At 9:25 P. M., 4/10/68, an anonymous male who sounded as if perhaps 25-30 years of age, sober, no background noise, telephonied Dallas Office and advised Clek C. B. Brown as follows: "The killer of Dr. Martin Luther King is at 3307 Crestview, number 114." Caller hung up.

Mildred Mc Murray, 3225 Crestview, telephone LA 8-5614, manager of Chestview Apartments, advised apt. 114, address 3307, is occupied byBod Sikors, employed by Clairol (cosmetics), and Jimmir Moore whose ramily are understood to own Zenith Cleaners. The latter is supposed to work for an uncle. Mrs. McMurray stated the two are very undesirable tenants, noist, rowdy, have many visitors in the same general age group. Doris Cargle, apt. 115, had told Mrs. McMurray within the past couple of days that it was friends of Moore and &kin= Sikors who thre patio furnitue into the swimming pool. One of the boys drives what is believed to be a white 1962 Falcon, the other a blue Plymouth.


Mts. Mc Murray saidthe boys were there last night, at least Sikors was, as she saw the latter in apt. 117, occupied by Jim Pettyjohn who is considered a prittet quiet, more responsible person. Pettyjohn works for Nichols Machinery Co. (Amarillo address shown on business card, although this company is known to have a Dallas branch.) Mrs. McMunray knew of no recent out-of-town trips of Sikors or Moore.

Doris Cargle, 115, said Sikors is 22-23 years of age, about 5'9", shorty dark hair, lean, thin face, nice looking. Moore is about the same age, perhaps a little younger, shorter, heavier, round face, very black eyes. Cargle said if Sikors and Moore have b een out of town, she has not been aware of it as she sees or hears them practically every day. They do considerable partying and have loud. apparently irresponsible visitors.

Circumstances suggest the probability the call was a prank. and since descriptions do not fif subject, and there is no indication of out-of-town travel, no further action is being taken.

On 4/11/68, Inspector JOE SULLIVAN, who is now running this case from Memphis, advised that the Los Angeles Office had apparently located the laundry where the laundry marks were from on the shorts fround apparently abandoned by the individual who shot MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated that this laundry had previously been operated for a time by one JAY WALLACE VERNON, who apparently sold out in March and current whereabouts not known. VERNON was described as a white male, born 12/14/35 at Pampa, Texas, 5'11", 195 lbs., brown hair, brown eyes, FBI No. 7 432 268, Army Serial No. He stated also that a pair of pliers that had been found abandoned by the assassin had been determined to have been purchased in Los Angeles in 1966 about five blocks from where this laundry was located. VERNON's prints are not identical with the latent prints that have been developed by the Bureau, but he apparently disappeared from Los Angeles around 3/27/68. He has, while serving in the Army, been stationed at Camp Campbell, Clarksville, Tennessee and at one time deserted and turned himself in at Birmingham, Ala. and also on another occasion believed to have turned himself in at Laredo, Texas. His father is shown as JAMES MACK VERNON, who has apparently been living in the Los Angeles area since about 1955. He stated they were definitely trying to determine VERNON's whereabouts and his background because he would possibly have some connection with the actual assassin or possibly know him. It was suggested that I might try to find out anything I could at Pampa, Texas and that he would furnish further information to me when same received.

I called Inspector SULLIVAN back and furnished him this information as it appeared that VERNON had probably gotten out of the Army and was in the Air Force as late as 1963. He stated he would obtain detailed information from San Francisco, origin.

ACTION: SA JENKINS is proceeding to Pampa to try and check and determine any connection, but JENKINS advised that in 1935 he was actually living in Pampa and knew that a large segment of the population was itinerant oil workers.



Mr. J. C. SPIEKERMAN, JR., Plant Manager, Joseph Schlitz Brewing Company, Longview, Texas Plant, advised canned beer produced by this plant is stamped on the bottom of each can at the time of packaging with a code number which designates the date, month, and year it was produced. He gave the following code number as an example:

Code No. $\frac{03}{158}$ The number 03 refers to the month and the 15 refers to the day of the month while the 8 refers to the year.

Therefore, this particular stamp on a can of beer produced by this firm means it was produced on March 15, 1968.

Mr. SPIEKERMAN stated that no other stamps or markings are placed on the beer can by this firm when produced and packaged. He stated that the lids which are placed on the bottom of each can of beer produced for the sale in the State of Mississippi bear markings showing the Mississippi State Tax as being paid. These markings are in the form of black lettering showing "Mississippi Tax Paid", the Great Seal of Mississippi, and the amount of the tax, "4 Cents" or "5 1/3", this latter amount depending on the size of the beer can, 12 or 16 fluid ounces as the case may be. This lettering is within a black circle. The other marking on the can which is different from other cans used by Joseph Schlitz Brewing Company is that the can shows the beer was produced at a particular plant. The beer produced by the Longview plant shows Longview, Texas.

Mr. SPIEKERMAN advised that Schlitz beer sold in the State of Mississippi is sold through the following distributors, all located in the State of Mississippi:

RE: REPORT OF GRANT AHRENS, 2736 DELORES STREET, ANTIOCH, CALIFORNIA, CONCERNING CONVERSATION ON AMERICAN AIRLINES FLIGHT 296 BETWEEN MEMPHIS AND LOUISVILLE, MARCH 28, 1968

The following investigation was conducted by SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS on April 11, 1968:

AT DALLAS, TEXAS:

JESSE ORR, Security Representative, American Airlines, (former Special Agent), determined that American Airlines flight 296 was in fact a 727 jet, departed Dallas at 1:20 PM, March 28, 1968, with stops at Memphis and Louisville in route to LaGuardia, New York City. Mr. ORR stated the questionsof making seating charts is discretionary with the stewardesses on a flight, since it is primarily for their benefit. the seating chart is normally thrown away by the stewardesses on arriving at the terminal point of the flight. In connection with this particular flight, the stewardesses who took the plane from Memphis to New York City are based in New York City, names not known to Mr. ORR. Mr. ORR furnished a list of passengers who boarded flight 296 in Dallas on March 28, 1968. Fifteen persons were first class passengers, the remainder beginning with the name & AHRENS were coach passengers. In addition, two military personnel on "stand-by" were shown to have boarded in Dallas. No information is available except slips of paper. One slip shows the name "SGT" (illegible, possibly REYNOLDS or REVNOERS) who first checked with the airline at 12:30 PM and was destined for Louisville. The other was one FARRIS, rank and service not shown, who first contacted the author at 11:45 AM, March 28, 1968, and was also destined for Louisville. Mr. ORR noted that this would have been a poor choice of flights for a person traveling from Dallas to Richmond, however, there are undoubtedly flights from Louisville to Richmond.

Mr. ORR determined that the numbers which follows the passengers' names on the list furnished are numbers which identify information in the Brier Cliff Computer System, New York City. Such information will normally indicate full details, including address and/or telephone number given to the airline as a contact point for the prospective passenger when making reservations. 44-2649-83

Enclosed to Memphis are nine copies of investigative insert reflecting investigation conducted in Dallas, Texas. Also enclosed for Memphis is a Xerox copy concerning passengers who boarded American Airlines flight 296 at 1:20 PM, 3/28/68, in Dallas. It is noted Mr. G. AHRENS, apparently identical with GRANT AHRENS, was a coach passenger and accordingly it appears passengers who sat in the immediate vicinity of him were also coach passengers. Coach passengers are listed on the enclosed beginning with the name of Mr. AHRENS, those above being first class passengers.

Investigation disclosed no names of military persons appear on the enclosed list, however, two persons were on "stand-by" and did board the flight in Dallas. Both were destined for Louisville. One was Sgt. (illegible possibly REYNOLDS or REVNOERS), the other one FARRIS, rank and service not indicated. It is further observed that the female Captain in the Afghanistan Army is not identifiable from the list enclosed. Agent was informed that the numbers to the immediate rights of the names of the individuals on the list are identifying information in a computer at the Briar Cliff Computer System, New York City. Such information will show in most cases the full data concerning reservations made by the respective persons, including contact telephone numbers and/or addresses.

It is being left to the discretion of Memphis whether this investigative lead is worthy of being pursued further in this regard.

It is suggested with respect to military personnel, that Louisville Office might check records of airlines out of Louisville to Richmond, Virginia, following the arrival of American Airlines flight 296 on 3/28/68, in an effort to identify the Airman who reportedly sat next to AHRENS. It is further suggested that Louisville at Fort Knox, Kentucky, might successfully identify the female Afghanistan Army Captain, perhaps more easily than through information from the airlines.

Memphis note 71 persons reportedly boarded the plane at Memphis.

Dallas Office will not pursue this matter further unless advised by Memphis.

### FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

April 10, 1968

A review of the Army service record for DONNIE LEON HARDEN. Army Serial Number on file at the Military Personnel Records Center, St. Louis, Missouri, disclosed that HARDEN served in the U.S. Army on active duty from May 1, 1958 at Montgomery, Alabama, to honorable discharge from active duty and transferred to the Reserve at Oakland, California, March 31, 1961. He thereafter entered on active duty in the Army at Montgomery, Alabama on May 22, 1963, and served until honorable discharge due to hardship at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, June 4, 1965. Rank at time of discharge was Specialist Fourth Grade. He also had inactive service in the Alabama National Guard, April 21, 1955 to April 30, 1958, and May 15, 1962 to December 17, 1962. He served in the inactive U. S. Army Reserve from April 1, 1961 to April 30. 1962. His military occupation was listed as Communications Center Specialist. His civilian occupation was listed as Welder, Farmer and Musician (singing and guitar). The file failed to show any courts-martial or absences without official leave but did indicate a reduction in rank in December, 1962, while in the National Guard due to inefficiency. No details appear.

Top secret clearance was granted him on September 30, 1958, based on a background investigation completed September 24, 1958 by the Army Security Agency, Third Army Area, Dossier Number H3008562.

Throughout his service his home address is listed as Route C, Evergreen, Alabama. In 1963, an address of 6125 Ridgemont Avenue, Houston, Texas appeared and his address at the time of final discharge was listed as 701 Roxella, Houston, Texas.

He has blood group "O". He received an expert's badge in the Ml carbine. He had foreign service of one year, eight months, and 15 days in the Pacific Theater.

A letter from his wife appeared in the file dated April 2, 1965, addressed to Lieutenant General J. L. RICHARDSON, Fort Houston, Texas, which alleged that HARDEN had made false statements in applying for a hardship discharge. She stated HARDEN had indicated he was going to run his father's firm in Evergreen, Alabama, and that she was a nervous wreck worrying about him going overseas, all of which was untrue. She stated that he had a job waiting for him at Brown and Root Construction Company as a heavy equipment operator. She further stated that he had been a different man since his service in Okinawa as he had beaten her several times and had spent one night in jail on arrest by the Alamo Heights Police Department in San Antonio, Texas for having beaten her. She stated his temper and filthy language were terrible. She stated she had tried to leave him but had been told by him he would kill her and all three of their children if she did. She stated he purchased a rifle and cartridges the following day. She stated he had torn up several pieces of their furniture, half of her clothing, broken her watch, and had choked her on several occasions. She further alleged mistreatment of their 15 month old son.

The file further reflected a statement by HARDEN that his wife had previously suffered a complete nervous

The following investigation was conducted by SA FORREST F. JOHN on April 10, 1968:

### AT DALLAS, TEXAS

Accheck of the voters registration list for each of the 293 precincts in Dallas County failed to locate any entry under the last names LOWMEYER or LOWMYER. These lists were made available by E. C. MC CORMACK, Supervisor of Voters Registration Section, Dallas County.

A check of the Dallas County Clerk's Office determined 1967 Texas license LKF 414 is listed to a 1964 Chevrolet registered to DOUG ROY, 1548 Mapleton, Dallas, Texas.

Mrs. JOHN WORLEY, 13503 Shahan, advised that CLAUDE ROUX, who resides next door, moved to that address, which was observed to be 13509 Shahan, from Alabama prior to the time school started in September, 1967. ROUX has three cars, one of which is a company car just recently acquired by him. These cars have had Alabama licenses on them. All of them are full sized cars and she has never observed ROUX to have a Mustang. It was observed that there is no 13505 Shahan.

Later on April 10, 1968, during a telephone call from ROUX, he stated Alabama license 47-7514 was on a 1967 Ford four-door, that this car is a company car and that it was picked up by one of his employees in Memphis, Tennessee, on the day MARTIN LUTHER KING was shot.

WAYNE SMITH, 2420 Wicker, telephone CH 7-3037, after being advised of the interviewing Agent's identity, furnished the following information:

SMITH is a close friend of HERBERT A. (BUCK) FERRELL, 4406 Holland, Dallas, LA 8-0716, who formerly resided in Memphis, Tennessee. FERRELL has advised SMITH that if MARTIN LUTHER KING went to Memphis "they" would kill him. FERRELL did not further identify "they."

SMITH was watching television on the date that KING was shot and when the news appeared on television he telephoned FERRELL's home to advise FERRELL, but he was not at home. FERRELL's wife, MARY ELIZABETH, answered the telephone and she was crying, appeared to be terribly upset and said, "Oh my God, I hope it isn't someone we know. You'll have to call back later if you want to talk to BUCK. I'm too torn up now."

SMITH telephoned FERRELL at home about an lour later and FERRELL stated he had been told by an "informant" (not otherwise identified by FERRELL) that "they" had tried to get KING two weeks ago and would try again.

FERRELL and his wife have been in Memphis frequently lately as her mother died in January, 1968, and they have been back and forth settling her estate.

FERRELL has a son JIMMIE, age 16 or 17, at home, and a son BILLY in the U. S. Marines. He has another son LAWRENCE A. FERRELL (wife BOBBIE), age 23 to 26, 7135 Fenton, Dallas, telephone DI 8-7916. LAWRENCE has a red Mustang with black top and a Volkswagen and is a motorcycle enthusiast. LAWRENCE

has been unemployed for a period of time and about two or three weeks ago when asked by SMITH what he was going to do, he stated that he was going to work for Blue Cross in their Dallas office. LAWRENCE was in the U. S. Air Force and after discharge he spent a year bumming around in Mexico. He rides with motorcycle clubs and would apparently like to be a "hippie."

MARY ELIZABETH FERRELL, wife of HERBERT A. FERRELL, has reportedly done a lot of work for GARRISON of New Orleans, and she has had GARRISON's people in her home, going to Love Field Airport at times to get them. This work done by her has apparently all been in Dallas. She has had Mrs. OSWAID, ex-wife of LEE HARVEY OSWAID, in her home.

FERRELL's daughter CAROL ANN is married, has two children and resides in the 4000 or 4100 Block of Holland, Dallas.

FERRELL has a 1964 or 1965 Lincoln financed through the Ford Motor Company, Dallas; recently purchased a 1968 Dodge Monaco from Dodge City, Dallas, financed at a local bank; and has a 1967 Dodge Dart for CAROL ANN financed at the First National Bank, Dallas.

FERRELL's home is financed at Oak Cliff
Bank and Trust Company, Dallas, and he has gas credit
cards with Mobil, Gulf and Shell Oil Company.
FERRELL has bank accounts at the Texas Bank and
Republic Bank and Mrs. FERRELL has her own bank account
and her own credit (Femme Sole). FERRELL is employed
by United Savings Life Insurance Company, Dallas,
as a Division Manager. He is gone most of the time
during the week in connection with his employment
and during the past year he has stayed in the Holiday
Inn Motel, Mt. Pleasant; at motels in Dangerfield
and at hotels in Tyler, returning home on the weekends.

JAMES FERRELL, brother of HERBERT A. FERRELL, is a conductor on a railroad out of Memphis and has a violent dislike for Negroes and has his family thinking the same way. He has rifles and ammunition and has taught his three or four sons to use these.

Last fall or early this year, FERRELL, went to Arkansas and purchased some land for himself and also some land for JAMES FERRELL deep in the hills and has advised SMITH that this land was purchased so they would have some place to go in the event the Negro problem got too bad in Memphis. FERRELL has stated that he made the down payment on this land and some of the payments for JAMES FERRELL.

On Saturday evening, April 6, 1968, SMITH telephoned FERRELL's home and asked JIMMIE, FERRELL's 16 or 17 year old son, where FERRELL was and JIMMIE stated that his father had gone to Arkansas immediately following a business meeting which usually ends at about 5:00 PM on Saturdays.

MARY ELIZABETH FERRELL at one time worked for the Greenhill school and while there the FERRELL family became very close to a boylinamed SCOTTY BARONSON (Phonetic) from Mexico, whose father controls all the adhesive surfaced paper products in the Mexico City area and has property in Mexico, Europe and Dallas and has ships. SCOTTY went to School in Plano, but quit, married a local girl and now is employed by her father who owns a dry cleaning business in Dallas.

In addition to JAMES, FERRELL has a younger brother HERBIE who is in a management position in an insurance company in Memphis and another brother who is an officer in the U. S. Air Force, but his name and location is not known.

SMITH stated that the FERRELL brothers are very close, but that their wives do not get along too well.

He described HERBERT A. FERRELL as a white male, 50 years of age, and he stated that all of the FERRELL men he has seen have dark sandy hair, fair complexions, weigh from about 160 to 200 pounds and are from 5'8" to 5'll" in height.

HUBERT A. FERRELL, 4406 Holland Avenue, telephone 523-0716, after being advised of the identities of interviewing Agents and that information was received indicating he had information of possible interest relating to the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, advised as follows:

FERRELL is employed as a District Manager by United Savings Life Insurance Company and works out of his home. FERRELL has lived most of his life in Memphis, Tennessee, but moved to Dallas about 14 years ago.

Recently during a "bull session" with a large group of men, someone made a statement to the effect that during the first march in Memphis, which march was led by KING, the riot was probably started by the militant Negroes as a diversion to give them an opportunity to shoot KING, but that KING had been gotten away before they had an opportunity. This individual, identity not recalled, further remarked that if this were true they would probably try again. He stated he has repeated these remarks to many people.

FERRELL stated his wife has been very upset and emotional about the situation in Memphis as her only close relative, a sister, resides in Memphis. She is very concerned over her sister's safety.

FERRELL has three brothers and a sister who reside in or near Memphis, as well as friends. He stated he knows no one in Memphis who he would suspect of killing KING. He stated that none of his relatives or friends appear to have any unusual animosity toward members of the Negro race.

# FBI Searching For Alabaman In King Case

MEMPHIS—The Federal Bureau of Investigation Thursday night was seeking a 37-year-old Alabama man for questioning in the slaying of The Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

An FBI bulletin which was released by mistake in Miami Thursday night identified the man as Eric Starvo Galt. He was described as being 5 feet 11 inches tall and weighing 175 pounds.

The FBI in Washington refused to comment but sources said that Galt was sought in connection with the assassination of the civil rights leader in Memphis.

It was the first indication that the FBI may be nearing a solution to the killing.

The FBI bulletin, which was withdrawn at 10:30 p.m. said that Galt, who has blue eyes and brown hair, was last seen driving a white Mustang car with Alabama license plates. Number 1-38993. This is the license plate issued for a car in Birmingham.

The FBI bulletin gave Galt's address at 2608 Highland Avenue in Birmingham. A Birmingham reporter who went to that address said that it was a rooming house and that other residents said they had not seen Galt in about three months.

In Atlanta Thursday night, the police were reported to have impounded a white Mustang that had been parked near a housing project since last Friday.

EARL DAY, Rt. 3, Siloam Springs. He advised that DAY drove him to Tulsa, Okla., He was picked up by a trucker in Tulsa, Okla., and given a ride to Oklahoma City, where he stayed from 3/27-29/68 returning to Amarillo on 3/30/68 by Greyhound Bus, staying at the Faith City Mission on 3/31/4/2/68 and on 4/3-4-5/68 he slept in a car parked behind a garage on Amarillo, Blvd. because he had no money.

Subject advised he filled out an application for job at the TexaslEmployment Commission on 4/3/68 and worked at the Pullman Cafe as a dishwasher 4/3-4-5/68.

Subject volunteered to go with the writer to establish his whreabouts on the above dates.

On 4/10/68, PAUL H.WILLIAMS, Texas Employment Commission, 1020 West 6th St. advised subject registered for work on 4/3/68. WILLIAMS advised a referal card indicates COOKSON received a job at the Pullman Cafe as dishwasher on 4/3/68.

On 4/10/68, EVA COLE, Owner Pullman Cafe, 404-B S. Polk St. identified COOKSON as working for her from 4/3-4-5/68 and that he came into her cafe on the following Monday 4/8/68 but did not work.
