Enclosed for the Memphis Division is one Bureau of Employees Compensation directory showing various districts in the United States.

Mr. JOHN P. TRAYNOR, Deputy Commissioner, Bureau of Employees Compensation, U. S. Department of Labor, Federal Office Building, Cleveland, Ohio, advised SA JOHN J. JUREY his office covers compensation claims for the states of Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky, West Virginia, Tennessee, and certain areas along the Great Lakes in Pennsylvania and New York. These claims are ones filed under the Federal Employees Compensation Act (FECA) and the Longshoremen's and Harbor Workers Compensation Act (LYWCA).

Mr. TRAYNOR advised he could locate no record in his files for ERIC STARVO GALT, JEROME WALLIS VERNON or HARVEY LOWMEYER. He could locate no record for JOHN WILLARD under the LHWCA, however, he did locate a record reflecting one JOHN R. WILLARD, white, age 46 at the present time, who in 4/63, was an employee of the U. S. Post Office, Dowagiac, Michigan, filed a claim under FECA, claiming a back injury.

At the time of the claim WILLARD resided at 712 East Prairie Rende Street, Dowagiac, Michigen, who had been an employee of the Post Office for 13 months and who served in the U. S. Army from 6/19/42 - 12/8/45.

Referenced Cleveland teletype requested Latent Fingerprint Section to compare Government and Army prints of WILLARD with latent prints located in this matter.

By way of background, TRAYNOR advised that with regard to LHWCA there are 15 districts in the United States including Alaska and Hawaii and if a claim is filed under this act the district where the claim is filed would have a record of it, however, there is no central repository for these records such as in Washington, D.C. To make a complete check, each district would have to be checked individually.

With regard to FECA his Washington headquarters would have a record of any claim filed regardless of the location as they maintain a central filing system.

Mr. TRAYNOR made available a directory which outlines the 15 districts covered by his organization and the location of the district headquarters. It is not known by the Cleveland Division if leads have been set forth to check the files of the various districts.

Enclosed for Memphis and Birmingham are one photo each of TOMMY RAY WHITE.

On 4/15/68, Mrs. BARBARA DIEHL. 3239 Route 225, Rootstown, Ohio, phone 947-2559 (Atwater), which is located about halfway between Youngstown and Akron, Ohio, furnished the following information which she requested be kept confidential:

She stated that after the killing of KING on 4/4/68, she and other members of her family observed sketches of the subject in Ravenna and Akron papers. They observed what they believe is a striking resemblance to her former son-in-law TOMMY RAY WHITE, who divorced her daughter, PATRICIA ANN WHITE, who is making her home with her at present. They stated at first all of them who knew her former son-in-law treated the matter as a joke but the more they have thought about the act, the more they are of the opinion that he could be the man being sought for the KING murder.

She stated her daughter separated from WHITE in June, 1966, and he secured a divorce from her in Jefferson County, Alabama. He was last in Portage County, Ohio, from 3/18-22/68, when a hearing was held relative to the custody of the child of the marriage, namely LYETTE WHITE, age 3. She stated on this occasion WHITE apparently had no car with him and either arrived in the area by bus, plane or train. She stated that the last she knew, he drove a 1965 White Ford but she does not know what he is driving at present.

CV 44-565 He wired someone for \$200.00 for his return to Alabama after the hearing in Portage County, Ohio, and is a shiftless short who will not work long at anything. She stated her former son-in-law is definitely psychotic and always carried a loaded gun in his car when he lived in the Portage County area for a time. When they asked him why he carried a gun, he would state he carried it to "kill niggers". She stated that although he never professed to be a member of the Klan, he indicated that many of his close friends were Klan members and expressed a deep seated hate for Negroes. He threatened to kill her daughter on many occasions and that was why she separated from him. She stated when in Portage County, Ohio, in March he told them he had married a girl whose maiden name was SHARON HENDERSON, a woman with three children by an unsuccessful marriage. Her family had formerly lived near his former home on Hill Avenue, Hueytown, Alabama. THE FBI DIRECTOR SAID THAT GALT, WHO HAS USED THE NAMES OF JOHN WILLARD AND HARVEY LOWMYER IN THE PAST, IS THE OWNER OF A 1966 WHITE MUSTANG BEARING ALABAMA LICENSE PLATES WHICH WAS LOCATED ABANDONED IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON APRIL 11, 1968. INVESTIGATION DISCLOSED THAT GALT PURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN BIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S ODOMETER SHOWED THAT IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967, AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

Mr. JOHNSON stated that he is the only Negro employed on the assembly line in his specific area. He stated on March 30, 1968, some of his fellow workers were joking about a killing that they had planned. He stated they spoke of a man being very well dressed from out of town and a white Mustang. He stated that during the course of the conversation, one individual known to him only as "MORGAN" stated that the Klan would pay \$100,000.00 for the killing of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. He stated that one of the individuals who is employed in Department 80, known to him as BOB, was the one who was supposed to do the actual shooting. He stated that another individual known to him only as "BIG DICK" and who is also employed somewhere in the Ford Plant was to get the gun.

Mr. JOHNSON stated that BOB (LNU) would be described as a white male, age approximately 23, 5'2", 130 pounds, dark hair, medium build, who wears cowboy shirts. He stated that the last time that BOB WOrked was on March 29, 1968, and since that time he has heard that BOB is in a hospital, although he stated he has not seen his work card which would indicate that he is on sick leave.

Mr. JOHNSON stated that he had no other information to offer other than the talk that he had heard among these men concerning a possible killing. When asked why these individuals would discuss such a matter in front of him, he stated he guessed that they did not think that he would tell.





The hand printing appearing on the slip of paper comprising a portion of Q124 was searched in the Anonymous Letter File without effecting an identification. Appropriate photographs have been added to this file for future reference.

The cellophane tape comprising a portion of Q124 is of common  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch-wide variety, the ends of which appear to have been torn or cut unevenly.

Due to the limited nature of the questioned hand printing on Q124 and because of unexplained variations, a definite conclusion could not be reached whether the hand printing on Q124 is identical to the hand printing appearing on documents attributable to Eric S. Galt, submitted in this case. A number of significant differences were noted indicating
