BASS is supposed to be living with BILL (LNU), Dallas, Texas, whom she knows nothing about. She expects a telephone call from BASS this weekend which is 6/29-30/68, and is to advise him to contact the Dallas FBI Office. She will obtain his address and furnish to FBI. She stated BASS was, to her knowledge, still employed in the bosing of meat with Arnold Heat Company.

On 6/25/68. HERRY COX, Limestone County Sheriff's Office, Groesbeck, Texas, stated he has known LLOYD GENE BASS. SR., for about 30 years. He stated BASS' wife MARY, and children live at 410 West Colorado, Groesbeck, Texas' however BASS lives and works in Dallas and is thought to run a meat company in Dallas.

LA 44-1574 4. RAY, two girls and a child were driven from Memphis by WILBURN in the blue Buick. They went to Kansas City and the trip took six and one half hours. The girls, the child, and WILBURN are all from Huntsville, Alabama. 5. In Kansas City, RAY stayed overnight at a home, described as a small gray, shingled, one bedroom house about three miles from central Kansas City. 6. At dusk the next day, 4/5/68, RAY was flown to Belle Glade, Florida in a private plane. The plane took off from a private field, also used as a training field for the military. RAY arrived early 4/6/68. 7. The plane in which RAY was flown is owned by a WILLIAM PIERCE, a wealthy man who owns or operates an airport in Belle Glade, and once owned a contracting company in Guba. It is not known if PIERCE flew the plane. PIERCE also owns a motel in Belle Glade and cottages in nearby Okeechobee, or maybe on nearby Lake Okeechobee. Re laundry marks on clothing related to Alton, Illinois bank robbery.

On 6/27/68, Mr. WILLIAM S. GECKS, Sales Administrator, National Marking Machine Co., (NATMAR, Inc.), 4026-30 Cherry St., Cincinnati, Ohio, was contacted relative to type of specific information needed concerning the laundry marks found on the clothing related to the Alton, Illinois bank robbery on 7/13/67.

Mr. GECKS advised it would be best to have color photos of the laundry markings taken alongside a ruler or other fine measuring device. GECKS stated from the information furnished him from Chicago airtel that the markings appear to have been made by a 16 digit machine which can be coded by the user for his own specific purposes. With the use of color photos, GECKS may be able to identify the size of the type used by the machine and other details which would possibly identify the model of the machine used to make the markings. NATMAR can then furnish a list of laundries or dry cleaners in a specific area that are utilizing NATMAR machines that could possibly have made these markings. GECKS stated it would not be possible to identify the markings with a specific location around the country.

In reviewing this file, it is noted that at the time captioned vehicle was recovered at the St. Louis Municipal Airport on 5/16/68, Trooper RGBERT SCHURE, Missouri State Highway Patrol, advised that this vehicle had been rented at Atlanta, Ga., 4/2/68, from National Car Rental utilizing stolen credit cards in the name of SAMUEL SCHNEIDERMAN, 6535 Noad Rd., Richmond, Ill., and that these credit cards were alleging stolen from SCHNEIDERMAN in an armed robbery in Kansas City, Mo.


