KALISTER, Alchol Tax Unit SA, US Treasury Dept., Tyler, Texas, appeared at the Tyler RA on this date and advised that he and SA ROBERT BREESE of the Alchol Tax Unit were in the SO at Centerville, Texas, Leon County, at about 2:00 PM an 4/17/68 and were told by sheriff Roy Wilson that he had a man in his jail who claimed he had shot Dr. Martin L. King. Kalister said the Sheriff had a newspaper in his hand which allegedly contained some handwriting by this man relating to his confession and also exhibited to him a diary. The Sheriff told him that this man had sold a new motor and boat to a filling station man across the street from the courthouse, for \$99.00. Also this man in jail had \$1,000 in Travelers checks on his person when arrested. KALISTER said the Sheriff apparently thought this jailed man was a "nut" and paid no further attention to the matter. Also present were the County Judge, the Game Warden, and RALPH ELLIOTT of the State Liquor Control Board. Kalister said he did not see the prisoner.



On the PM of 4-18-68 G.B. HARTMAN, Dispatcher, Texas DPS, Sherman advised he had just received word from THP MARVIN DOBECKA, stationed in McKinney, Texas that DOBECKA had just been notified by an unspecified person McKinney that this person had just seen a person who bore a similarity to that of photos of ERIC S. GALT, and "who acted suspicious," had just passed through McKinney, Texas, heading North on US 75. He was driving a white Cadillac, year not given, bearing "Calif. license plates WN-2343." HARTMAN stated this appears to be in error since Calif. license prefix is three letters, rather than two, and speculated it might be an Oklahoma license, in view of two letter prefix and car headed North on 75. He estimated at this time the car would probably be between Melissa and Anna, Texas, and stated he had no highway units at this time on or near 75 between McKinney and Sherman, Texas. Car had only the one male occupant.

The writer proceeded immediately to Highway 75 South of Sherman, and the Dorchester overpass and maintained a fisur of northbound cars on 75 for above described vehicle with negative results.

This information was subsequently on 4-18-68 furnished to night clerk, JERRY PRICE 18-13, Dallas FBI who subsequently stated he had contacted night clerk, WAYNE STURDIVANT, Oklahoma City, who in turn had been informed by OHP there was no such license issued in Oklahoma at set forth above and a check of various variations of this number failed to reflect any registered to a Cadillac at all.

MEMDUIS, Tenn. (AP) -The mysterious Eric Starvo Galt has been charged with conspiracy and murder in the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The FBI said in a fugitive varrant issued Wednesday warrant night in Birmingham, Ala., that Galt, 36, conspired with a man "whom he alleged to be his brother" to violate King's civil rights.

The state charge of first-degree murder was filed against Galt in Memphis where King, 39, Nobel Prize winning civil rights leader, was shot to death on a motel balcony April 4 by a sniper who fled from a nearby rooming house.

FACES CHAIR

First-degree murder in Tennessee carries the death penalty although the electric chair has not been used in the state since 1960.

The maximum penalty under the federal charge of conspiracy to violate a person's civil rights is a \$5,000 fine and 10-year prison sentence.

There was no further mention in the FBI statement about the alleged brother and no charge was filed against him.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover announced in Washington that the conspiracy to "injure, op-press, threaten or intimidate" King began "on or about March 30" in Birmingham.

The FBI statement said a 30.06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight found near the rooming house shortly after King was slain, was purchased March 30 in Birmingham.
NO DIRECT LINK

The statement did not connect

Galt directly with the rifle.

The FBI released a photograph of Galt and solicited public aid in finding him. Whether this appeal magnet the trill head this appeal meant the trail had become cold was unclear, but U.S. Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark told a reporter in Washington

that he felt this was not the situ-

The FBI started hunting Galt a week ago. Agents even contacted persons named Galt in several states in an attempt to find him.

The picture—which had to have the eyes "opened" by an artist—brought uncertain responses from witnesses who were acquainted with Galt or saw the fleeing sniper.

NOT YOUR MAN

"Unless he was wearing a wig or had had a face lift or some-thing, it's not the man I saw," said Charles Q. Stevens, who lives at the Main Street rooming house from which the fatal shot apparently was fired.

"The hair is too full and the face is too young," he said. But Stevens said he only got a side view of the fleeing figure.

A source in Birmingham said the photograph was taken with-in the past three months, al-though the FBI did not specify when it was made. The photo has sharp contrast, making hair and features very dark.

The FBI, relying on witnesses apparently, said the fugitive had been described as a white man, 5-8 to 5-11, weighing 160 to 175 pounds, with brown hair in a brush cut, blue eyes, straight nose.

Persons who have met Galt, the FBI reported, described him as a loner with a "rural" speech and little schooling, fond of vodka, beer and hillbilly mu-

The FBI statement also said, "The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his left hand. His left ear protrudes further from his head than his

right ear."
"Galt should be considered armed and dangerous," the FBI release warned.

Galt has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmeyer, the FBI said.

Mrs. HARRY JOHNSON, 9432 Parkford, Dallas, DI 8-6844, (requested her identity be protected), who stated she is wife of a doctor, on 4/20/68, telephonically furnished information to SA EDWIN D. KUYKENDALL as follows:

About midnight, following April 1, 1968, she alone in her 1964 Buick Electra, stopped at an eating establishment, name unknown but like a Toddle House, on Highway 90 as she was driving east, one or two blocks on her right passed a university in Tallahassee, Florida. While having coffee there a male individual came in and inquired if she was driving the Texas car. He said a few other things to her including something to the effect that people he came there with had left him there stranded. Later as she was leaving she saw him standing in the parking lot and then made some comment about staying next door. She did not observe what was next door but remembered it was a large building, possible a hotel, apartment or rooming house. She furnished the following description of the individual:

MC KINNEY stated this man came out of the grocery store empty handed, entered the Mustang, and drove East on Live Oak, toward out of town. MC KINNEY pointed out someone might recall the Mustang and its occupants, as the car was backed into the parking space approximately two cars down from the manus entrance to the Safeway store.

MC KINNEY described this unknown individual as 5'9", 170-175 lbs., walked with limp (int turned toe of left // foot in toward other foot, blonde had r.

At Approximately 12:45 AM this date, this office was contacted by GEORGE ESTFALL, Mesa Grande Estates, Parker County, phone CIrcle-5-1248 concerning possible info in the MURKIN case. The caller stated that a few days ago he was out walking his dogs in his pasture, located off Interstate Highway 20, when he heard gunfire. WESTFALL stated that at the time he thought nothing of the shots. However, he did notice an abandoned car near where he heard the shots come from. The car is an old Chevrolet with Mississippi license plates. When asked the license number, WESTFALL said that he would have to go and get the numbers. The caller was not instructed by this writer to take such action.

At approximately 1:30 AM, WESTFALL recontacted this office and related this info. The license plates on the car have been altered with green and white paint. The plates were originally L-1-4873 and had been altered to read L-2-4878. The plates were issued in Lauderdale County. WESTFALL further stated that the car was full of clothes and trash and that there was an obnoxious odor coming from the trunk. Upon investigation WESTFALL found an envelope with a hand-drawn map on the back showing a street dividing a large building from a smaller one with a line drawn from the smaller building to the larger one. The front of the envelope contained the address GORDON LYMAN, Veteran's Administration Hospital, Temple, Texas. The envelope also had an Army discharge number C-505 86 10 and other scribbling concerning a Jiffy Dodge Truck Rental.


