
MACK RICHARDSON IN INTELLIGENCE DIVISION, SECRET SERVICE WASHINGTON, D.C. ADVISED INSTANT DATE OF RECEIPT OF A TELEPHONE CALL AT ELEVEN THIRTY P.M., APRIL FOUR LAST, FROM MRS. JAMES W. TRIMXXX TRINKLE, FIFTEEN HUNDRED PROVINCETOWN LANE, RICHARDSON, TEXAS, TELEPHONE AD ONE TWO SEVEN THREE ONE. SHE SAID THAT ON MARCH TWENTYNINE LAST HER HUSBAND WAS IN ABILENE, TEXAS, AND BOUGHT GAS FROM A MOBILE STATION WHERE THE ATTENDANT INFORMED HIM THAT A YOUNG WHITE MALE IN A NEW WHITE CAR HAD GUNS AND AMMUNITION IN THE BACK SEAT AND HAD SAID HE WAS GOING TO MEMPHIS TO TAKE CARE OF THE LEADERS OF THE DEMONSTRATION. MR. TRINKLE DID NOT WISH HIS WIFE TO INFORM THE AUTHORITIES IN ORDER NOT TO BECOME INVOLVED. MRS. TRINKLE SAID THE CARBON CREDIT MOBILE TICKET IDENTIFIED THE STATION AS ONE-H-TWENTY. DALLAS IMMEDIATELY CONDUCT APPROPRIATE INVESTIGATION TO ASCERTAIN FACTS AIMED AT IDENTIFYING THE FBI DALLAS





JAMES W. TRINKLE, ONE FIVE ZERO ZERO PROVINCETOWN LANE, RICHARDSON, TEXAS, WAS INTERVIEWED TODAY AND STATES HE STOPPED TWENTY AT INTERSTATE HIGHWAY/MOBIL). STATION IN ABILENE, TEXAS, AT APPROXIMATELY ELEVEN THIRTY AM, MARCH TWENTYNINE LAST. WHILE OBTAINING GAS, ATTENDANT ASKED WHERE HE WAS FROM AND TRINKLE ADVISED HIM HE WAS EN ROUTE TO DALLAS. DURING BRIEF CONVERSATION ATTENDANT MENTIONED FACT UNIDENTIFIED MAN HAD COME INTO STATION EARLIER THAT MORNING OR DAY BEFORE AND MAN HAD SEVERAL GUNS IN BACK END OF CAR. ATTENDANT TOLD TRINKLE MAN SAID HE WAS "GOING TO MEMPHIS TO KILL SOME NEGROES." NO FURTHER DETAILS OF CONVERSATION RECALLED BY TRINKLE AND TRINKLE DID NOT OBTAIN DESCRIPTION OF MAN OR CAR HE WAS DRIVING. ATTENDANT DID COMMENT ABOUT SEVERE

TODAY HOMER DILL, MANAGER, MOBIL INTERSTATE TWENTY SERVICE STATION, ABILENE, TEXAS, ADVISES AS RECALLED ON MARCH THIRTYONE LAST ABOUT SEVEN AM, AN INDIVIDUAL DRIVING A BRAND NEW WHITE, TWO-DOOR HARDTOP THUNDERBIRD AUTO STOPPED THERE FOR GAS. HE ADVISED HE DID NOT NOTE THE LICENSE NO. AS THE PAYMENT FOR THE GAS WAS IN CASH. HE STATED THE INDIVIDUAL MENTIONED THAT HE WAS GOING TO MEMPHIS AND HAD A THIRTY POINT ZERO SIX AND SOME OTHER RIFLES LAYING IN THE BACK SEAT PARTIALLY COVERED BY A SHEET. HE ADVISED DURING THE COURSE OF CONVERSATION, THIS INDIVIDUAL STATED HE WAS EN ROUTE TO DALLAS TO STAY WITH AN AUNT AND THEN GOING TO MEMPHIS. CHANCE. DILL STATED THE INDIVIDUAL SAID NOTHING ABOUT GOING TO KILL NEGROES NOR DID HE SHOW ANY ANIMOSITY TOWARD NEGROES. HE ADVISED THE INDIVIDUAL CAME BACK THROUGH, STOPPED AT HIS SERVICE STATION ON APRIL THREE LAST, JUST AS HE OPENED, AND WAS ACCOMPANIED BY A WHITE FEMALE. BELIEVED TO BE HIS WIFE. DILL ADVISED THEY MENTIONED THEY HAD COME FROM HIS AUNT'S IN DALLAS AND WERE GOING ON A VACATION AND TOOK TWELVE OR FOURTEEN GALLONS OF GAS, THE LAST TIME PAYING IN CASH. NEWBY SERVED TIME WITH HALL IN FCI, EL RENO, OKLA. HALL HAS BEEN RELEASED FROM FCI AND IS REPORTEDLY LIVING WITH MOTHER (NAME UNKNOWN) AT TWO NINE SIX ONE GROON OR GROOM ST., BAKER, LA.

NEWBY ADVISED THAT DURING TIME HE WAS AT FCI EL RENO, HALL HAD NUMEROUS FIGHTS WITH NEGRO INMATES AND INFORMED HIM WHEN HE GOT OUT HE WANTED TO KILL A "NIEGER" AND MARTIN LUTHER KING WAS SINGLED OUT BY HALL AS BEING A GOOD ONE TO KILL. HE FURTHER

At 11:30 A.M. today, Colonel HUGH D. DOW (USAF), telephonically advised he arrived at Love Field, Dallas, Texas, via Braniff Flight 163, from Colorado Springs, Colorado, at about 10:00 A.M. He said he entered an airport limousine (car #8) to go to Fort Worth, Texas. A man and a woman also entered the limousine but they were not traveling together. While waiting for the driver, they began discussing the death of KING.

The man mentioned he had just come in from Memphis, Tennessee this morning and night go back tonight since he had a girl there. Colonel DOW said he got the impression he referred to a daughter. He then inquired as to whether Dallas was larger than Fort Worth and was told that it was. He then got out of the limousine and said he was going to stay in MASHAMERINA Dallas.

Colonel DOW said this individual was a white male, about 5'8" tall, wearing a dark suit with a white turtle-neck sweater, and had dark crew-cut hair.

He said he has no further information relative to this person and realizes the information he is furnishing is very nebulous in nature but he felt he should report it. He said he will be in Fort Worth at the home of his brother, telephone WA 3-0704, until Sunday evening. He resides at 1600 South Eades, Apartment 911, Arlington, Va.

SAC SHANKLIN discussed the above with ASAC HALTER, Memphis, and was advised this information does not appear pertinent.

At approximately 1:00 P.M. today, NANCY SAULNIER, 302 Louisiana, Abilene, Texas, telephonically advised she has just seen a photograph in the Abilene Reporter-News of the suspect in KING's death. She stated that she had been traveling from Ohio to Abilene on March 28, 1968, and stopped at the Ramada Inn in a town thirty miles East of Shreveport, Louisiana. She stated that she was having dinner that evening and observed a man sitting at a nearby table. When he finished his meal, he came to her table and asked is he could sit down and talk with her. She said they talked for a while and then went to her room and watched the news, being particularly interested in weather reports since this was during tornado warning times. She said he then went to his room and she did not seen him until the following morning. The next day she was having breakfast and saw him leaving the motel in his automobile which she believes was a red Porsche.

Mrs. SAULNIER said the picture in the newspaper closely resembles the individual whom she met at the motel. She said his name was MARK but she does not recall his last name. She stated that he was supposedly a Top Value stamp salesman from Alexandria, Louisiana. She described him as a W/M; brown, receding hair; about six feet tall; and average build.


On 4/6/68, T. G. GRIMES, 815 S. Ravinia Dr., Dallas, (FE 1-5568), telephonically advised he had observed the drawing of the suspect in instant matter, and concluded suspect possibly identical to CHARLES NELSON GIBSON, who worked for him about four months ago.


GRIMES said GIBSON worked for him for three or four months, and lived at 300 N. Rosemont, Dallas, Apt. 3, an apartment rented by GRIMES for his employees. GRIMES is in the construction business.

GIBSON, SSN , is age app. 37, and gave address for W-4 Tex form as RFD 3, Box 310, Red Springs, N. C. GIBSON was possibly in Korean War, and his mind is unstable. GRIMES stated GIBSON suspects many people of being Communists, including GRIMES, himself.

GRIMES advised he still has W-4 form on GIBSON, which possibly contains the fingerprints of GIBSON. He stated he is willing to give this to any FBI agent desiring same.

On instant date, at 5:15 P.M., Officer JOHN STEED, Nacogdoches, Texas P. D. telephonically advised writer of the following: He stopped for speeding an individual with the name of GENE M./STAMM, who he described as a white, male, age about 35-40, height 5/9", weight about 145, dark brown hair, slight build. He stated he did not charge this individual and permitted him to go on his way. He stated however, that it seemed unusual to him, since this individual had a Tennessee license plage BP-0663 on his car, with "Shelby County" written on the plate. The car was described as a white, 1965 chevrolet, four door sedan. This individual exhibited Tennessee Drivers' license 1656645, and stated that he worked for the War on Poverty and that he was travelling to Houston, from Memphis.

DATE:

Officer STEED stated that he thought he should relay this information to the FBI, although he did not wish to indicate or insinuate in any way that the above individual might be a suspect in the murder of Dr. King.

A review of Dallas indices is negative; Miss ERMA RODRIGUEZ, Ident. Bureau, Dallas PD., as well as Deputy Sheriff J. BROWN had no record of this individual.
