He stated he went around the dock, came back and copied a license number after he observed this man enter an old green vehicle which he believed to be a Chrysler product. This license was copied down by himself and he then telephoned the FMI in Washington giving them the details as he recalled some. In regards to distance, CONROY said that he was on the opposite side of the street when this man left the drugstore and he again observed him after driving around the block from a distance of 30 or so feet, but did not get a good view, since the man was in the car. CONROY was not absolutely sure that this individual was RAY, however, indicated he wished to side the FBI in any conceivable way possible, therefore, had immediately or soon thereafter telephoned Washington. On April 25, 1968, PCI was shown a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, IO. #4182 and advised she could not recognize this person and she stated she knew nooneby this name and had never heard of anybody in the Lima area using the name ERIC STARVO GALT.

#### RICHARD COSTELLO

COSTELLO in the Lima, Ohio area and assumed that he was living and probably working at Key Largo, Florida. She advised that approximately three weeks ago LEONARD FAUROT described him as a wealthy man in the Lima, Ohio area had been in her bar, but that he had merely visited in Lima, Ohio and she believed he had returned to Key Largo, Florida. She stated that she knew that LEONARD FAUROT owned a bar or restaurant across from a spot operated by MICK GRISBY at Key Largo. PCI advised she had no information relative to the reported wife of COSTELLO, name "PEG" and she had no info rmation that COSTELLO had transported PEG for immoral purposes or for the purposes of prostitution.

#### CRIMINAL CONDITIONS, CLEVELAND DIVISION

PCI advised that a young red-headed woman had patronized the bar about a week ago but had been put out by the police. She stated she did not know this person and that apparantly this girl had tried to pick up dates at the bar. She stated that she had no idea who this red head was and no idea where she was from.

PCI stated that as far as she knew, the regular local prostitutes hung around WILLIE WRIGHT's cafe or night club and also the Waldo Hotel. PCI stated that a reported boyfriend or son of EDDIE DODGE also known as EDDIE SEATON was supposed to have been involved in an armed robbery with EDDIE SEATON and this young person had lived at the Waldo Hotel. She advised that EDDIE SEATON had been arrested for armed robbery by the local police and was presently swaiting trial on a local armed robbery charge.

#### RACIAL MATTERS, LIMA, OHIO RA

PCI advised that she had not heard of any im-

On May 8, 1968, SA ROBERT A. QUAINTANCE displayed to Mr. ARTHUR LARIMER, Postmaster, U. S. Post Office, Sandusky, Ohio, the unsigned printed note and envelopes addressed to "Chief of Police, Memphis, Tenn.", and "Postmaster, Pelee Island, Ontario".

Mr. LARIMER advised that although the identity of the author was unknown to him he noted the apparent shaky. printing, and suggested that it might be the effort of an elderly person. He suggested an inquiry at the old soldiers and Sailors Home, Sandusky, might be productive.

On May 9, 1968, SA ROBERT A. QUAINTANCE contacted Mr. MICHAEL KRESTEL, Assistant Reeve, Pelee Island, Ontario, Canada, in the absence of the Reeve, Mr. CHARLES WALLACE, and the Constable, Mr. ZANE HOOKER. Mr. KRESTEL questioned the Postmaster, Mr. DONALD GOW, who advised that instant note, .35 change, and cover envelopes, were received at the post office on approximately April 24, 1968. He said that he opened the envelope addressed to him. He discovered the inner envelope already opened, which he believes may have been done accidentally by him in opening the outer envelope. He recalled the change and note, however, were lying loose in the outer envelope. He said he did not know what disposition to make of the contents and finally asked Mr. WALLACE, the Reeve, for advice. He stated it was the suggestion of Mr. WALLACE that these items be mailed to the FBI, Federal Building, Sandusky. He was unable to suggest any suspect as the author of instant note.

On May 9, 1968, Mr. ROBERT BORDERS, Registrar, Old Soldiers and Sailors Home, Columbus Avenue, Sandusky, examined instant note and envelopes and advised SA ROBERT A. QUAINTANCE he suspected them to be the work of a resident,

He said WITZLER arrived at the Home on July 19, 1962. He added that WITZLER would not be available for interview until May 10, 1968.

On May 10, 1968, SA ROBERT A. QUAINTANCE confronted CHARLES MANN WITZLER with instant note and envelopes. He admitted being the author. He said he could offer no logical reason for his writing the note and said he could only suggest that he must have been drinking at the time. He stated it was not his intention to burden or harass the Memphis, Tennessee Police Department, FBI, or any other law enforcement agency by his action.

He said his reason for enclosing \$.35 with the note was to include \$.10 for air mail postage from Pelee Island to Memphis, Tennessee; he said he visits Pelee Island a few times each summer and has bought postage at the post office there. He said he sent his note via Pelee Island simply to give the postmaster a little business.

He was admonished by SA QUAINTANCE for the consequences of his action, the wasted time and money that could have been spent on other matters. He was also admonished by Mr. BORDERS, and threatened with possible expulsion if he should repeat this misconduct.

Mr. WITZIER apologized for his action and promised to refrain from any such conduct in the future.

He admitted his note intended reference to the slaying of MARTIN LUTHER KING, however, he denied sympathy for the assassination. He said he has no knowledge of JAMES EARL RAY or his whereabouts.

He seated himself accross from the newstand at the airport, in a lounge chair.

While reading the account of the murder of Dr. M.L. KING in Memphis, Temn., on the previous day, he observed a white, male, wearing a "white suit" pass him enroune to the terminal's main entrance-exit, along the passageway which contains shops, and the bar. Upon closer examination of this man, HUGHES determined the man's "white suit" was actualy light brown in color, with dark brown stripes. He wore a white shirt, open at the color, but did not have on a necktie. He had a day's groth of beard, his suit was wrinkled, and his hair needed combing. He did not fit in with the regular airport patron, and had no luggage of any type.

HUGHED described him as being 5'10" to 6', in his early /30s, slender build, dark brown hair, and medium complexion. This man was in no hurry, and left the terminal by the main entranceexit. He was alone, and carried no packages. HUGHES said # that since that time, he has given the above matter considerable thought, and decided that possibly the man he saw at the airport might have been connected with the slaying of Dr. KING in some way.

HUGHES was shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, and decided that the sideview photograph of RAY, taken in 1960, resembled to some degree the man he observed in Baltimore on 4/5/68, but was not definate in his identification. He claimed the man he observed had an abundance of very dark brown hair, while the photo selected showed RAY with short hair. HUGHES mentioned he only had a side view of the man as he walked from the terminal.

While the Bureau's continuing policy is to encourage the public to furnish information to law enforcement authorities as a matter of good citizenship, without expectation of financial reward, it is fully recognized that monetary rewards are often necessary to motivate some individuals. The knowledge of the existence of the substantial rewards available in the Murkin case could possibly prove of value in the solution of this major investigation.
