

This case is predicated on a letter, dated Jone 19. 1987, from Estimated States Attorney William A. Wirchen, Esance City, Missouri, enclosing a letter, dated fone 5, 1987 from M. Y. LAUF, Identification and Records, Missouri State Emultantiary, by. LAUF's letter set forth the following information:

The indicated subject was missing, from inside the walls of the main Penitentiary on April 23, 1967 and since that date information has been discovered giving us reasons to believe that he has escaped. We also have reasons to believe they has fled the state, to avoid prosecution. As all efforts to locate his have failed.

This insale is described as a shite male, age 30, 708 beight 5'll", dark brown hair, blue even, weight lob, medium complexion and medium build. He was received here which 17, 1980, from the 31. Louis City circuit Court, to serve 20 years for abbery first Degree by means of a Dangerous & Deadly Reapon (2 chys.); operating a Motor Vehicle without permission of the Owner (20, 7, 5 Concurrent).

"To should appreciate it if your office would cause a Federal warrant to be issued against this individual. If he is apprehended, outside of the state of Hissouri, the Department of Corrections will extradite him and pay the expenses thereof."

On Jame 19, 1967, Fr. WILLIAM A. WITCHEN requested an Unlawful Flight to Avoid Confinement complaint be filed against JAMAS HARL HAY.

On Jone 23, 1967, br. H. F. LAUF, mentioned above, advised SA TEOMAS U. MEAVER that subject is known as a "hide out guy" who stays hidden within the confines of the Kissouri State Penitentiary for several days and has done so in the past. He said there is considerable speculation as to whether MAY had actually been able to leave the prison. He said investigation, to date, has failed to develop any information as to RAY's whereabouts.
