On May 23, 1968, a confidential source advised the Cleveland Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that his wife had recently returned from Miami, Florida, where she had worked in a bar. During her stay in Miami she met a man named Roland (last name unknown), who stated he was a Ku Klux Klan Grand Dragon and who drove a white Mustang. Roland stated to her after King's death that he had knowledge of it, and that Adam Clayton Powell, Stokely Carmichael, and H. Rap Brown were also scheduled for assassination and that "we will take care of Bobby Kennedy so he will never become president."

Roland reportedly carries weapons in his car and is accompanied by a large, vicious Doberman pinscher dog.

Roland was identified by the Miami Office of the FBI as Roland Chesley Talbott, Jr. Talbott operates a white Mustang and breets Doberman pinscher dogs. He is a former member of Klavern #6, United Klans of America, Inc., Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, and last attended a meeting of Klavern #6 on September 11, 1967.

A characterization of the United Klans of America, Inc., Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, is contained in the appendix section of this memorandum.

Talbott was interviewed on May 24, 1968, at his place of employment, McGahey Chrysler-Plymouth, 1930 N. E. 2nd Avenue, Miami, Florida. He stated he has been "shooting his mouth off" sympathizing with individuals responsible for or connected with the shooting of Martin Luther King, Jr. ever since April 4, 1968.

Talbott further stated that he is of the opinion that Adam Clayton Powell, H. Rap Brown, and Stokely Carmichael should also be assassinated and that Bobby Kennedy should be stopped by non-violent means so he can never become president. Talbott believes Kennedy is responsible for all the current racial unrest in this country.

Talbott advised that he believes in the supremacy of the white race and stated that he is a former Klansman. Talbott stated even though he makes many controversial statements, he has no intention of perpetrating any such act such as shooting a Negro or political leader and is not acquainted with anyone who would do so.

Talbott advised that on occasion he carries firearms in his automobile but not for the purpose of shooting anyone.

The employment records of McGahey Chrysler-Plymouth were reviewed with reference to Roland Talbott and these records indicate that Talbott was at work at McGahey, Miami, Florida, on April 4, 1968.

UNITED KLANS OF AMERICA, INC. KNIGHTS OF THE KU KLUX KLAN

Records of Superior Court of Fulton County, Georgia, reflect that this Klan organization was granted a corporate charter on February 21, 1961, at Atlanta, Georgia, under the name United Klaps, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan of America, Inc.

A source advised on February 27, 1961, that United Klans was formed as a result of a split in U. S. Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, Inc. According to the source, the split resulted from a leadership dispute and United Klans has the same aims and objectives as the parent group. These are the promotion of Americanism, white supremacy, and segregation of the races.

The first source and a second source advised on July, 1961, that United Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan of America, Inc., merged with Alabama Knights, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan. The merged organization established headquarters in Suite 401, Alston Building, Tuscaloosa, Alabama. (The organization is directed by ROBERT SHELTON, Imperial Wizard, and is the dominant Klan group in the South, with units in several southern states.)

Second source advised that at a meeting in Prattville, Alabama, on October 22, 1961, the U. S. Klans, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, merged with the United Klans of America, Inc., Knights of the Ku Klux Klan.

Third source advised on May 25, 1966, that the UKA is currently an active organization, with Klaverns in several states. This source said that ROBERT M. SHELTON is the Imperial Wizard of this organization and was elected to this position on September 5, 1964, at a National Klonvocation in Birmingham, Alabama. Source stated that during April, 1966, the National office was moved from Suite 401, Alston Building, Tuscaloosa, Alabama, to the carport of SHELTON's residence, #18 Lake Sherwood, Star Route, Northport, Alabama, which space he had converted into a room.

Result of examination:

Specimens Q347 and Q348 were searched through the appropriate sections of the Anonymous Letter File but could not be identified with any prior submissions to this file. The waterwark "Four Star Bond Southworth Co. USA 25% Cotton Fibor" appears on Q348. The Southworth Company is located in West Springfield, Massachusetts. No indented writing or other identifying features were noted on Q347 and Q348 which might indicate the immediate source of these two items. The typewriting on Q347 and Q348 is not identical to that on other typewritten items which emenated from "Eric S. Galt!" signature on Q348 bears a pictorial resemblance to other signatures in the "Galt" name appearing on items previously submitted; however, the poor line quality and the presence of certain characteristics indicate that the signature on Q348 was not prepared by the subject James Earl Ray. On April 25, 1968, CI was shown a photograph of RAY - the IO and advised that he had never seen this individual and that the name meant nothing to him and he had never heard of ERIC STARVO GALT.

RICHARD COSTELLO

CI advised that as far as he knew, RICHARD COSTELLO was still living at Key Largo, Florida and that he had not seen COSTELLO in the Lima, Ohio area. PCI advised that he has known LEONARD FAUROT for a number of years and that LEONARD FAUROT had for years operated the Philips Kohn Company which is a pawn shop located on East Market Street near the Public Square. PCI stated that FAUROT had also purchased some kind of a restaurant or bar at Key Largo, Flroida and that he considered FAUROT to be a very wealthy men. He stated he almost considered FAUROT to be a millionaire. PCI advised that he had heard the name of POLLY mentioned but that he could not identify this parson and did not know whether or not this woman POLLY was working for FAUROT in Florida or not. In above referenced communication, the Bureau directed that all offices should contact the Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency in their States to cover the possibility that subject may have died since the commission of the crime. It was also pointed out that if no central record repository is maintained, appropriate inquiries relative to unidentified dead should be made during the course of normal business with appropriate agencies and reasonable investigation should be pursued.

In an effort to broaden this coverage, Dr. SAMUEL GERBER, Executive Secretary-Treasurer, National Association of Coroners and also coroner, Cuyahoga County, Cleveland, Ohio, who has cooperated with this office in the past and of whom there is no derogatory information, was contacted and he advised he is presently the Executive Scaretary-Treasurer of the National Coroners Association. Dr. GERBER advised that this group consists of approximately 2400 members throughout the country. He stated that he has access to the addressograph plates and he would be most happy to make these plates available to circularize the Bureau's Identification Order to the various members.

Dr. GERBER stated that in his opinion, if the Identification Order would be accompanied by a short letter from the Director, indicating that this was being done with the cooperation of the National Coroner's Association, it would create such more interest in the recipients of the letter and would obtain a higher degree of cooperation and awareness as to the contents.

Should any information come to your attention in this matter, I would appreciate your notifying the FBI Office nearest you as noted on the back of the enclosed Identification Order.

Dr. GERBER stated that as a rule, only bodies that have met with violent deaths or have not been identified are taken to the morgue in Cuyahoga County, Ohio. However, he stated that many individuals who have died of natural causes do pass through a coroner's office where there is no physican available to sign the death certificate.

Dr. GERBER stated that many deceased do not pass through a coroner's office or medical examiners office when the death certificate is signed by a physician. This call was made as per above referenced memo, an individual resembling JAMES EARL RAY was supposedly in the bar. MARY SEMAN advised that she resided at 1300 Seneca Apartment 302, Broadview Heights, Ohio, telephone number 237-7140. When the call was made to her at approximately 1:50 AM, she advised that the individual who resembled RAY had departed and that the license number of the car he left in was 1968 Ohio License DD 5475, and was a station wagon.

MARY SEMAN stated that this individual, who she described as a white male, 5'll", 170 pounds, 37 years of age, had come into the Chippewa Inn approximately one month ago, and that she had served him during the course of the evening. She stated when she left the bar for her home that night, he met her in the parking lot and wanted to see her home. She stated that she refused and that when she got into her own car and drove home, this individual followed her. She stated as she attempted to enter her apartment, he once again tried to persuade her to let him accompany her to her apartment. She stated that she once again refused and was able to get into her apartment and lock the door behind her. She stated he remained in the area for some time before driving away.

MARY SEMAN stated that this individual mentioned

that he was from Chicago, and his first name was JIM. She stated that he also advised he had lived in Los Angeles and that he works for the IBM Company. She further advised that he had told her that he had been in the Cleveland area for about one year and lived in North Royalton.

MARY SEMAN was advised that inasmuch as the individual had departed, she would be contacted the next day in an effort to have her provide any additional information.

The Department of Motor Vehicles, Columbus, Ohio, advised that License Number DD 5475 was registered to a JAMES EDWARD MAHER, 8527 South Akins Road, North Royalton, Ohio, for a 1964 Pontiac Station Wagon.

On May 23, 1968, MARY SEMAN was contacted at her apartment, and shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY. Upon looking at the photographs of RAY, she stated that there was a slight resemblance, but that she did not think now that it was the same individual.

Mrs. RUSS RAYMER, 8555 Akins Road, North Royalton, Ohio, next-door neighbor of JAMES EDWARD MAHER, was contacted on May 23, 1968, and advised that the MAHERs had moved into 8527 Akins Road, around February, 1967. She stated that JAMES MAHER and his wife drove a white station wagon and that they had two children.

Mrs. RAYMER advised that the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY was definitely not JAMES EDWARD MAHER.

On May 23, 1968, Mrs. PATRICIA MARIE MAHER was contacted, and she advised she and her husband, JAMES EDWARD MAHER, resided at 8527 Akins Road, North Royalton, Ohio, and have resided there since March of 1967. She advised that her husband's date of birth is at Chicago, Illinois. She stated that he is presently the manager of the Control Data Group, Leader Building, Cleveland, Ohio. She advised that he was transferred by this company from the Chicago Office in March of 1967.
