At 8:12 AM, Friday, 4/19/68, mustached little man, proudly proclaiming his identity as BILLY HITCHCOCK, knocked at the RA door, strode in and promptly hung up his jacket and combed his long/wavy hair, and announced that he wanted to see "Mr. HOOVER," whose photo confronted him. Speaking rapidly and precisely in clipped tones, he said his visit was two-fold: (1) to get a job, as he had always liked police work, and (2 togive some information.

Questioned as to his own identity and as to the information he wanted to impart, HITCHCOCK preferred rather to portray himself as a much-traveled, well-educated (University of Berkeley) man-of the-world who had come all the way from California to seek FBI employment. It was elicited from him that has information concerned the fact that he had just come from Memphis (not California) via hitch-hiking and he "believed" he had ridden into Chicago early 1/18/68 with the man who killed Dr. KING.

He explained that he was hitch-hiking outside Memphis (route unknown) late Wednesday, 4/17/68, and got a ride all the way to Chicago with this suspecious man, who was driving a/ 1960 light green Chevrolet tudor, six cylinder, all smashed in front. They drove all night in this car, which made it," and this fellow, who gave his name as "GOO-F-F," left HITCHCOCK off on State street (someplace - cross street unknown) in Chicago, saying he "had to go; the little woman's waiting for me." HITCHCOCK paid no attention to the license, which may have been Tennessee plates. This man made no mention of KING, and HITCHCOCK was vague as to his reasons for thinking of this man as a suspect. HITCHCOCK described him as wm, about 5-6, brown or black hair, blue eyes, slip-on shoes, age and weight unknown. He said he could better draw a picture of the man, rather than describe him, whereupon he drew attached "picture" of "G-O-F-F."

HITCHCOCK allowed that he was a better auctioneer or hill-billy singer-yodeler than he was an artist, and thereupon good-naturedly volunt pered samples of his chants and yodels.

He deried that he was wanted anywhere (NCIC checked negatively 4/19/68), that he had ever been institutionalized (Downey VA Hospital telephonically advised that no such a patient had eloped), that he had never registered for Selective Service (his story that he had lost his cards and applied for new ones 4/18/68 with IB 150, Waukegan, was verified) or that he had been in SEARCHED NOTEXED.

any serious trouble, saying that his most serious arrest was 1/11/68, when he was booked in Jonesboro, Arkansas, and then released, for having a special police badge in his possession.

In his pockets, HITCHCOCK had a bank book of Mercantile Bank, Jonesboro, Arkansas, which showed one entry, 1/11/68, opening a savings account with \$1.50 deposit. He also had business cards of CORDELL HULL SIOAN, 807-9 81 Madison Building, Memphis, phone JA 6-6727, on which was penciled the date 1/13/68, and of ABRAHAM E. HORN, attorney, Memphis, phone 526-2500. HITCHCOCK said he got the cards "off some fellow," and followed that by saying "I'm no queer." He said he stayed at the Rex Hotel, Memphis, before heading north.

He said he had stayed in the Pla, a H tel, Jukegan, the night of 1/18-19/68, had only 75 cents left, and needed a job, as he had "always believed in working for a living."

HITCHCOCK agreed that he would voluntarily go the the Waukegan PD 4/19/68 to be fingerprinted (and photographed), which he did, under Waukegan PD #E701, fingerprint glassification 20 9 R OIM 3. Sergeant CHARLES ROSE, WPD, $1 \ \overline{0} \ \overline{1} \ \overline{1$

advised that HITCHCOCK had been there shortly after 6 AM, 4/19/68, wanting to see the mayor about a job, and that HITCHCOCK went outside and spit back at ROSE when the latter told him to leave the building. Thereafter, HITCHCOCK returned to Waukegan RA to advise he had "lied;" that he had not gone to University of 'Berkeley" but had got his education by studying while confined on three occasions from 1960 to 1965 at the State Hospital, Nevada, Missouri.

On 1/20/68, HITCHCOCK appeared at Waukegan RA and announced that he was leaving to visit his sick mother in a Houston, Missouri hospital, and might "never, newer" return to Waukegan.

In the extensive background investigation conducted concerning JAMES EARL RAY and his family, the following common denominators were noted:

Brother JOHN attended bartender school in Chicago and was employed at various country clubs in the Chicago area. JOHN presently owns a bar in St. Louis, Missouri, although the bar is technically in the sister, CAROL PEPPER's name, since JOHN is an ex-con and cannot own a bar legally.

Brother JERRY RAY is presently employed at the Sportsman's Club, Northbrook, Illinois, as a janitor-maintenance man. He also was employed in various country clubs throughout the Chicago area, and obtained this employment through his brother JOHN's instigation. JERRY also has expressed a desire to open a bar and to attend bartender school.

An uncle was also employed in various country clubs throughout the Chicago area and in St. Louis and Southern Illinois area.

The subject has attended bartender school, may have been previously employed in country clubs and prior to leaving the Los Angeles area, made several phone calls to country clubs in an effort to obtain employment both in a bartender and maintenance man capacity.

It is for the foregoing reasons that personal contact of the country clubs attached to this memorandum is being requested. Investigation has established that the subject was in prison until April 23, 1967, and his whereabouts commenced being known around September 1, 1967, until April 5, 1968. Accordingly, the employment records of the various country clubs should be reviewed from the period of time of April 24, 1967, to September 1, 1967, and for any new bartender or maintenance man employees from April 5, 1968, to date. The country club personnel contacted should be alerted to the possibility that the subject might contact them for employment. A copy of the IO is being furnished to be left at the country club.
