

MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

Officer Theron Toole, Human Relations Unit, Chicago Police Department, advised on November 13, 1967, that Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., President, Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC), had arrived in Chicago at approximately 1:00 p.m. on November 11, 1967. King had arrived in Chicago on Northwest Airlines from Atlanta, Georgia, SCLC headquarters. King was in Chicago as featured speaker at the University of Chicago, Center for Continuing Education, where an anti Viet Nam conference, The National Labor Leadership Association for Peace, was being held over the period November 10 through 12, 1967.

Toole advised that King had departed Chicago either late during the evening of November 11, 1967, or early November 12, 1967, reportedly for New York City, New York. While King had been in Chicago, there had been no incidents or disturbances connected with his business here.

Attached to this memorandum are articles from Chicago's daily news media; these articles containing excerpts from King's remarks in his appearance on November 11, 1967, at the Center for Continuing Education.

On November 13, 1967, Edward Mc Clellen, Executive Secretary, Chicago Branch, National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), advised as follows:

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside of your agency.

SEARCHED STORED BELLALIVED OF BUILD OF

MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

The NAACP Office, Chicago, on that date had received a telegram from Mrs. Jessie Kilgraf, 752 Liberty Street, Apartment 7, Penfield, New York. The telegram had stated as follows:

"Please find Dr. Martin Luther King and warn him his life is in danger. Go easy on speeches for a while."

Officer Toole, above, advised on November 13, 1967, that the Chicago Police Department was aware of the above information available to Mc Clellen.
