ABOUT TWENTY MINUTES LATER, HE WENT OUTSIDE AND A CAB DRIVER ENTERED WHO ASKED TWA CLERK TIME THE NEXT FLIGHT LEAVES. HE WAS TOLD FIVE TEN AM AND LEFT. UNKNOWN MALE THEN RETURNED AND ASKED CLERK SAME QUESTION AND RECEIVED SAME ANSWER. UNKNOWN MALE ASKED THE CLERK IF HE COULD LEAVE COLUMBUS ANY OTHER WAY BECAUSE HE SAID HE HAD TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY. BOYS WHO WERE CURIOUS AS TO WHY HE HAD NO LUGGAGE. IN: RESPONSE TO THEIR QUESTIONS HE TOLD AT TIMES THREE DIFFERENT STORIES; HE HAD NO LUGGAGE, HE LOST IT, AND IT WAS ROUTED TO ANOTHER AIRPORT. HE ALSO TOLD THEM HE HAD AN UNUSED AIRLINE TICKET TO REDEEM BUT DID NOT HAVE TIME TO DO SO. TWA CLERK SAID HE HAD NO TICKET. UNKNOWN MALE THEN CALLED A CAB AND LEFT ALLEGEDLY FOR GREYHOUND BUS TERMINAL.

ABOUT FOUR THIRTY AM, TWO YELLOW CAB COMPANY DRIVERS ENTERED WAITING ROOM AND THREE BOYS OVERHEARD CONVERSATION REGARDING UNKNOWN MALE THAT ONE DRIVER HAD DRIVEN FROM AIRPORT. DRIVER SAID HE WAS SUSPICIOUS OF THIS PERSON WHO SAID HE WAS FROM ST. LOUIS AND WHOM HE HAD DRIVEN TO A PRIVATE RESIDENCE IN THE AREA. DRIVER SAID HE WAS PAID WITH A ROLL OF DIMES WHICH HAD CINCINNATI ON THE WRAPPER. DRIVER SAID HE WAITED OUTSIDE RESIDENCE TO SEE IF SOMEONE WOULD LET THE UNKNOWN MALE ENTER AT THAT EARLY HOUR, AND WAS TOLD BY THE UNKNOWN MALE NOT TO WAIT BUT TO LEAVE. THE DRIVER DID NOT OBSERVE THE UNKNOWN MALE RING A BELL OR ATTEMPT TO ENTER THIS HOUSE. CAB DRIVER ALSO STATED THIS PERSON RESEMBLED PHOTOGRAPH OF JAMES EARL RAY THAT HE HAD SEEN IN THE NEWSPAPER.

ESTIMATED HE OBSERVED AND TALKED TO UNKNOWN MALE FOR ABOUT AN HOUR AND AFTER OVERHEARING CAB DRIVER'S CONVERSATION, THE THREE BOYS, TWO CAB DRIVERS AND TWA CLERK DISCUSSED UNKNOWN MALE AND AFTER VIEWING PHOTOGRAPH OF JAMES EARL RAY IN NEWSPAPER, DECIDED THE UNKNOWN MALE CLOSELY RESEMBLED RAY.

She did not observe type of automobile those men were driving stating same was believed parked just outside the Andersons Office. When shown WF #442 (ERIC STARVO GALT), Miss COREY stated subject does not resemble either of the two men described above & also described in Ref. Serial 148.

At Walbridge, Ohio:

On 4/19/68 Mrs. RALPH PETERS, 115 Clinton St., advised her husband is a PRR employee; that he will not be available for interview at the PETERS residence before 4/22/68.

On 4/22/68 RALPH PETERS was contacted. He stated he was eating in the Lincoln Bar-Restaurant, 916 Jeff. Ave., Toledo during late p.m. of 4/17/68; that he observed a man who seemed to bear some resemblance to MURKIN subject GALT whose photo was shown on TV. However, he stated subsequent thereto he noted subject's photo in local newspapers; that close study of newspaper photos reflect man previously observed by Mr. PETERS bears no resemblance to Subject.


On 4/19/68 Edwin Kelley, University Garage 2017 Cornell Ave, Vieveland advised that after seeing the photo of ERIC 5 Galf on TV, he recalled that an individual who looked like GALT had been in his garage on April 8 or 9, 1968 and had his 1968 White Mustang serviced andoil changed. He stated that this ocurred about 2:00 P.M. that the individual paid for the w work in cash; the individual indicted to Kelley that he had driven a long way and Kelley recalled that the car did need a oil change. He stated that the car had Ohio license but could not recall whether they were 1967 or 1968. Kelley recalled this individual wore a white shirt, a tie and dark pants; he not recall observing anything inside the car or anything unusual about the indidvidual.

Kelley stated that this individual looked like the picture of Galt in which he wore a bow tie; he added that this individual appaered to have a shorter hair cut than the one in the picture. Kelley was shown a picture of M MAMES EARL RAY, however was unable to say whether this photo was a better picture of the individual he had observed. He stated that he had never seen this individual before but felt sure that he would recognize him again and if he appeared at the garage he would immediately call the FBI office.

Kelley was questioned regarding the bartender at a downtown bar who also ;looked like GALT. He advised that this individual, whom he knew as "JOHNNY" had been employed at the Gazelle Bar across f-rom the Hotel Statler, but that this bar has been out of business for over 2 or 3 years. He added that he knew definitely that "Johnny" is not GALT but thought that his general appearance was similar to GALT.

Kelley added that none of his employees had observed the individual mentioned above.

ALBERT PLUTH, desk clerk, College Motel, 11214 Eucild Ave, located around the corner from the University Garange was shown photos of James Earl Ray, but said he had never seen him before and definitely not at the motel.

On 4/22/68, Capt. RAY ROWLES, Post 2, Summit Co. 50 telephonically advised he had been telephonically contacted by ELLIS ROBERTS, a Greyhound Bus driver, who said he had transported a male resembling ERIC GALT on a trip from Akron to Youngstown, last Thursday, 4/18. ROBERTS told ROWLES he would be at the Akron terminal at 10:30 AM.

At 10:30 AM, ROBERTS was contacted at the Greyhound Terminal, Broadway and Center Streets, Akron.

He advised on 4/18 he picked up a passenger at Akron at 2:50 PM. The man had a ticket from Cincinnati to Mansfield, via Medina, to Akron, to Youngstown, to Salem, Ohio. He told the man he would have to get a new ticket and had a brief conversation with the man about the ticket. He then contacted the dispatcher, who advised it would be alright to take the man to Youngstown on the existing ticket.

ROBERTS described the man as a white male, about 35 years old, 5'9" tall, medium build, ruddy complexion, dark hair starting to bleach light in front, eyes un-noticed, wearing a brown spring top-coat, a light yellow sport shirt, dark pants, shoes and socks.

In discussing the ticket with the man, ROBERTS thought the man was quite suspicious. The man talked with a rough Southern accent and was minimum about and unfriendly. After arriving in Youngstown, at about 12/12 PM, 4/18/68, ROBERTS noticed the man had no luggage at all, nor was he carrying any bags or packages. ROBERTS watched for the man around the Youngstown terminal, to see if the man would get the 5:30 PM bus to Salem, but the man did not get the Salem bus. ROBERTS said there is only one bus to Salem per day, with the man driver on it all the time, although he couldn't remember the driver's name.

The following day, ROBERTS saw the photo of ERIC GALT in the newspaper and immediately thought it looked exactly like the man on the bus the preceding day. ROBERTS said he had to wait until this morning to notify his boss, to obtain permission to notify the authorities about the man.

Youngstown - exhibit photo of GALT to Greyhound Bus Driver who has daily trip to Salem, to determine if he recognizes; or to ticket seller who would possibly refund unused portion of ticket to Salem.

STARTZELL advised he had been contacted by a representative of the "Lorain Journal" who inquired as to what action the FBI was taking in connection with the suspect being held by the Lorain Police Department in connection with the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.

Lt. KOZAK, Lorain PD, was telephonically contacted by SA MARTIN P. MC CANN, JR. He advised that CHARLES BISHOP was first noticed by a Lorain Negro policeman who, because of BISHOP's driving a 1968 white Mustang, was believed possibly involved in the KING assassination.

Lt. KOZAK stated that on this date, CHARLES BISHOP voluntarily appeared at the Lorain PD, at which time he was photographed and fingerprinted. Lt. KOZAK advised that BISHOP is described as follows:

Lt. KOZAK advised he has seen the Wanted Flyer in connection with JAMES EARL RAY and that this individual bears no resemblance whatsoever to RAY.

On 4/20/68, the Cleveland Office was telephonically contacted by a guard from the Cuyahoga County Jail who advised that an inmate, which wished to speak with an FBI Agent in connection with JAMES EARL RAY.

On Saturday, 4/20/68, was interviewed at the Cuyahoga County Jail by SA MARTIM P. MC CANN, JR., at which time he advised as follows:

advised that he is presently incarcerated in the Cuvahoga County Jail, having been arrested on on a carrying concealed weapon charge.

stated he is presently on parole out of Missouri State Penitentiary until . He stated that he had been serving a 10 year sentence for armed robbery and had served in Missouri State Penitentiary from he was placed on parole.

advised that during this time of incarceration at Missouri State Penitentiary he was in K Hall, cell . He stated that the Missouri State Penitentiary has one-man cells and that JAMES EARL RAY, during this period of time, was incarcerated in cell 191.

stated that RAY was a bread man and that he worked in the bakery. He stated that RAY's duties consisted of slicing the bread for the meals and that because of these duties RAY would be up earlier than the other inmates and would usually be back in his cell at 7:00 AM and would be free to come and go as he pleased during meal hours.

advised that RAY was a racist and many times he heard him discussing his dislike for Negroes.

advised that he would be considered a friend of RAY's but this was due mainly to the fact that they both had free time and that their cells were near each others and that during break periods they would discuss various matters.

stated that RAY had no close friends inside the prison and would be considered strictly a loner. stated that RAY RAY was hooked on amphetamine powders. always had an "outfit" in his cell, stating that an "outfit" was a nose dropped with a needle with which he would shoot a solution made up from the amphetamine powder into his veins. BOND stated that he considered RAY a "fiend" on amphetamine powders. He stated that he was constantly shooting the amphetamines into his veins. stated that he was not sure exactly what type of amphetamines RAY used but that he knows that RAY secured the amphetamines through a source in the prison at a price that ranged anywhere from \$50 - \$100 per spoonful stated that on occasion RAY would break down the amount of powder he received and in turn would sell it in smaller packages.

and that he attributed this nervousness to his using amphetamines. He stated that because of the use of this drug RAY was a very poor eater and slept very little. Stated that he did not recall RAY smoking hardly at all and that he drank very little. Stated that RAY would have access to "hooch" made from potato or rice that was made in the prison bakery but that to the best of his knowledge RAY drank very little. Stated that if amphetamine powder was not available RAY would break up "bennies" and use it.

advised that RAY was strictly a lone wolf and never discussed his own personal background. Stated that RAY was an avid reader of sex books and girlie magazines but that he had never known him to engage in any homosexual acts.

stated that he did not recall RAY getting many visitors and very few letters. He stated, however, that on occasion when RAY did not have sufficient money to buy the amphetamine RAY would get a letter smuggled out of the prison to some unknown individual who in turn would send a check directly to the inmate RAY was purchasing the drug from and as soon as the check cleared would get the amphetamine.

advised that while incarcerated in the Missouri State Penitentlary he had his own little business going which was renting books. He stated it was because of his renting books to RAY he was familiar with the type of books RAY read. He stated that he did not recall specifically but believed that RAY had read practically all of the James Bond series with the exception of "Man With a Golden Gun".

stated that RAY was a constant reader and that he used to write considerably. He stated that he did not know if RAY was writing letters or what, but that he had observed him on many occasions writing page after page.

stated that RAY's personal habits, as far as cleanliness of his person, were excellent but he did not keep his cell clean and things would be thrown all over the cell at various times.

cv

stated that RAY seldom went to the movies but he did not think this too strange inasmuch as the movies were a source of trouble in the prison where numerous prisoners were knifed by fellow-prisoners on various occasions.

stated that RAY had talked of escaping on numerous occasions and he believes that on one occasion he had been put into maximum security when he was caught with a rope and a hook. It tated that on another occasion RAY took part in a tunnel job that had been discovered by prison authorities who were unaware who had been involved in this attempt.

stated that RAY never trusted anyone, that he was suspicious of everyone and had a feeling that everyone was out to get him.

stated that on occasion he and RAY had talked about the philosophy of FRIEDRICH NIETZSCHE, the philosopher, and he stated it was RAY's feeling that "man can do anything as long as it seems right for him".

stated that RAY had a habit of pulling at his left ear constantly. He stated it was impossible to be with RAY for any period of time at all without being aware of this.

after much reluctance, advised that the inmate RAY purchased the amphetamine from was JIM BRADIEY. described BRADIEY as the "top con" and stated that everyone in the Missouri State Penitentiary would know BRADIEY. stated that this information being furnished by him must be kept confidential since a retainer is outstanding for him and he may be returned to the Missouri State Penitentiary and he fears retaliation should it be known information furnished by him.

BOND stated that his lawyer evidently had contacted the papers in the belief it might help his case. The asked if it were possible for the FBI to prevent the newspapers from printing his name. Was advised that there was nothing that the FBI could do in the way of repressing the newspapers and that inasmuch as it was his own attorney who had made this information available to the newspapers there was nothing that the FBI could do in this matter.

stated that he then would attempt to have the papers at least keep his name out of the papers when they printed this information.





Set forth below is a summary of information received regarding above captioned case:

At about 6:00 p.m., on April 4, 1968, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap reoming house located at $422\frac{1}{2}$ South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorreine Motel.

At about 3:00 p.m., on April 4, 1968, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422 South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6:00 p.m., on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the

sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on March 30, 1968, by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on April 4, 1968. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of April 3, 1968, at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-3893. Investigation at Birmingham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1967, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1,995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as _______ his height at 5' 11", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on April 11, 1968, and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9:00 a.m., on April 5, 1968.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

JUREY, at which time she advised that Prompt TV Service is a one-man operation run by her husband out of their home at this address. She stated that her husband has been in the TV repair business for fifteen years, and that they have resided in this home for the past nine years. 
