

He said he could not state positively that the man he knows is RAY but he is very suspicious of him. He said this man came to work with another man who he said is his brother but they do not look alike and he does not believe they are brothers. The person looking like RAY gave his name as DAVID GLAWSON and his brother gave his name as RAYFORD GLAWSON.

The personnel records of the RAYMAD, Inc. were reviewed and show that DAVID NATHANIEL GLA SON, born 9/14/34, wife NORMA ANN, gave his address as Rt. 4 Box 787, Lufkin, Texas. His wife's address is shown as DIBGLL, Texas. He listed 6 children as dependents, has Social Security # and shows his occupation as carpenter. He lists his bank as the Citizens State Bank, Corrigan, Texas. He claimed to be a veteran with service in the Air Force from 11/14/52 to 8/21/56, AF # He is described as 5'10", 175 lbs., part of left ring finger missing.

Ray has been convicted of burglary, robbery, forging U.S. Postal Money Orders, armed robbery, and operating motor vehicle without owner's consent.


#### CAUTION

RAY IS SOUGHT IN CONNECTION WITH A MURDER WHEREIN THE VICTIM WAS SHOT. CONSIDER ARMED AND EXTREMELY DANGEROUS.

A Federal warrant was issued on April 17, 1968, at Birmingham, Alabama, charging Ray as Eric Starvo Galt with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen (Title 18, U. S. Code, Section 241). A Federal warrant was also issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri, charging Ray with Interstate Flight to Avoid Confinement for the crime of Robbery (Title 18, U. S. Code, Section 1073).
