interviews of motel employees in regards to the subject have been negative in that they cannot recall him.

There is set forth under a caption for each Office the identity or identities of persons staying at the Provincial Motel from 12/17 through 19/67. The identities of these persons were obtained from the motel registration cards as well as other information which is set forth under the name. In connection with the captioned case there has been speculation that James Earl Ray concocted the alias of Eric Starvo Galt by combining the names of characters from books by Ian Fleming and from a book "Atlas Shrugged" by Ayn Rand. This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by Ian Fleming there is a character named Ernst Stavro Blofield and in "Atlas Shrugged" there is a character named John Galt, as well as one named Eric Starnes. Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of Ray's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance.

On 5/9/68, PCI MARJORIE LOUISE FETTERS, 2420 Arnold Street, Camden, N.J., telephone number 609-961-4923, advised SA JOHN E. CPTO at about 3:00 p.m. of 5/8/68, JERRY RAY telephonically contacted her at her residence. He said he was calling from St. Louis, Missouri.

He stated he had telephonically contacted his employer at the Northbrook, Illinois, Country Club. His employer advised him to return to work on 5/9/68 or soon thereafter and arrangements would be made for him to begin residing in an apartment away from the club. He said his employer thought such a move could possibly avert the type of attention that was attracted to JERRY RAY by news media when they recently learned he is the subject's brother.

JERRY RAY asked PCI if it would be readily possible for him to obtain employment in the Camden, N.J., area if he decided to come there to live. He said he is strongly thinking of making such a move so he could be closer to PCI. PCI apprized him of various major industries in the South Jersey area and JERRY RAY appeared to her to be favorably impressed. JERRY RAY mentioned he had learned he would be able to receive about \$44 a week in unemployment benefits until he obtained a job should he terminate his present position at the Country Club in Illinois.

For the information of Chicago, JERRY RAY said in a letter he sent to FCI, which was postmarked on 4/29/68 at Wheeling, Illinois, he owns a 1960 DeSoto and a 1961 Plymouth. In a previous telephone conversation with FCI, he said he keeps the Plymouth at his father's farm in Centerville, Missouri.

On 5/8/68, FCI's telephone conversation with JERRY RAY was disconnected. About a half hour later, he called her at her residence again and they completed their conversation.

FCI further advised that JERRY RAY said he is going to send her \$25 enclosed in a letter or to be sent by a wire to reach her by 5/11/68. It is noted he sent FCI a \$25 money order enclosed in the described letter postmarked 4/29/68.

FCI said JERRY RAY told her he would telephonically contact her next on 5/11/68. He commented he would rather talk to her on the telephone than write her. He did not further explain this statement.

FCI again stated under no circumstances does she want her cooperation with the FBI in connection with this matter to ever become known outside of the FBI. She again also said it is a special concern to her that JERRY RAY never know of her assistance to the Bureau.
