





No case was noted where in the description of RAY appeared identical with that of the Unsub, however, his description is favorable, with exception of age, to that of Unsub in Dallas file 91-3905, captioned "UNSUB; Alvord National Bank, Alvord, Texas, 1/31/68, BR". Accordingly RAY's photograph should be exhibited to pertinent witness in said matter, to preclude any possibility that he might be a logical suspect.

Re memo of SAC SHANKLIN 4/22/68 relating to information received from Capt. Will Fritz, Dallas PD, who had received information from FORREST SUMMERVILLE.

FORREST SUMMERVILLE, 1204 Cladwell, telephone TA1-9208, was contacted on 4/23/68 and furnished the following information: He is a porter at the Sands Motel, Loop 12 and Highways 67 and 80. He works a 12 hour shift from 7 pm to 7 am. Part of his job is to help guests with their bags and to get the license numbers of the cars of each guest so that it can be checked against the hicense numbers given by the guest when he checks in.

At about 9;30 to 10;30 pm 4/5/68 he was passing by Room 212 when he noticed two men getting out of their car which was a 1960 or 1961 Plymouth stationwagon with 1968 Texas license. He later recorded the license number and gave it to the desk for the record. He offered to help these men with their luggage and one of them accepted his offer. He removed one small bag and a garment bag containing a suit or a suit coat from the car and put them in the room. He was tipped a dollar for this.

About four hours later he got a call to assist the occupant of room 212 with his baggage. He went to the room and the man told him he was checking out and was going to tak a taxi to Fort Worth. At that time he noted that the man who was with the occupant and who was the driver of the stationwagon had apparently left in that car. There were two beds in the room and neither of them had been used. There was a nearly empty fifth of whisky on the table. Also the small suitcase was open and he noted that it contained only one necktie and a small notebook.

He accompanied the man to the motel office where the man checked out and called a cab. The man appeared to be quite intoxicated and required assistance in getting about and in making the call. When the taxi (Yellow cab #326) arrived the man discussed going to Ft. Worth with the driver. When he
