The above is the caption for the civil rights investigation to identify person or persons responsible for the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr., in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968.

Per Bureau instructions, all investigation must be handled under the personal direction of the SAC. Leads are to be afforded immediate thorough imaginative attention and all possibilities must be exhausted as any one lead could result in the solution of this most important investigation.

Memphis has advised that the pertinent periods in the investigation are March 29 and 30, in Birmingham, Alabama, and April 4, 1968, in Memphis, Tennessee. Memphis has requested that in the event any data developed regarding suspects that if the interested offices can establish whereabouts of suspects on dates above, this may tend to eliminate the suspect. If this cannot be done, efforts should be made to secure photographs of suspects in question and forward photos to Memphis and Birmingham for possible elimination. Pertinent descriptive data should be included with photos. If the office is unable to eliminate on basis of established whereabouts in pertinent periods, efforts should be made to secure fingerprints of suspect and submit same to Bureau for elimination. The composite description based on data developed in Birmingham and Memphis is as follows:

On 4/6/68 Supervising Nurse DIANE HILL, Rive redge Hospital 8311 Roosevelt, Riverside, Illinois, advised that RQNALD BRUCE KIRSH, WMA, born at Oak Park, Illinois, brown hair and mustache, Social Security # residence - 474 Ovedale Road, Riverside, Illinois (phone 447-0251), had been committed to that institution on 4/5/68 at 8:00PM as a mental patient by his father ALBERT KIRSH of 474 Uvedale Road, Riverside. Further, HILL related that subsequent to KIRSH's admission he was discovered to have had a small pistol in his possession and this weapon was turned over to ALBERT KIRSH.

On 4/6/68 Lt. DONALD GOSSLING, Riverside, Illinois PD related that on 4/5/68 he served committment papers to RONALD BRUCE KIRSH at the Riverside PD Headquarters at 6:00PM. GOSSLING stated that KIRSH was then transported the the Riveredge Hospital by private ambulance. According to GOSSLING KIRSH had been committed because of his recent erratic behavior and an incident where a number of lights were shot out in the neighborhood of his parents! residence. GOSSLING reported that Dr. PETER BEINAR, 3240 Oak Park, Berwyn, Illinois, phone ST8-5600, had been the examining physician.

On 4/6/68 Mr. & Mrs. ALBERT KIRSH, 474 Uvedale Road, Riverside, Illinois, advised that after over six years of marriage their son RONALD KIRSH had separated from his wife ARLENE KIRSH about two months ago and as a result suffered a mental breakdown. The KIRSHs related that as a result of his mental problem RONALD KIRSH lost his job. The KIRSHs stated that RONALD KIRSH visited a friend near Tulsa, Oklahoma, acquired a heavy sunburn and returned to theer home in Riverside, Illinois, when he learned that his small daughter had been injured in a fall. The KIRSHS advised that RONALD KIRSH had been living with them from the date of his return on 4/1/68 to the date of his committment on 4/5/68. The KIRSHs produced a Brookfield, Illinois PD Traffic Citation received by their son on 4/3/68 at 12:34AM, ticket # X1-019-351 listing Ronald Kirsh's Illinois D/L# and his address as 1220 South 49th Street, Cicero, Illinois (KIRSH's former address with his wife ARLENE). Both KIRSHs recalled that RONALD KIRSH had been home all day Thursday 4/4/68 and that they had been together at the dinner table when

when the news of the shooting of Dr. King came over the TV.

ALBERT KIRSH stated that on the morning of 4/5/68 his son RONALD had purchased a used 410/.22 over and under Savage for \$39.00 from Midwest Sporting Goods in Lyons, Ellinois, but because of the Illinois 72 hour waiting period on firearms purchases RONALD could not take possession until 4/8/68. ALBERT KIRSH explained that this was the gun receipt he had in his possession when committed. ALBERT KIRSH stated that he recovered the receipt and a .22 Astra automatic pistol found his RONALD's possession by Riveredge Hospital personnel. Further, ALBERT KIRSH stated that with the receipt and after explaining the dircumstances to the Store Manager he was able to obtain a refund on his son's \$39.00 purchase.

ALBERT KIRSH stated that his son had been a shooting enthusiast and owned several pistols all of which were being turned over to the Riverside PD for safekeeping.

In addition, ALBERT KIRSH advised that his neighbors Mr. & Mrs. PHILIP KASKA, 527 Selbourne, Riverside, Illinois, 447-7391, could perify RONALD KIRSH's present in Riverside all day on 4/4/68.

He also advised that THOMPSON while in Highland Park was driving a cab for the Lake Cab Co. 214 Green Bay Rd., Highwood, Ill.

CROWLEY advised that he welcomed any time that an agent contact him for more information, if necessary.

It is noted that before the conversation was completed, CROWLEY advised that is was necessary that he hang up since he felt that it was necessary that he take a "heart" pill.

On 4/8/68 Rev. LELAND REGIER, 11345 S. Bell, Chicago, advised he had learned that FNU PLOGGER, a resident of Chicago and much-publicized leader of the Illinois chapter of the Ku Klan, was out of town at the time of the assasination of MAPTIN LUTHER KING Jr. REGIER is a personal friend of writer.

On 4/8/68 Rev. CHAPLES E. WILSON, 2307 Lawndale Ave., Chicago, 252-8880, advised writer that PLOGGEP AND DONALD E. HEATH, former Chicago police and much publicized members of the Ku Klux Klan, reside near WILSON's church. WILSON noticed that PLOGGEP's auto, a white Mustang, has been gone from the from of the PLOGGER home since 4/2 or 4/3/68. It reappeared in front of the home during the afternoon of 4/8/68.

When WILSON read in a newspaper that a suspect set away had been made in a white Mustang he thought immediately of PLOGGER. When he saw the car was not at the PLOGGER residence for several days before and several days after the murder, he decided to call writer.

WILSON has never met nor seen PLOGGER or HEATH and has had contact only with their families who attend WILSON's church. WILSON emphasized that his church is in a changing community and that feelings against Negro and civil rights movements are very strong. He therefore requested that his identity not be disclosed outside the FBI. VILSON was referred to writer by Dr. ALFRED DEMAN, Pres., Chicago Baptist Assn. and mutual friend of writer and WILSON.

On April 9, 1968, Mr. RALPH YONKE, American Laundry and Dry Cleaning Institute, Chicago Street, Joliet, Illinois, telephone 815-727-4501, advised that the thermo seal marking machines manufactured by the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York, used in the state of Illinois, are distributed by PETER WUKOVICH of 756 Hawthorne Street, Elmhurst, Illinois, telephone BR 9-6141.

On April 9, 1968, Mrs. PETER WUKOVICH at the above address, advised that her husband is out of state on business and will return to the Chicago area on April 10, 1968. She advised that she would be talking to her husband the evening of April 9, 1968, and would attempt to determine from him the names of all laundries in the state of Illinois that use the thermo seal marking machine. She said she is employed at the Fastener Corporation in Chicago and could be reached at 678-0100, ext. 308.

On April 10, 1968, Mrs. WUKOVICH was recontacted and she advised that she had talked to her husband the previous evening and that he had furnished her with a list of the laundries in the state of Illinois that he could recall used the thermo seal marking machine. In addition, he stated that he would return to his residence the afternoon of April 10, 1968, and that he would search his records to determine any additional laundries using this machine that he had omitted. He further advised his wife that the laundry tags in question, that is, a red tag $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide by 1 1/16" long bearing the code 02B-6 or D2B-6, are made by an dder-type machine which prints five characters. The color red indicated to him that the laundry was on a special tag.

At 10:58 PM on 4/6/68, Reverend RICHARD FISHER 7322 South Clyde, Chicago, Illinois, (phone 684-8098) who stated he is Pastor of Martin Temple, AME Zion Church, 7158 South Indiana Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, advised that he just received a phone call from a man who said his name was JOHN but would not give his last name. JOHN told Reverend FISHER that ALBERT CARLY, whose last known address was 5650 South Laflin Street, Chicago, Illinois, was paid \$10,000 to assasinate Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING and that half of the money was put up by the "Cicero Boys"

FISHER further stated that he asked JOHN why he was giving him this information and JOHN said "you called and asked for it". Reverend FISHER stated that he had not made such a call. Reverend FISHER added that the caller sounded like a white man and talked rationally. Reverend FISHER said the man hung up when he told him that he had not called him.

SUMMARY INFO

The following information was obtained from the Memphis Division and is not to be discussed outside the Bureau. Any investigation conducted re suspect ERIC STARVO GALT should be discreet and on a confidential basis.

KING was shot at 6:00 p.m. on April 4, 1968, from the back window of a flop house overlooking KING's motel. The murderer evidently left the flop house through the front entrance and while going to his car saw an unidentified Sheriff's Deputy running down the street with his gun drawn. It is surmised that this is the reason that the murderer dropped the box containing the rifle which was wrapped in a bedspread and his suitcase by a small business establishment.

The owner of the establishment heard the thud of the box being dropped went out to the street, looked both ways, and saw no one. At this point, a white car pulled away from the curb and drove off at a fairly high rate of speed. One of the colored persons in the establishment stated that the car was a Mustang. In addition, sometime around 5:30 p.m., a man and wife parked their car on the same street directly behind a car identified as a white Mustang. This vehicle bore red and white license plates but the witness is not sure as to whether it was red numerals with white background or vice versa. It is noted that Alabama plates are red and white.

In the suitcase dropped with the box containing the rifle were a pair of brownish-checkered undershorts and a white jockey T-shirt bearing cloth laundry tags. The tags are made by a thermo seal marking machine manufactured by the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York.



These tags are one quarter inch wide and one and one sixteenth inch long, red in color and bear marking which appears to be "02B-6" or "D2B-6". Only a portion of the first character is present on each tag, and this character is cut on a slight bias. No other visible laundry marks were found on either garment. This office and other offices are in the process of attempting to trace instant tag.

Further investigation by Birmingham Division has developed that on March 29, 1968, a man using the name HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER purchased a Marlin rifle. He returned the next day, March 30, 1968, made some comment that he was not satisfied with the Marlin rifle, and traded it in for a .30-06 Remington rifle. The composite description at the end of this memo is based upon the salesman's impressions as well as other witnesses in Memphis. The Identification Division has indicated that there are identifiable latent prints on the rifle and on the Redfield scope plus a binocular case which might have been found in the motel room. This fact is not known but the case does tie in to the murderer. There is also pâlm prints for comparison purposes.

ERIC STARVO GALT is the prime suspect at the moment because he answers the general physical description of the murderer plus the following:

Memphis determined that GALT was registered in the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and checked out on April 4, 1968. He was driving a white Mustang with Alabama plates. Birmingham further developed that he lived in the rooming house in Birmingham, Alabama, from September 1 to December 1, 1967. The Mustang was bought from a private individual and was paid for with \$1900.00 cash. GALT did not test drive the vehicle saying that he had no driver's license but that he would obtain one. According to Memphis, GALT is a complete "mystery man" and they are attemptint to concentrate efforts to develop background information concerning him. Birmingham did develop that GALT resided at 2608 Highland Avenue South, Birmingham, and was the owner of a 1966 Mustang bearing 1967 Alabama license 1A88354. Further check shows 1968 Alabama registration as 1-38993.

GALT is described from driver's license info as a white male, DOB height 5'11", weight 175 pounds, blue eyes, brown hair.

The composite description of the unknown subject in this case is white male, 26-40 (however believed to be closer to 30), height 5'8"-5'11", weight 150-170 pounds, dark brown hair (combed straight back without part), eyes light, probably blue or green, build medium, complexion smooth, gives the impression of being very clean cut and neat appearing. At time of murder, he was wearing a dark suit, white shirt and necktie. No cigarette butts were found in the rented room. Rifle was right-handed leading to the assumption that the subject is also right-handed.

In all teletypes relating to the laundry tag investigation and investigation surrounding GALT, the Bureau has stated that under no circumstances should anyone be told these investigations are in connection with MURKIN.

SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE, Birmingham, telephonically advised that investigation re ERIC STARVO GALT in Birmingham reveals he resided at 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama, from 8/26 to 10/7/67. The landlord at this address advised that sometime during mid September, 1967, GALT received a package from Chicago, approximate size 18" x 12" x 8", weighing 20 to 25 lbs. GALT reported opened and examined the package and informed the landlord he did not like the merchandise and thereafter returned it.

The landlord further advised that approximately three weeks ago, GALT received a letter from Chicago, which the landlord held to the light and believed it contained a check. The landlord returned the letter to the sender. He is unable to recall the name or address.

It was the landlord's opinion that the contents of the package may have been phonograph records, however, he did not hear any music played in GALT's room and when GALT checked out, he only had three suitcases.

Action: Check all logical mail order houses using above name, address and circumstances.

> SAC ROBERT JENSEN, Memphis, telephonically advised this date that there is every indication that the unsub in this case is an illegal of an ethnic group, possibly Nordic. He advised that investigation has developed two safety deposit boxes maintained by GALT, wherein he handled all transactions by cash and the reference for the safety deposit boxes have been in the name of his uncle KARL GALT.

He also advised that there is every indication that the articles ordered from Chicago were of electronic type. He based this on the fact that found in the blue suitcase discarded at the scene were a pair of duckbill pliers used in electronic type work, which were bought in Los Angeles two blocks from a location where one JAY WALLIS VERNON, aka., JEROME WALLIS VERNON operated a laundromat. This individual fits the description of suspect GALT.

In addition, SAC JENSEN advised that with regard to the St. Louis lead regarding employment, this was based on the fact that GALT has professed employment as a merchant marine on canal and lake barges.

Financial institutions leads should be expanded to include GALT, HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER, JOHN WILLARD and JAY WALLIS VERNON, aka., JEROME WALLIS VERNON.

In addition, in line with contacts with the merchant marine and headquarters for Great Lakes shipping in Chicago, the Indianapolis and Detroit Offices should be advised

At 11:55 am this date SA Bob Ray of the Albany Office telephonically contacted the Chicago Office and advised the following:

Albany is in receipt of the teletypes sent by Chicago requesting the identity of laundries using the Thermo Seal. Marking Machines in the U.S. and the identity of companies distributing the tape used in the machines. Albany has been in the process of sending out a forty one page airtel to all offices setting out the identity of these laundries, which went out on 4/10/68, and another airtel being prepared now is going to be sent to all offices with additional information. In addition, the Bureau is preparing suitable number of copies for all offices of color photographs of the marking tape recovered at the scene of Murkin for use in inquires regarding the tapes. Albany suggested that investigation regarding the tapes be held in abeyance pending receipt of the Albany airtels. It was suggested to Albany that a teletype be sent to all offices advising them of the above information.

SA Ray additionally advised that there is a machine located in Los Angeles, Calif., which is believed to have made the tape recovered * Murkin. The laundry where this machine is located is a leased laundry and was leased until the latter part of March, 1968 by J. WALLIS VERNON, who at that time absconded with the records of the laundry. The laundry is located six blocks from the hardware store where the pliers westpurchased that was recovered an Murkin.

No additional investigation being conducted regarding the laundry tapes pending receipt of Albany airtels.

Re phone call from Supervisor R. STOETZEL, 4/8/68, pursuant to which the following investigation was conducted by writer 4/8/68 in re man identified as HAYDEN EUGENE/THOMPSON.

AT HIGHWOOD FILLINGIS:

Plice Chief TED BENVENUTO advised he has personally known HAYDEN THOMPSON, who has no arrest record with his department, for the past 6-7 years, during which time he has been an irregular resident of Highwood. THOMPSON is a "hill-billy singer," who has appeared on local "barn dance" TV shows, and who has recorded some songs. He has worked locally as a bartender and cab-driver, is known to BENVENUTI as a hard worker, and recently told BENVENUTI that he had brought his parents up from "down South" and they "really like" Highwood, where they live in an aparement at 43 Clay Street, adjacent to the boundary of Fort Sheridan.

JOSEPH MASSIMO (protect identity), co-owner with DON CASTELTANI of Lake C.b Company (chartered in Highland Park), 214 Green Bay Road, Highwood (home address 1440 Greenwood, Deerfield, phone 945-6606), confidentially advised as follows:

HAYDEN EUGENE THOMPSON, who was fingerprinted for a cab license by Highland Park PD, lives in Apartment H, 43 Clay, Highwood, phone 433-3890, and has been employed on day-time shift as cab driver the past two years or so, during which he has been most dependable and honest. He drives a 1964 green T-Bird with white top, and is about 32, 6-0, 185. On Friday, 3/29/68, he went on a "week's vaca tion" to take his father and mother down home," believed to be Memphis. Although he was to have returned to town over the weekend, he did not report for work morning of 4/8/68, although MASSIMO saw him (THOMPSON) driving around town. Another cab driver, BOB VANDERPOOL, who lives in same apartment building as THOMPSON remarked Saturday, that THOMPSON had apparently returned "during the night," since his car was parked outside early that morning. MASSIMO will admonish THOMPSON upon his return to work as to why he didn't come to work 4/8/68, and will normally inquire as to his trip south.

The following information was received from ASAC JOSEPH SYLVESTER, New Orleans, which in turn was relayed from SAC, Birmingham. Investigation to date has revealed that 8 identifiable latents were recovered by Memphis. In addition, these latents have been compared with those of JAY VERNON, Los Angeles and no identification effected.

When Unsub LOWMEYER purchased the Marlin in Birmingham, he reportedly returned it, stating 'My brother doesn't want this type of gun". Thereafter, the gun shop spent two hours transferring the scope to the murder weapon. With regard to the murder weapon, the fatal bullet has been identified with the 30.06 and of interest is the fact that there was only one bullet in the chamber.

Investigation Birmingham and surrounding offices has proven that all information furnished by GALT is fictitious, that is regarding his employment, etc. The safe deposit box used by GALT in Birmingham has been flown to Washington, D. C. for latent examination. In addition, sometime in Décember, GALT mailed the keys to this safe deposit box to the bank from Biloxi, Mississippi.

A Bureau artist's conception is being prepared and should be available within the next two days. An APB on points of entry and with all law enforcement officers has been put out for GALT and the white Mustang, with the caution that he or the car not be linked with this case.

The following investigation was conducted by SA JAMES A. POND at Chicago, Illimois:

On 4/11/68, at Aldens, Inc., 5000 West Roosevelt Road, ROBERT HENSEN, District Credit Manager, advised that Aldens offedit account or mail order customers accounts are filed alphabetically by the State in which they live. He reviewed the records for the State of Alabama and could find ho record of any credit purchases by ERIC STARVO GALT; 2608 Highland Avenue South, Birmingham, Alabama, or for any person named GALT.

He suggested the Manager of the Adjustment Department be contacted inasmuch as any refunds to COD or prepaid accounts would be handled by that Department.

on 1/11/68, FRANK BARNAT, Section Manager, Adjustment Department, advised that COD or prepaid customer accounts are filed alphabetically by the State in which the customer lives. If a customer returned part or all of a COD or prepaid order, BARNAT's department would make out a check for the proper 16:55 and mail it to the customer. He reviewed the file for the State of Alabama and could locate no record of any refund to ERIC STARVO GALT of Birmingham, or any customer named GALT. He stated that if a check wassent to a customer and the customer moved without leaving a forwarding address, the check would be returned to his Department. If the customer later advised Aldens of a new address in a different state, his original account would remain in the State file in which the order was placed and a complete copy of the file would then be put in the new State.

He checked the Transaction Section which maintains an alphabetical list of all Aldens customers and could locate no record for any GALT. The above three departments, according to GALT, would have a record if GALT washer had been a customer. Because no record was found in these departments, he concluded, GALT was not an Aldens customer.





He explained VINCENT DePALMA was also known as VINNIE and has a slightly more square nose.

BUMGARDNER stated that he is a member of the strike team of the Minutemen. He said he is scheduled to testify in Seattle, Washington, for the Federal Government concerning actions of the Minutemen. He said he has cooperated with the FBI in Kansas City and Denver concerning the activities of the Minutemen.

BUMGARDNER stated he believes that it is very possible that the assassination of KING was engineered or handled by members of the Minutemen organization. He

On April 9, 1968, the following investigation conducted by SA ROBERT E. HALL and SA THOMAS J. GREEN:

By personal observation, it was determined that there is no such address as 1339 South Western, Chicago, Illinois.

The residence at 1339 North Western Avenue is in a Puerto Rican-Spanish American neighborhood and consists of a three-floor flat building, owned by M. B. RIVERA, occupant of the third floor.

Interviews were conducted with Mrs. CALDERON through a nine-year old grandson, interpreter. Mrs. CALDERON and ther family occupy the first floor. Interviews were also conducted with Mrs. AMANDA CONDE who occupies the second floor flat.

The name JOHN SCOTT CANDRIAN was unknown to any of the persons interviewed. They had no knowledge that any person in the 1300 block of North Western was attending school in Memphis, Tennessee, and no person residing at 1339 North Western had children older than high school age.

It was noted that other names on the mail box with Mrs. CALDERON were also Spanish names: MORALES and SANDIN.

Inquiry of the Illinois Bell Telephone Company determined that the prefix number 396 is not in the Chicago area but is in North Antioch, Wisconsin. The current Illinois Bell Telephone Company telephone directories for the Chicago area have no listing for a JOHN SCOTT CANDRIAN.

Mr. GUY GRABILL, 6942 Higgins, Chicago, Ill., telephone RO3-6969, who advised that he must not receive any publicity in regards to this matter and that in the event he need be recontacted he be contacted discretely, personally and that the person contacting him not identify themselves to anyone at his place of business other than himself stated that he operates a Realty Business. In the course of business, on 4/1/68 his salesmen distributed cards, door to door, advising the residence owners that in the event they were interested in placing there property for sale they should return the card.

On 4/2/68 a card was returned bearing the name, JOHN WELLARD, 7802 Clarence, indicating this person was interested in placing his residence for sale. When a salesman went to the address to follow up it was determined that it is a non-existent address.

Mr. Grabill advised that in following the newspaper accounts of the death of KING he read where this same name or one very similar somehow entered into the case. He stated that this has been on his mind and although he realizes there is probably no connection and this is only a coincidence he wanted to call and give the FBI the benefit of the information.

Mr. Grabill was advised that the information would be brought to the attention of the appropriate agents and in the event he need be recontacted it would be done discretely.
